Sermon Outline for The Perfect Gift

Scripture: Matthew 1:21 (KJV) And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Subject: The Perfect Gift

Introduction: Often times we want what we don't need and need what we don't want.

Aim: For us to have A Perfect Christmas.

Definition: Perfect - That which is free from fault, or defect. Flawless.

[because *Perfect* can also infer completion, it should be recognized that we are incomplete without Jesus! No matter what material gift we get at Christmas]

Points to Consider:

We see . . .

1. Her Gift vs. His Gift

- A. Prophecy
- B. Purity

2. Human Gifts vs A Human Gift

- A. Product
- B. Person

3. The Human Gift became the Heavenly Gift

- A. Purpose
- B. Perfect

Note: In order to receive "The Perfect Gift" does not mean we have to be perfect; that's what makes it "The Perfect Gift".
