- MATERIAL PRICING AND AVAILABILITY: The current uncertainty of the global supply and pricing of raw materials and finished goods will not allow us to recieve firm pricing from product vendors to be held past the date of their quote. Due to this market trend, ALL PRICING WILL BE REVISITED AT TIME OF SHIPMENT BASED ON CURRENT PRICE AND AVAILABILITY OF ALL MATERIALS.
- Mobilization includes our estimated move ins and move out of equipment. Extra mobilizations due to conditions beyond our control or at the conveinience or delays of others shall be done at additional cost.
- Pricing is based on civil plans prepared by xxxxxxxxxxxxx and dated xx/xx/xxxx. Bid drawings are considered build drawings unless Simpson
  Trucking & Grading, Inc. recieves the proper record drawing. Revisions to drawings shall indicate ALL changes made by clouding or highlighting to
  denote changes. It shall be the owner, GC, Architect or engineers responsibility to make contractor aware of all changes to plans.
- CLEARING & GRUBBING: All Timber to become property of Grading Contractor. Pricing based on grinding debris and wasting onsite or utilizing some to assist with erosion control.
- Hazardous or contaminated materials requiring special handling or disposal ARE SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED. Examples are: Asbestos, tires, pcb's, lead, tanks, oils, batteries, etc.
- Utility relocations, cut offs, or removals are not included. Utility conflicts with improvements on plans to be resolved at the cost of the owner.
- All Topsoil is priced to utilize onsite, import or export of topsoil is not included unless shown as a specific pay item. Topsoil stripping is based on
  average 6"-8" thick, deeper shall be considered undercutting unsuitable soils and paid for at the rate below. Topsoil to be stripped and utilized as
  is in fill slopes or stockpiled for use by others. Rehandling, mining and burying, or respreading shall be at additional cost, if required
- GRADING: is based on drawings and topography provided. No allowance has been given for importing or exporting any earthen material from or to offsite. Grading to be performed to a tolerance of +/- 2 tenths of a foot of subgrade elevation. Compaction to be at 95% standard proctor and 98% standard proctor for the upper 12" of subgrade under buildings and pavements. Footing spoils and excess materials generated by other contractors working onsite shall be the responsibility of the entity generating spoils. Accel and Decel lane to be safed up with stone by paving contractor. Subgrade to be cut 1 ( ONE ) time. Footing excavation of buildings is excluded.
- GRADING: is based on classified excavation with the following unit prices prevailing if encountered:

Mass Rock = \$25/cy \* minimum quantity 100cy, minimum cut 5'

Rip Rock = \$4/cv

Trench Rock = \$75/cy \* minimum cut 5', minimum trench width 4'.

Hydraulic Breaker (Hoe Ram) = \$3,500 per day minimum charge

Unsuitable soils = \$6.50/cy

ALL PRICES BASED ON DISPOSAL ONSITE.

Dewatering, french drains, well points, stabilization stone, stabilization fabric, excessive drying by mechanical or chemical methods is excluded and shall be performed at additional cost to the contract. Rock Removal price is based on blasting. Additional costs for seismic monitoring, preblast and post blast surveys, rock removal by mechanical or chemical methods shall be at additional cost.

- ROCK BLASTING MONITORING: Blasting notifications and monitoring to be per State of Georgia regulations which requires monitoring of the closest inhabitable structure within 700 ft of the blasting area. There are no requirements on pre-blast surveys, but we will send a letter to any inhabitable structure within 400 ft of the blast area and upon receipt of a response to the notification granting access on the property we will perform a preblast survey.
- TESTING: Soil, compaction, and materials testing is EXCLUDED. This is to be secured and paid for by Owner or Prime Contractor.
- EROSION CONTROL: Is priced per drawings. Any additional erosion control items required by others shall be installed at the unit prices provided. Subcontractor shall perform maintenance of installed devices only while we are actively working onsite. NPDES monitoring or reporting is EXCLUDED and to be the responsibility of others. Simpson Trucking & Grading shall not be held responsible for failures of properly installed devices due to inadequate design or acts of God.
- WATER SYSTEM: BY OTHERS
- · SANITARY SEWER: BY OTHERS
- STORM DRAIN: will be installed per plans utilizing precast structures. Type 2 backfill or bedding stone is not included, unless specified in our
  proposal. Catch Basin Throats & Tops or installation of hoods on curb inlets are in curb pricing or to be installed by curb subcontractor.
- Grade staking and layout is included for our use for only items included in this proposal. Use of stakes by others shall be at their own risk. ASBUILT DRAWINGS ARE EXCLUDED, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY ITEMIZED IN OUR PROPOSAL.
- . MODULAR BLOCK WALLS: BY OTHERS
- Final billing to be based on contract price, plan changes, and change orders.
- ASPHALT PAVING & ASSOC. ITEMS: BY OTHERS
- ALL PERMITS AND FEES RELATED TO SITE DEVELOPMENT TO BE SECURED AND PAID FOR BY OTHERS.
- Engineered shoring is EXCLUDED, unless listed in proposal. Adequate room for safe excavations shall be provided by owner or GC or pay extra cost for shoring. Trench boxes are included if our competent person judges they are required.
- Pricing is solely based on specified materials and procedures identified within this proposal. Deviations from the proposed specifications will alter unit prices given.
- This proposal is good for 30 days from proposal date. Acceptance of proposal after 30 days shall be at the sole discretion of Simpson Trucking and
  Grading, Inc. Prices for materials and fuel are based on todays prices, if these commodities increase then an adequate adjustment shall be made to
  the contract prices.
- Bonds ARE NOT included in this pricing.
