**RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST**  
**EXTENSION OF SIDEWALK BONDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works and Utilities is in the process of revising its regulations concerning performance and maintenance bonds for developments within Hall County; and

**WHEREAS**, during the formation and implementation of the new process, it is necessary to authorize the extension of sidewalk bonds beyond the present 24-month period; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners desires to authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works and Utilities to extend presently existing sidewalk bonds beyond the 24-month period as needed near expiration during the study and implementation process; and

**WHEREAS**, certain sidewalk bonds are nearing expiration and should be extended on a one-year basis during this process; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of a new comprehensive process for administration of performance and maintenance bonds is in the best interest of Hall County citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HALL COUNTY DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** that the portions of Section 16.70.330 of the Code of Ordinances of Hall County regarding the duration of performance and maintenance bonds are hereby suspended through and including August 31, 2022, and the Director of the Department of Public Works and Utilities is hereby authorized to extend such bonds for a

period of one-year pending study of and adoption of a new comprehensive process for acceptance and management of performance and maintenance bonds concerning developments within unincorporated Hall County.
