Chairman Gibbs:

The Department has approved the County's funding assistance request for drainage repairs on State Route 13 at Hog Mountain Road. The funding assistance only applies to work within the state right of way. The Department will commit up to **\$100,000** or **70%** of the project cost, whichever is less. The project will be funded out of the Department's Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) Program. These funds will be in addition to any other LMIG funds allocated to the County.
