RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Classes will be guided by USEF Rules & Regulations. (PLEASE NOTE NEW COVID 19 REGULATIONS)**
 - a. **PRE-ENTRY WILL BE REQUIRED TO MINIMIZE THE TRAFFIC IN THE SHOW OFFICE**
2. **TIME SCHEDULE:** Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class at its discretion in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management also reserves the right to cancel or combine any class having less than three (3) entries. Time schedules & order of classes are subject to change after the close of entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check the time schedule.
3. **Stalls** and Tack Rooms will be available. \$150 fee. **Bedding not included.** Please call Country Hills Feed (831) 722-6588 for delivery of bedding and feed. \$40 per day haul-in fee if you are not boarding in a stall.
4. **Courses** will consist of any of the following combinations: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post/Rails, Coops, & Walls.
5. **Conflicts:** It is the intention of Management to avoid holding rings to wait for horses &/or riders. Exhibitors with conflicts must arrange their jumping order with the starters so they will not delay a class. **We will be enforcing a one (1) minute gate call.**
6. **Dogs** and all other pets must be leashed and in the control of a competent person at all times.
7. **Returned Check Fee:** \$25.00 Returned Check Charge. No personal checks accepted for payment of returned checks.
8. **Attire: Protective headgear is always mandatory for ALL riders, whether showing or schooling.**
9. **Full Payment** must accompany entries along with a **Signed Release of Liability. (NO EXCEPTIONS!!!)**
10. **All trainers and riders must leave an open check upon registration for any add/drop changes and incidentals incurred throughout the show. (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Jumpers: All Jumper Tables may be used.

Hunters: To be judged on performance & soundness. Emphasizing manners; penalizing extreme speed.

Equitation: To be judged on hands, seat, & horsemanship. Individual work will be at Judge's discretion.

Walk Trot: If rider cross enters out of Walk Trot Div., or Ground Rails Div., rider is ineligible for Champion or Reserve Champion in Walk Trot Div.

Lead Line: Rider may not enter in any other classes except for Classes # 67, 68, 69

Walk Only: Rider may only cross enter into Lead Line.

Maiden: Not to have won more than one blue ribbon at any horse show

Novice: Not to have won more than 3 blue ribbons at any horse show

SPECIAL CLASSES

Class #28A - \$5.00 Dollar Bill Bareback Special, Walk/Trot – Bareback riding. Place \$5.00 bill under your leg. Last two riders that hold on to their \$5.00 bill are winners! All entries split 1st place – 60%, 2nd place 40%. **Entry fee is your \$5.00!**

Class #28B - \$5.00 Dollar Bill Bareback Special, Walk/Trot/Canter – Bareback riding. Place \$5.00 bill under your leg. Last two riders that hold on to their \$5.00 bill are winners! All entries split 1st place – 60%, 2nd place 40%. **Entry fee is your \$5.00!**

(Please note, if fewer than 9 entrants, classes #28A & #28B will be run together)

CLASSES 800-802 - Special Equitation Challenge – Four Phases – Phase 1 – written quiz handed out in the show office. Must be turned in by 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 17. Phase 2 – Class 800 – Over Fences 2'3" – 2'9" (same fence height that horse and rider are currently showing). Phase 3 – Class 801 – Gymnastics, Phase 4 – Class 802 – Special Equitation Challenge on the Flat . Championship is the total of accumulated points from all classes plus the written test. \$60 TOTAL –ALL 4 PHASES.

CLASS 600, 601 - \$300 Hunter Derby : JR/AA 2'3, 2'6", 2'9", 3'. Consists of two rounds Sunday morning. Option fences in all phases of the derby could include hay bales, brush, logs, or other various natural fences. Winner will be chosen using the cumulative scores of both rounds. \$300 will be awarded with **10 or more riders.** With 9 or less riders \$150. **PRIZE MONEY TO BE SPLIT BETWEEN TOP 8.** Distributed 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 15%, 4th 10%, 5th 7%, 6th 6%, 7th 5%, 8th 5% **Entry \$50**

Class #700 - Versatility (In Western/Out English): After performing on the rail in **Western** attire, riders will line up for review. Upon an audible signal, riders will have exactly 8 minutes; change into English attire & tack. Each entry may have two handlers to assist with tack change. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).

Class #701 – Hunter Under Saddle Championship – Must have 5 entries prior to \$100 prize money being awarded. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).

Class #702 – Hunt Seat Equitation on the Flat Championship - Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40**).

Class #710 - \$250 "Wild Card" Gambler's Choice: To be shown over a course of 10 obstacles, .90 - 1 meters. Each obstacle will have a point value. Each rider will be allowed 50 seconds in which to accumulate as many points as possible after crossing (in either direction) the starting & finishing line. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only, either direction. After crossing the finishing line, each competitor will have the option of attempting, within 25 seconds, the **Joker Obstacle** which will have a point value of **200. JOKER FENCE WILL BE SET AT 1.05 meters!** Time will decide in the event of a tie. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th place. **Must have 5 or more entries for \$250 prize money being awarded.** \$250 prize money split between top 5 1st-40%, 2nd-30%, 3rd- 15%, 4th 10%, 5th-5% . (**Entry Fee - \$40**). Horse, but not rider, may cross enter **Class #711 (\$100 Child/Adult Mini Gambler's Choice)**.

Class #711 - \$100 Child/Adult Mini Gambler's Choice: To be shown over a course of 10 obstacles, .80 - .90 meters. Each obstacle will have a numerical point value. Each competitor will be allowed 50 seconds in which to accumulate as many points as possible after crossing (in either direction) the starting & finishing line. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only, either direction. After crossing the finish line, each competitor will have the option of attempting, within 25 seconds, the **Joker Obstacle** which will have a point value of **200. JOKER FENCE WILL BE SET AT .90 meters"** Time will decide in the event of a tie. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **Must have 5 entries prior to \$100 prize money being awarded.** \$100 prize money split between top 5. prize money split between top 5 1st-40%, 2nd-30%, 3rd- 15%, 4th 10%, 5th-5%. (**Entry Fee - \$40**). Horse, but not rider may cross enter **Class #710 (\$250 "Wild Card" Gambler's Choice)**.

Class #712 - Teams of 2/Relay (UP TO 2'6" OPEN): " Team will consist of 2 Riders/1 Horse. Riders may compete on multiple teams. Horses only go 1 time. First Rider goes through start line & time starts. Rider jumps a course of 6 fences & goes to the designated area. Second rider mounts the horse & jumps the second half of the course & goes through the finish line where time stops. Rider must mount/dismount in designated area or be penalized with 30 seconds added to teams final time. Refusals and rails will be penalized by time adding **5 seconds** for each instance, each rider may have 3 stops before elimination. Winner is the team with the fastest time & least faults (rails down). Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th (**Entry Fee - \$40 per team**).

Class #713 - MINI Teams of 2/Relay(UP TO 2'-2'3"): Team will consist of 2 Riders/1 Horse. Riders may compete on multiple teams. Horses only go 1 time. First Rider goes through start line & time starts. Rider jumps a course of 6 fences & goes to designated area. Second rider mounts the horse & jumps the second half of the course & goes through the finish line where time stops. Rider must mount/dismount in designated area or be penalized with 30 seconds added to teams final time. Refusals and rails will be penalized by time adding **5 seconds** for each instance, each rider may have 3 stops before elimination. Winner is the team with the fastest time & least faults (rails down). Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **Rider may not cross enter class #207. Riders not to have shown 2'6" or higher. (Entry Fee - \$40 per team).**

Class #704 - Pairs Jumpers (UP TO 2'6" OPEN) (Entry Fee - \$40 per team) Team of two horses and two riders. Each horse and rider jumps their own course and then must jump the last fence together. 2'6" – Fastest clean round wins. Rider may compete on multiple teams but must change one rider. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th

Class #703 - MINI Pairs Jumpers (2'-2'3") (Entry Fee - \$40 per team) Team of two horses and two riders. Each horse and rider jumps their own course and then must jump the last fence together. 2'-2'3" – Fastest clean round wins. Rider may compete on multiple teams but must change one rider. Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons through 6th **Rider may not cross enter class #704. Riders not to have shown 2'6" or higher. (Entry Fee - \$40 per team).**

CLASS #454-Lindsay Ashbun Memorial Green Rider 2'0" Medal: Hosted at the Paso Park Schooling Show Series, the Paso Park B Series, and other regional shows, the Green Rider Medal features fences not to exceed 2'0" in height. Class is to be held over a hunter-style equitation style. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Alternatively, the course designer may choose to integrate the test(s) into the posted course. Tests may include USEF equitation tests 1-6 and 10-13. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights above 3'. Riders may not cross enter in the Paso Park Medal. Finals of the Green Rider Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump show. Points from shows hosting the medal between December 1 of the previous year through October 31 of the current year or at the Turkey Trot & Jump show are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st – 7pts, 2nd – 5pts, 3rd – 4pts, 4th – 3pts, 5th – 2pts, 6th – 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the Green Rider Medal Final. Any rider that has previously won the Green Rider Medal Final is no longer eligible to compete.

CLASS #330-Paso Park 2'6" Medal: Hosted at the Paso Park Schooling Show Series, the Paso Park B Series, and other regional shows, the Paso Park Medal features fences not to exceed 2'6" in height. A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order

for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Alternatively, the course designer may choose to integrate the test(s) into the posted course. Tests may include USEF equitation tests 1-17. This class may be run in either a jumper or hunter competition arena; jumper-style tack is permitted, no time allowed is to be considered. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter in the Lindsay Ashburn Memorial Green Rider 2'0" Medal. Finals of the Paso Park Medal will be held at the Turkey Trot & Jump show. Points from shows hosting the medal between December 1 of the previous year through October 31 of the current year or at the Turkey Trot & Jump show are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st – 7pts, 2nd – 5pts, 3rd – 4pts, 4th – 3pts, 5th – 2pts, 6th – 1pt. Riders with 7 points or more are invited to participate in the Paso Park Medal Final. Any rider that has previously won the Paso Park 3' Medal Final is no longer eligible to compete.

CLASS #411-Cloverleaf Medal Open to junior and amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'7". To be judged over a jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control of the horse on a jumper type of ride. There will not be a time allowed, a tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties will be considered in accordance with USEF equitation rules. Additional work offs after the initial round will be at the judges discretion and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter and compete in the class. First and second place will qualify for the finals. Points awarded 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. Winner of the medal final class will receive a golf cart and a cooler. Prizes to 10th in the finals.

OCEAN BREEZE 2'6" MEDAL Hosted twice during the June and August Ocean Breeze Hunter/Jumper shows. The Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal will consist of a hunter course set no higher than 2'6". Fences can be any combination of: . Obstacles must simulate those found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, hedge, natural foliage, straw, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, logs, etc. At least three of the following: 1. Bending Line 2. Narrow Jump (5'6"-8') 3. Roll back turn 4. Fence at the end of the ring 5. Long approach to a single jump. Verticals may be built with or without ground lines. They may be jumped in either direction, provided ground lines are correct (i.e. no false ground lines). A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Work off will be a course design of the riders choosing and can include USEF Medal Tests 1-12. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights above 3'. Finals of the 2025 Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal will be held at the September Ocean Breeze Show during the Santa Cruz County Fair. Points from the current year (2025) Ocean Breeze qualifiers are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 4 points or more are invited to participate in the Ocean Breeze 2'6" Medal Final. Medal Finals in September will be two parts and over fences portion followed by a flat class top four to work off. Winners will be chosen by combined scores.

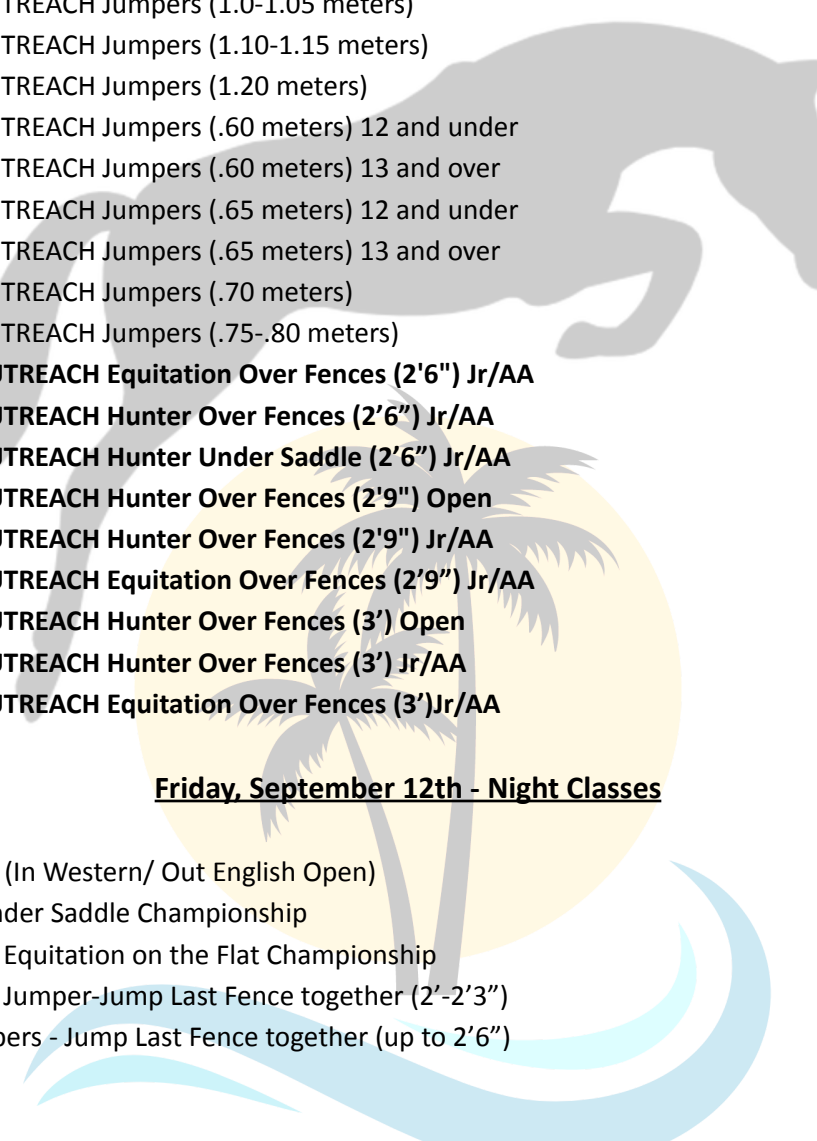
OCEAN BREEZE 2' MINI MEDAL Hosted twice during the June and August Ocean Breeze Hunter/Jumper shows. The Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal will consist of a hunter course set no higher than 2'. Fences can be any combination of: . Obstacles must simulate those found in the hunting field such as natural post and rail, brush, hedge, natural foliage, straw, stone wall, white board fence or gate, chicken coop, logs, etc. At least three of the following: 1. Bending Line 2. Narrow Jump (5'6"-8') 3. Roll back turn 4. Fence at the end of the ring 5. Long approach to a single jump. Verticals may be built with or without ground lines. They may be jumped in either direction, provided ground lines are correct (i.e. no false ground lines). A minimum of two riders must complete the course in order for the round to qualify for points. The top four riders (if available) in the class may be asked to work off at the judge's discretion. Work off will be a course design of the riders choosing and can include USEF Medal Tests 1-12. This class is open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed at heights 2'6" or above. Finals of the 2025 Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal will be held at the September Ocean Breeze Show during the Santa Cruz County Fair. Points from the current year (2025) Ocean Breeze qualifiers are eligible to qualify a rider for the Finals. Points are to be awarded as follows: 1st - 7pts, 2nd - 5pts, 3rd - 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. Riders with 4 points or more are invited to participate in the Ocean Breeze 2' Mini Medal Final. Medal Finals in September will be two parts and over fences portion followed by a flat class top four to work off.

CWD Woodside Medal - 2'3": Class is open to Junior & Adult Amateur riders only that are not showing in any 2'9" or above class. This class will be run in a hunter competition arena over an equitation course of fences with a minimum of 8 jumps not to exceed 2'3" in height. Tests may be included by the course designer and can include USEF equitation tests 1-17. Finals of the CWD Medal will be held at the Fall Finale show. All riders who have won a ribbon in a CWD Medal class during the regular season are automatically eligible to compete in the medal finals class at the Fall Finale. Finals will consist of two rounds, the first being a regular CWD Medal class which is open to all riders. The second round will be a work off/medal final round. Work off tests are allowed at the judge's discretion and can include USEF equitation tests 1-17. Winner of the finals will receive a voucher for a CWD bridle! Reserve champion will receive a saddle pad.
