Infrastructure Investments Program Eligible recipients include states and federally recognized Indian Tribes, state or local government authorities, nonprofit organizations, and operators of public transportation services. Eligible activities include planning, operating and capital assistance, job access and reverse commute projects, mobility management activities and the acquisition of public transportation services. The deadline for completed applications is November 1, 2021.
