Purpose of Request: Approve the application of the U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Action Plan Grant for the Hall County Public Works and Utilities Department in the amount of \$300,000.00 and if awarded, appoint the Grants Manager as the Program Designee and authorize the Chairman to execute all related application and award documents. A cash match of 20% is required and Hall County will provide \$44,352 of the match with the Cities of Gainesville, Flowery Branch, and Oakwood providing the remaining based on their population.		History: This is a new grant from U. S. Department of Transportation. Hall County has not received this funding in previous years.

Facts and Issues:

The purpose of SS4A grants is to improve roadway safety by significantly reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries through safety action plan development and implementation focused on all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, public transportation users, motorists, personal conveyance and micro mobility users, and commercial vehicle operators. The program provides funding to develop the tools to help strengthen a community's approach to roadway safety and save lives and is designed to meet the needs of diverse local, Tribal, and regional communities that differ dramatically in size, location, and experience administering Federal funding. The SS4A program provides funding for two types of grants: Action Plan Grants (for comprehensive safety action plans) and Implementation Grants. Action Plan Grants are used to develop, complete, or supplement a comprehensive safety action plan. To apply for an Implementation Grant, an eligible applicant must have a qualifying Action Plan. Grant Priorities: 1. Promote safety; 2. Employ low-cost, high-impact strategies that can improve safety over a wider geographic area; 3. Ensure equitable investment in the safety needs of underserved communities, which includes both underserved urban and rural communities; 4. Incorporate evidence-based projects and strategies; and 5. Align with the Department's mission and with priorities such as equity, climate and sustainability, quality job creation, and economic strength and global competitiveness. A 20% project match is required and can be in kind or in cash. Hall County will provide \$44,352, Gainesville will be providing 20.25% or \$12,148, Flower Branch will be providing 3.75% or \$2,251.00, and Oakwood will be providing 2.09% or \$1,249.00.
