Report of Public Hearing Held on June 1, 2022 Regarding the Issuance of up to \$12,000,000 in Principal Amount Gainesville and Hall County Development Authority Revenue Bonds (Lanier Christian Academy, Inc. Project), Series 2022

As the hearing officer designated by the Gainesville and Hall County Development Authority, T. Treadwell Syfan, legal counsel for the Authority, held a public hearing regarding the issuance of the above-captioned Bonds on the date set forth below. Mr. Syfan conducted the public hearing, held on June 1, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. at the Greater Hall Chamber of Commerce, 230 E. E. Butler Parkway, N.E., Gainesville, Georgia 30501, pursuant to notice published in the The Times on May 25, 2022. At 4:00 p.m. Mr. Syfan called the public hearing and stated that the purposes for which the Bonds are proposed to be issued are as follows: (i) refinancing and financing the planning, design, acquisition, construction, equipping and installation of a new academic campus, including real property, infrastructure, and academic facilities containing classrooms, a media center, a music room, a practice gym, and a cafeteria, which campus shall be located at 4937 Chestnut Mountain and 4883 Winder Highway, Flowery Branch, Hall County, Georgia, 30542 (the "Project"), to be used by Lanier Christian Academy as facilities to provide educational curriculum to individuals in the City of Flowery Branch, greater Hall County and neighboring areas, and (ii) paying the costs of issuance of the Bonds. Mr. Syfan then reviewed the notice published in the The Times. He then called for comment in favor of or against the issuance of the Bonds for the purposes set forth above. No comments were made by any one in favor of or against the issuance of the Bonds or the financing of the Project. Mr. Syfan then closed the public hearing.
