

Sergio Zingarelli Chianti Classico Gran Selezione 2013

BACKGROUND

Rocca delle Macie is one of the few wineries in Tuscany to put a Gran Selezione at the very top of their quality pyramid, versus an IGT / Super Tuscan. Warm, velvety and well-balanced with ripe red fruit flavors and a long finish

WINEMAKING & AGING

Hand harvested grapes are selected from Rocca delle Macìe's best vineyard site in Castellina in Chianti. Following fermentation, the wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barriques and refines an additional one year in bottle prior to release.

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red Intense, persistent red fruit with touches of spice Warm, velvety and well-balanced with ripe red fruit flavors and a long finish
