

Gran Duque d'Alba Oro

BACKGROUND

Gran Duque d'Alba Oro is an ultra-premium Brandy de Jerez. It is similar to Gran Duque d'Alba Solera Gran Reserva, but matured and aged for an average of 25 years. It is produced at the Williams & Humbert Bodega, in Jerez, Spain, using the traditional system of criaderas and Solera. The brand was first launched in 1945 and named for the Grand Duke of Alba, Fernando Ivar de Toledo y Pimentel. It is aged in American Oak casks that previously held palo cortado Sherry, and has an intense nose with notes of vanilla, raisin and plum. Best served at room temperature and excellent for special occasions.

TASTING NOTES

Old mahogany with ebony highlights. Intense nose with notes of vanilla. Lavishly complex with a velvety, long, creamy finish.
