NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **Hall County Board of Commissioners** has tentatively adopted a 2026 millage rate which will require an increase in property tax by **14.12** percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on the tax increase to be held at the **Hall County Government Center, Commission Meeting Room located at 2875 Browns Bridge Rd, Gainesville, GA** on **Thursday, August 13, 2026 at 6:00 PM**.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase will be held at the **Hall County Government Center, Commission Meeting Room located at 2875 Browns Bridge Rd, Gainesville, GA** on **Monday, August 24, 2026 at 3:00 PM** and **Thursday, August 27, 2026 at 6:00 PM**.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of **3.565** mills, an increase of **.441** mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than **3.124** mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of **\$ 475,000** is approximately **\$ 83.79** and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of **\$ 500,000** is approximately **\$ 88.20**.
