PORTICO KIDS strives to glorify God by providing every child with a Biblical understanding of our triune God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit through the teaching and application of God's Word. We equip and encourage parents to be the primary spiritual influence in the life of their child.



#### **Infants - 1 Year 11 months**

The Nursery is a loving place for our youngest Portico kids. Volunteers in the Nursery will spend time playing, talking, reading, singing, and praying with our little ones. Napping is a common pastime in the Nursery, and there is a dedicated room for sleeping babies and nursing mothers.

#### 2 Year Olds - 3.5 Year Olds

Kids in Early Preschool are able to engage in free play for the first part of service. About halfway through service, while our kiddos snack, Volunteers share a Bible story and an optional art/craft activity. Volunteers will also pray for and with the children. Kids will continue to play until pickup.

#### **Late Preschool - 3.5 Year Olds**

When kids arrive in their room, their Sunday School teacher will lovingly get them engaged in a hands-on activity. Their teacher will share that week's Bible story, and then they will participate in developmentally appropriate activities for smaller groups and include free play. Praying with and for our children is also emphasized.





#### **Kindergarten-Fourth Grade**

In the elementary years, students are greeted by their Sunday School teacher upon arrival in their classroom. They participate in team building activities that help foster lasting Christian friendships. PORTICO KIDS' curriculum, The Gospel Project by Lifeway, takes our children on a three-year journey through the entire Bible. As the class works through the Bible, their teacher will share that week's Bible story, lead discussions about the Scripture, and help the children learn a memory verse about our loving Heavenly Father. They will then participate in developmentally appropriate games, activities, and crafts.

#### **Fifth Grade**

Our fifth graders finish their PORTICO KIDS' tutelage with a year of deep theological study using the New City Catechism curriculum. These students form close bonds as they discuss and learn about the fundamentals of the Christian walk and what it means to be a disciple of Christ. Children also learn about the sacraments of baptism and communion.

## **Promotion**

Birth - 2 years move to the next level class on their birthdays.  $3\frac{1}{2}$  - 5th grade will have a promotion day each fall at the beginning of the school year. We will notify you when it's time to move your child to the next level class.

## CHECK-IN & PICK-UP GUIDE

## Check-In



You will check-in your child/children at one of the iPads or with a Coordinator. You will be issued a security sticker to be placed on your child/children and a corresponding sticker for you for pick-up. In addition to iPad check in, children will be checked off an attendance sheet in their room by a Volunteer to create an accurate roster in each classroom in the event of an emergency.

If we need to contact you during the service, your child's number will be placed on the screens. Proceed to the PORICTO KIDS entrance and ring the doorbell to gain access and attend to your child.

## Pick-Up

Children will be released from their classrooms ONLY to an adult with their corresponding security sticker. If an adult attempts to pick up a child without the corresponding security sticker, or if the child's security sticker has been lost, you will see the Coordinator, show them a picture I.D., and be issued a new sticker.



## **POLICIES**

#### ALLERGIES **O1.**

We are a peanut free environment. No items containing or processed in a factory with nuts may be used or consumed in PORTICO KIDS. Notify your child's teachers of any allergies your child may have.

#### RESTROOM

02.

Please take your child to the restroom prior to class, particularly if he/she is potty training. Otherwise, we will tend to their needs.

#### **ILLNESS**

03.

Please do not bring your child to class if he/she has any of the following symptoms: rash, lice, fever, sore throat, eye drainage, diarrhea, vomiting, persistent cough, or nasal secretions that are discolored.



#### **SAFETY**

04.

Please do not enter the classroom without permission from the Coordinator or Director. Only screened ministry workers may be in the room. Never leave the property while your child is in class

#### **EMERGENCY**

05.

In case of an emergency, follow all directions given by a church leader from the platform. This will facilitate the safety of your children.
