### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Hall County, Georgia with Hall County Parks and Leisure is issuing this Task Order #2026-043 to Demand Services for Minor Resurfacing, Paving and Sealcoating at Laurel Park located at 3100 Old Cleveland Highway, Gainesville, GA 30506.

### **SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

**Bid Response:** Complete the information below and return it to the Issuing Officer via email by the date and time specified above. Electronic signatures are acceptable.

**Taxes:** The County is exempt from State of Georgia Local Sales and Use Tax. The Bidder understands and acknowledges that it is responsible for any sales and use taxes it may incur. The Bidder will not charge or invoice the County any sales and use tax as a separate line item. The Contractor may request a copy of the County's Georgia Sales and Use Tax Exemption Certificate.

**Bonds:** Not required for this solicitation.

### **SCOPE OF WORK:**

1. Cleaning and Surface Preparation:
  - a. Mechanically blow, broom, and clean all asphalt surfaces within the park entrance road and associated parking areas.

- b. Remove loose debris, dirt, vegetation, and any contaminants that may affect adhesion of sealcoat materials.
  - c. Perform localized spot cleaning where oil or chemical staining is present, using appropriate primers or treatments.
2. Sealcoating:
- a. Apply a commercial-grade asphalt seal coat to all designated entrance and parking lot asphalt surfaces.
  - b. Ensure application follows manufacturer specifications for coverage rate, weather conditions, and curing time.
  - c. Block off treated areas as needed to prevent traffic until surfaces are fully cured.
3. Pavement Marking & Striping:
- a. Re-stripe all existing parking stalls, directional arrows, ADA spaces, crosswalks, fire lanes, and curb markings to match current layout unless otherwise directed.
  - b. Use high-visibility, DOT-approved traffic marking paint.
  - c. Confirm all ADA-compliant markings and signage are refreshed and properly positioned.
4. Traffic Control & Safety:
- a. Provide all necessary cones, barricades, and signage required to control traffic during work.
  - b. Maintain public safety and access to unaffected areas of the park during operations.
5. Cleanup & Final Inspection:
- a. Remove all construction debris, materials, and equipment from the site.
  - b. Conduct a final walkthrough with the County representative for acceptance.
