Purpose of Request: Approve the continuation award and any supplemental funding of the FY 2023 Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant for the Solicitor's Office to provide direct support to crime victims in the amount of \$158,844.00, and if awarded, appoint the Grants Manager as the Program Designee and authorize the Chairman to execute all related application and award documents. An match of \$37,711.00 is required.

History: The Solicitor's Office has received this funding since 2001.

Facts and Issues: The VOCA program, created in 1984, provides federal funding to support victims assistance and compensation programs, to provide training for diverse professionals who work with victims to develop projects to enhance victims' rights and services, and to undertake public education and awareness activities on behalf of crime victims.
