

RESOLUTION GR-2022-09

Authorization to Partner, Submit and Accept Grant Funding for the Safe Streets and Roads for All Program

WHEREAS, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) passed by the United States Government established the new Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A program funds regional and local initiatives to prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries through the development of a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan will analyze roadway safety problems through an assessment of current conditions, engagement and collaboration with citizens, and project development; and


WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville desires to partner with Hall County to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety throughout the City of Gainesville and Hall County; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A grant program requires twenty percent matching funds from local jurisdictions that apply for and are awarded the grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville will apply with Hall County and provide matching funds required for the SS4A grant application based on population within each participating jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the governing body for the City of Gainesville hereby authorizes the Mayor, City Manager, and City Attorney to apply for, provide matching funds and accept grant funds for the Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program and to execute such documents that may be necessary to effectuate the approvals set forth in this Resolution.
