## <u>A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF HALL COUNTY</u> <u>WITH REGARD TO SOLID WASTE AT THE SANITARY LANDFILL</u>

WHEREAS, Hall County has developed certain regulations governing solid waste and the County's sanitary landfill and solid waste compactor sites found in Chapter 8.60 of the Official Code of Hall County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the useful life of Hall County's sanitary landfill will be prolonged by the prohibition on the acceptance of certain materials at the landfill and at solid waste compactor sites; and

**WHEREAS**, prolonging the useful life of the County's sanitary landfill and solid waste compactor sites is in the best interest of the County's citizens and taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the County's Board of Commissioners wishes to alter its current ordinance relating to solid waste and the County's sanitary landfill and solid waste compactor sites in order to prohibit the depositing of those certain materials at the landfill and compactor sites so as to prolong the useful life of the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the County's Board of Commissioners believes that changes to its solid waste ordinance as described herein are in the best interests of residents and businesses of Hall County, Georgia, and would promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of such residents and businesses.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of Commissioners does hereby amend The Official Code of Hall County, Georgia as follows:

Section 8.60.300 (Forbidden deposits and prohibited actions at county disposal sites; deposit or storage of junk) is hereby amended by adding new subsections (A) 8 through (A) 16 which provide as follows:

8.60.300 – Forbidden deposits and prohibited actions at county disposal sites; deposit or storage of junk.

A. ....

- "8. Boats of any size, including kayaks, canoes, flat bottom boats, and motorized boats;
- 9. Roofing shingles, tiles, and similar roofing materials;
- 10. Bulk Styrofoam, including Styrofoam used for floatation;
- 11. Pressurized tanks of any type, including air tanks, gasoline tanks, and propane tanks; and
- 12. Mobile homes.

The County's Board of Commissioners may, at their election, allow non-profit corporations or other charitable entities to deposit some or all of the above-referenced materials in exceptions for special events that serve community or civic purposes."

The remaining provisions of Section 8.60.300 of the Hall County Code of Ordinances shall remain as they were, unchanged by this amendment.
