Crawford to rezone from Planned Commercial Farm District (PCFD) to Agricultural Residential- IV (AR-IV) on a 3.19± acre tract located on the south side of Henson Road approximately 358 feet from its intersection with Fields Road; a.k.a. 5727 & 5769 Henson Road; Zoned PCFD; Tax Parcel 12044 000016 & 12044 000001 (pt.). Proposed use: homestead. Commission District 3.

Application of Jamie T. Crawford to rezone from Planned Commercial Farm District (PCFD) to Agricultural Residential-IV (AR-IV) on a 3.19± acre tract located on the south side of Henson Road approximately 358 feet from its intersection with Fields Road; a.k.a. 5727 & 5769 Henson Road; Zoned PCFD; Tax Parcel 12044 000016 & 12044 000001 (pt.). Proposed use: homestead. Commission District 3.

At their July 5, 2022 meeting, the Hall County Planning Commission voted to recommend approval (3-0) of this request with the following three (3) conditions:

- 1. A new plat shall be recorded prior to the issuance of any building permits.
- 2. The following statement regarding the potential impacts of agricultural operations in the area shall be made a part of any plat recorded on the property:

"Owners, occupants, and users of property shown on this plat are hereby informed of the impacts associated with normal farming practices which may take place on adjacent and nearby property including, but not limited to, noise, odors, dust, the operation of machinery of any kind, the storage and disposal of manure, and the application of fertilizers, herbicides, and pesticides. Therefore, owners, occupants, and users of the property shown on this plat should be prepared to expect the effects of such practices."

3. All conditions of zoning shall appear on any plat recorded for this property.

There were zero (0) written comments in opposition submitted in advance of the Planning Commission meeting and zero (0) people spoke in opposition during the public hearing on July 5, 2022.

There have been no changes to the request since the Planning Commission took action.
