### Purpose of Request:

The Hall County Sheriff's Office has received this grant since 2016.

### Options:

Aggressive traffic (speeding and impaired driving) is one of the leading causes of crashes that result in serious injuries and fatalities on the roadways of Georgia. HEAT is designed to educate the public and enforce laws related to impaired and aggressive driving. Each officer is armed with materials to educate residents about state laws that regulate aggressive and impaired driving. Hall County uses the funding to pay for enforcement hours, vehicles and equipment maintenance and travel and training for the three officers. As the five year program continues Hall County's match portion will increase by 20%.
