Your Participation in the Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ) Means:

- Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ™) screenings will be completed on your child's overall developmental skills. These screens will identify your child's strengths as well as any areas where your child may need practice or support.

Giving Permission Means:

- You agree to participate in the ASQ™ developmental screening and agree to allow information from your child's ASQ and any referrals made by Metro United Way to be shared with Play Cousins Collective.
- Metro United Way's Developmental Screening Hub will contact you for future screenings. You can opt out of these future screenings at any time.
- Your child's ASQ™ results will not be released by MUW or Play Cousins to any other persons, programs, or schools without your permission.
- You always have access to all information collected by Metro United Way's Developmental Screening Hub about your child.
- You agree to ongoing communication and screenings through Metro United Way's Developmental Screening Hub.

How ASQ Information Is Shared:

WHAT IS DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENING?

Developmental screening empowers parents and caregivers in their child's early education by helping them understand how their child is growing and learning. Simply by playing games and answering questions, parents and caregivers can learn about their child's milestones such as smiling, waving, walking and talking. Developmental screening can also help parents and caregivers know what skills to focus on.

WHAT ARE THE AGES & STAGES QUESTIONNAIRES®?

The *Ages & Stages Questionnaires®* are questionnaires that help parents and caregivers identify a child's strengths and any areas that they could encourage and support. The questionnaires screen a child's ability to:

- Communicate
- Move
- Think
- Help themselves
- Interact with other
- Regulate emotions
- Adapt to their environment

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Children between the ages of two months and five and a half years of age and that live in our seven-county region of Jefferson, Oldham, Bullitt, Shelby in Kentucky and Harrison, Floyd and Clark in Indiana are eligible.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A CHILD NEEDS ENCOURAGEMENT?

That's okay! Every child develops at their own pace. Appropriate resources will be provided to support and encourage a child.

Did you know...

- 90% of a child's brain will develop before the age of five
- One in four children are at risk for developmental delays
- Less than half the children identified as delayed actually receive services before they start school
- Developmental screeners identify 70-80% of children at risk for delays
- Children who complete four or more questionnaires are more likely to be ready for kindergarten
- Intervention is likely to be more effective and less costly when it is provided earlier in life rather than later
