- WHEREAS,** *a simple, safe and permanent microchip provides a reliable method of identification that cannot be lost, removed or damaged like traditional collars and tags; and*
- WHEREAS,** *lost pets with properly registered microchips are significantly more likely to be identified and safely reunited with their rightful owners, saving lives and reducing the burden on local animal shelters and welfare organizations; and*
- WHEREAS,** *a microchip is only effective if the owner's contact information, such as phone numbers and addresses, is kept current in the microchip registry database;*
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *that the Hall County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim June 2026 as*

National Microchipping Month

and urges all Hall County pet owners to consult with their veterinarian or the staff at the Hall County Animal Shelter to have all their pets microchipped, and to verify that their microchips are functional and up-to-date with the most accurate registry information.
