The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) is pleased to announce the FY2023 Call for Projects for transit funding under the following Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) programs: * Section 5303 Metropolitan Planning Program * Section 5304 Statewide Planning Program * Section 5307 Formula Grants for Small Urban Transit Program * Section 5311 Formula Grants for Rural Areas Program * Section 5339 Formula Grants for Program Bus and Bus Facilities Infrastructure Investments Program, Eligible recipients include states and federally recognized Indian Tribes, state or local government authorities, nonprofit organizations, and operators of public transportation services. Eligible activities include planning, operating and capital assistance, job access and reverse commute projects, mobility management activities and the acquisition of public transportation services.
