Hub City Baseball League League Overview

League Structure – Hub City Baseball League, Inc. (HCBL) was formed as a nonprofit organization for the purpose of organizing and running a competitive youth baseball league for 10U-14U teams in the Lubbock/ West Texas area.

Purpose – To provide a positive baseball experience for 10 thru 14 year old players in the Lubbock area who wish to participate in a competitive league whereby coaches and players can form their own teams. The League was initially formed as a viable alternative to Little League's existing draft league format. HCBL places an emphasis on competition, sportsmanship, and respect – individually and for the game of baseball.

Management – The HCBL Executive Committee, consisting of approximately four (4) individuals, will be responsible for the operations of the League. The Executive Committee will ensure that the teams and participants adhere to and abide by the rules, regulations and policies of the League. Any protests and or disciplinary issues will come before the Executive Committee for resolution and enforcement.

Coaching Responsibilities - The Manager and Assistant Coaches (collectively Coaches) of each team must be leaders and must recognize that they hold a position of trust and responsibility. In addition to teaching the fundamentals of the game and handling the administrative tasks of registering their teams, the Coaches are expected to focus on the following tasks:

- Have fun and make the game fun for all the parents and players
- Be positive role models and teach respect for the game, players, coaches and officials
- Teach, encourage, and demonstrate teamwork and good sportsmanship
- Control parents and insist that they adhere to the same principles of sportsmanship

It is the policy of Hub City Baseball League that no person who has a history of sexual abuse toward children be given any volunteer responsibilities in the League.

Participation – Teams have been required to be registered and in good standing with either Fivetool or USSSA. Register your teams and submit your USSSA rosters on-line. Further, the teams will be required to collect and pay a league registration fee of \$1095 per team to HCBL. Team insurance, purchased through Fivetool or USSSA, naming HCBL and the City of Lubbock as an additional insured is required. All players on such teams shall meet the age requirements of a 10U, 11U, 12U, 13U or 14U team (10 - 14 years olds as of May 1 of the current season). Any and all players meeting these requirements are deemed eligible to participate in the League.

Each team will be responsible for paying a non-refundable deposit of \$250 to secure a spot. We will potentially limit the number of teams to 10-13. Each team will be responsible for selling one outfield sign sponsorship at \$350 per sign. Once the signs have been sold and money collected, the team will receive their \$250 deposit back. If a team does not sell their sign, the league will just keep the \$250 deposit. Additionally, teams will receive \$100 reimbursement of league fees for every sign sold in addition to the one required. Teams are responsible for their own uniforms and team equipment. Sign Sponsorships are due by NLT March 10th to ensure signs can be placed before the start of the season. All sponsors will also have their logo published on our league website.

Signups – Begin on December 13th and run through February 15th, 2022. *Coaches meeting to be held on Sunday, January 16th , at 6:00pm on Zoom or at 5614 126th St B-1.

Season – March 21 – May 24, 2020, approximately 8 games per team. Scheduling will be done to determine and match teams in divisions whereby teams will be competing with teams of similar abilities. Each team will play every team twice in their division. There will be an end of season tournament that will be championship style (single elimination) tournament play.

Rules of Play – See separate handout.

Hub City Baseball League Rules of Play for 2021 Season

Age Restrictions – 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 year olds as of April 30, 2022.

Roster Limits – No limits. A recommendation of 11 minimum players is suggested. Players shall only be permitted to play on a single team. Any roster additions or removals must be coordinated with the League Director. Roster changes must be approved by the Executive Committee. No mandatory play requirement.

Code of Conduct - HCBL emphasizes sportsmanship and stresses proper conduct by players, managers, coaches and spectators. Accordingly, HCBL will not tolerate inappropriate conduct at any time. Coaches are responsible for the behavior and conduct of his team's assistant coaches, players and fans. Ejections will result in a minimum one game suspension and additional penalties as deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee (see separate handout on ejections).

Game Limits - 6 innings with 1:45 minute time limit. Run rule of 15 after 3, 12 after 4 and 8 after 5. Extra inning games will consist of one inning of an "International tiebreaker" – last player to complete an official bat from the previous inning starts as a base runner on 2nd base. Games tied after one additional inning will be considered a tie. 10:30 pm curfew Sunday – Thursdays. 11:00 pm curfew on Friday and Saturdays.

Lineups – 8 player minimum to start the game and a team may finish with 1 less than started, subject to an out being recorded for each player less than 9. All players may reenter once in the same batting position. Extra Hitter (EH), Designated Hitter (DH) and bat the lineup options allowed.

Pitching Limits – HCBL will use a pitch count with Pitchsmart.com

Note: There are no catcher restrictions.

Field Sizes -50/70, 54/80 or 60/90 as available. Teams to designate their preference for home games.

Courtesy Runners –A player not in the game (Sub) may run for pitcher or catcher. If a team is batting a continuous line-up, the courtesy runner shall be the player whom recorded the previous out.

Bat Rules – 10u/11u/12u USSSA or USA -12 bat or hevier. 13u/14u Qualified BBCOR Bat -3 or have the USSSA mark -5, or a wood bat.

Fields – *Maxey Park* (28th & Quaker), *1585/Cooper Field* (FM 1585 and Milwaukee), *Hodges* (40th & University)

Davs of Game – Daily, Monday through Friday most weeks

Disciplinary Issues for Ejections

The Executive Committee met and, in an effort to reduce and hopefully eliminate ejections, unanimously approved the following penalties for player, coaches and fan ejections:

- Player must serve a minimum one game suspension and be cleared by the Executive Committee before playing another HCBL game. *Manager must contact league director to notify of player ejection within 24 hours of ejection, failure to do so will result in manager suspension and an additional game suspension for player.
- Coaches minimum one game suspension penalty and a \$50 fine for first offense, minimum of one game penalty and payment of \$250 fine for a 2nd offense subject to additional penalties as deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee. 3rd offense will result in manager/coach being removed from the league indefinitely.
- Fans if a parent or fan gets ejected, the child or relative of the fan/parent will also be removed from the game, a minimum one game suspension penalty and a \$50 fine for first offense, minimum of one game penalty, player ejection and payment of \$250 fine for a 2nd offense subject to additional penalties as deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee. 3rd offense will result in fan and player being removed from the league indefinitely.

Umpires who eject a player, coach or fan will be required to meet with Evan and/or the Executive Committee before umpiring another HCBL game. Any coach or player who has been ejected must contact League Director within 24 hours of ejection to discuss the issue to prevent any further penalties. A player, coach or fan who does not abide by the league disciplinary policies can be removed from the league indefinitely.

BACKGROUND CHECK GUIDELINES

Applications for all coaches and volunteers are subject to a background check. Applications will be rejected if applicant's record indicates a pattern of criminal behavior and/or applicant has committed any of the following crimes:

- Any offense against a child
- Any felony offense involving domestic violence
- Any sexual offense or is a registered sex offender
- Any acts of lewd or lascivious conduct
- Any offense involving use of firearm or deadly weapon
- Any offense involving stalking, kidnapping or harassment
- Any active warrants
- Any 2 convictions of misdemeanor assault
- Any 2 convictions of misdemeanor theft

Application will be rejected if applicant has committed any of the following within the past 2 years:

- Any single offense for DUI or DWI
- Any offense for possession of a controlled substance

Application will be rejected if applicant has committed any of the following within the past 10 years:

- Any 2 or more DUI or DWI
- Any felony offense

Any and all issues that fall outside of the current policy are to be addressed by the Executive Committee. All arrests must be reported to HCBL within 48 hours, at which time the person will be suspended until the case is reviewed.

HCBL does not discriminate against any person or persons, based on age, race, gender, religion, nationality, or ethnicity.
