Dear Mr. Teicher,

I am writing to you to express the City of Oakwood's support for Hall County's application for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Discretionary Grant Opportunity. This program is made available through the U.S. Department of Transportation, assistance listing #20.939. The purpose of the program is to support planning, infrastructure, behavioral, and operational initiatives to prevent death and serious injury on roads and streets involving all roadway users, including pedestrians; bicyclists, public transportation, personal conveyance and micromobility users; motorists; and commercial vehicle operators.

The City of Oakwood endorses the efforts of Hall County to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the SS4A and will support their application by partnering in the creation of the Action Plan for Hall County. This plan will be focused on preventing roadway fatalities and serious injuries throughout incorporated and unincorporated Hall County. The SS4A application requires 20 percent matching funds from applicants of the program and the City of Oakwood will participate by providing the matching funds required based on population within the City.
