To approve a Resolution objecting to the proposed annexation and rezoning by the City of Buford, Georgia, of the property located at 5659 Holiday Road, Hall County, Georgia (Hall County Tax Parcel 07299 003002), and authorization for the Chairman to sign all documents necessary to effectuate the objection, subject to the review and approval by the County Attorney.

History:

On or about October 4, 2022, the County received an initiation of Annexation pursuant to the 100% Application Method from the City of Buford as to the property, which included rezoning of the parcel to C-2 (General Business).

The property located at 5659 Holiday Road (Hall County Tax Parcel 07299 003002) is 1.21 acres, is zoned AR-III (Agricultural-Residential III), and is sought to be annexed and rezoned by City of Buford to C-2 (General Business).
