DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

OUTREACH HUNTER DERBY

In order to participate in a Derby you must ride in a full division.
Fences at 2' or 2'6".

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

To be judged on position, performance, control of mount and correct style.

Leadline – Open to children 7 yrs and younger. May not cross enter into any other classes. Ties for Champion or Reserve will go to the rider with the most points in the WT class.

Walk-Trot – Open to riders of any age who have not yet shown at the canter in a horse show. May cross enter into any other WT classes as eligible.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Riders 10 yrs and under. To show over crossrails.

Long Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders of any age in their first or second year of showing. To show over crossrails. Trotting anywhere on course permitted.

Equitation - Open equitation. Fences 2' - 3'.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

To be judged on performance, manners and way of going.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 10 yrs and under, a simple course over crossrails. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'.

Modified Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies ridden by junior or adult amateur riders. Fences 2'.

Low Children's Hunter Pony - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. Pony/Rider combination may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter divisions.

Low Children's Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6". Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Children's Hunter divisions.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Children's Hunter - Open to junior riders. Horses 3', Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Low Childrens Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 3'. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Low/Pre-Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies starting training in the hunter division. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. To show over crossrails with groundlines.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences, who have not shown over fences 2'9" or higher. Section A: 2', Section B: 2'6". Simple changes of lead not to be penalized. May be split into two divisions if entries warrant.

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to any registered and non-registered thoroughbreds. Fences 2'3".

Low Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies to be ridden by juniors, adults or professionals. Fences 2'6"-2'9".

PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Judged on manners, suitability, performance and kindness. Division will be split if entries warrant either by horse and pony, or junior and adult rider.

Pleasure Horse or Pony - Open to all riders of any age or qualification on a horse or pony. Division to be a walk-trot class, a walk-trot canter class and a class of a simple course at 2' without oxers.

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Open to horses and ponies. 2.2.c format is known as power and speed. Format 2.1 is known as speed.

HUNTER CLASSICS & DERBIES SPECIFICATIONS

Children's Hunter Horse Classic 3' - Open to Junior riders on horses. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. Classic can be run separately or combined with Ponies and/or Adult Hunters. Prize money is optional. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Children's Hunter S/M/L Pony Classic (2'6" large / 2' small/medium) - Open to Junior riders on small, medium, or large ponies. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. A separate Classic may be run for Small/Medium and Large ponies. Classic can be run separately or combined with Children's Horse and/or Adult Hunters. Prize money is optional. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Adult Hunter Classic 3' - Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses. To be run as a two-round classic. Round one may be a designated over-fences class from the regular division. Classic can be run separately or combined with Children's Hunter Horses and/or Ponies. Prize money is optional. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Bit O' Straw Hunter Classic 2'6" - Open to Junior or Amateur riders. Two-round classic with option to do both rounds back-to-back. Fences 2'6". No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into The League's Children's Horse or Adult Hunter Classic. No cross entry of rider into any rated hunters or any class with fences of 3' or higher. Exception: Children's Pony, Low Children's, Low Adult or USHJA Hunter up to 2'6". Prize money is optional.

Pre-Child/Adult Hunter Classic 2' - Two-Round Classic. May be conducted as a separate two-round classic or if offering a division, round one may be a designated over-fence class with a separate second round outside of the division. Open to Adult Amateur and Junior riders. No cross-entry of rider into any Rated Hunter section with the exception of Low Child Adult Hunter and USHJA Hunter up to 2'6". No crossentry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 2'6". Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Low/Novice Children's Hunter Classic 2'6" - Two-Round Classic. May be conducted as a separate two-round classic or if offering a division, round one may be a designated over-fence class with a separate second round outside of the division. Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 3'0". Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable. May be combined with Low Adult Hunter Classic.

Low/Novice Adult Hunter Classic 2'6" - Two-Round Classic. May be conducted as a separate two-round classic or if offering a division, round one may be a designated over-fence class with a separate second round outside of the division. Open to Amateur riders on horses or ponies. No cross-entry of horse/rider combination into any classes where fences exceed 3'0". Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable. May be combined with Low Children's Hunter Classic.

Tiny Bit O' Hunter Derby 2' -Two-round Classic. Fences 2' with 2'4" Options. Open to Junior and Amateur riders on Horses and Ponies exclusively at HITS Horse Shows. Horse/pony must have entered in two classes over fences at the same show. No cross entry of rider into any class with fences at 2'6" or higher. Round 1 Classic. Round 2 Handy.

Bit O' Straw Hunter Derby 2'6" - Two-round Classic. Fences 2'6" with 2'9" Options. Open to Junior and Amateur riders on Horses or Ponies. Horse/pony must have entered in two classes over fences at the same show. No cross-entry of rider into any class with fences at 2'9" or higher. Round 1 Classic. Round 2 Handy.

Short/Long Stirrup Classic - Two Round Classic. Fences 18 inches. Open to Junior and Amateur riders on Horses or Ponies. Horse/pony must have entered in two classes over fences at the same show. No cross-entry of rider into any class with fences at 2'0" or higher.

Leadline - To be judged on the manners and suitability of pony/horse to rider. Children riding in this class are not eligible to compete in any other class.

JUMPER CLASSICS SPECIFICATIONS

Tri-Level S/M/L Pony Jumper Classic (.70m/.80m/.90m) - Open to Small, Medium and Large ponies with fence heights to be as follows: Small .70m, Medium .80m and Large .90m. Courses will not include combinations If a Classic is not offered, points may be accrued in Tri-Level Pony Jumper classes offered. Ponies may not cross enter into Itty Bitty Jumper Classic. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Itty Bitty .65m Jumper Classic - Jumps not to exceed 0.70m. Open to all horses and ponies. If entries warrant, classic will be split by Junior and Amateur.. Courses will not include oxers or combinations. Prior to competing in Itty Bitty Jumper, riders may not cross entry into classes exceeding .90m in height at the same competition. Riders may move up to compete in classes with higher heights at the same competition but will no longer be eligible to compete in the division for the remainder of the competition. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Intermediate Junior/Adult Amateur .80m Jumper Classic - Open to Junior or Amateur Adult riders. If entries warrant, classic will be split by Junior and Amateur. Horse/Rider combination must have entered in at least one other jumper class at the show and may not show in any class with fences 1.0m or higher. Table II.2.a/b. 0.80m. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Junior/Adult Amateur .90m Jumper Classic - Fences .90m - Open to Junior or Amateur Adult riders. If entries warrant, classic will be split by Junior and Amateur. The horse must have shown in at least one other Jumper Class at the same show. Horse/Rider combination may only compete in one Jumper Classic at the same show. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

Junior/Adult Amateur 1.0-1.05m Jumper Classic - Fences 1.0m - 1.05m - Open to Junior or Adult Amateur riders. If entries warrant, classic will be split by Junior and Amateur. The horse must have shown in at least one other Jumper Class at the same show. No cross-entry into the 1.15m or .90m Jumper Classic at the same show. Bonus points will be awarded to the division champion and reserve when applicable.

EQUITATION MEDALS SPECIFICATIONS

Adult Medal 3' Sponsored by Dover Saddlery™ - Open to Adult Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all

phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Pony Medal.

Children's Horse Medal 3' Sponsored by Pyranha™ – Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing in any Hunter or Equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the The League Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with Adult 3'0" and/or Pony Medal.

Adult 2'6" Medal – Sponsored by Sidelines Magazine – Open to Adult Amateur Riders who are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May ONLY be combined with The League Children's 2'6" Medal.

Children's 2'6" Medal –Sponsored by Sidelines Magazine – Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into The League Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May ONLY be combined with The League Adult 2'6" Medal.

Junior/Amateur Horsemanship Medal 3' – Open to Juniors and Amateurs. No cross-entry restrictions. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences including at least one combination (a double and a triple are preferred) and two changes of direction after the first fence. At least 12 riders, if available, return to show on the flat. Flat phase to include the working walk, trot sitting, trot rising, showing a lengthening of stride, working canter, working canter showing a lengthening of stride, and the counter canter (no more than 12 to counter canter at the same time). The same horse must be used in all phases. Riders may cross-enter into one Medal section. Running martingale or standing martingale allowed in the jumping phase. No martingales allowed in the flat phase. Change of bridle is permissible between phases.

Children's Large Pony Medal 2'6' & Children's S/M Pony Medal 2' – Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course for points to count. No cross-entry of rider into the Pyranha™ Children's Horse Medal or Children's 2'6" Medal at the same show. May be combined with The League Children's Horse Medal and/or The League Adult Medal. *Fence heights are suggested and should be used whenever possible. If Children's Pony specs. differ, show management may offer fence heights according to those specifications.

Pre-Child/Adult Medal 2' –Open to Adult Amateur and Junior Riders who are not competing at the same show in any class with fences exceeding 2'6". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 2' including at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse or pony. Three riders must complete the course for points to count. May not be combined with another class.

THOROUGHBRED INCENTIVE PROGRAM (TIP) SPECIFICATIONS

OVERALL HIGH POINT AWARDS

TIP Junior Rider High Point Award – The Jockey Club T.I.P. Junior Rider High Point Award will be given to the Thoroughbred/rider combination accumulating the most points where the rider is 18 years old or younger. A high point ribbon and medal will be provided to the winning horse and rider.

TIP High Point Thoroughbred Award – The Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Award will be given to the highest placing Thoroughbred at the competition (regardless of discipline/division). A high point ribbon will be provided for each award.

TIP High Point Thoroughbred Hunter Award – The Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Hunter Award will be given to the Hunter Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Hunter classes. A high point ribbon will be provided for each award.

TIP High Point Thoroughbred Jumper Award – The Jockey Club T.I.P. High Point Thoroughbred Jumper Award will be given to the Jumper Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Jumper classes. A high point ribbon will be provided for each award.

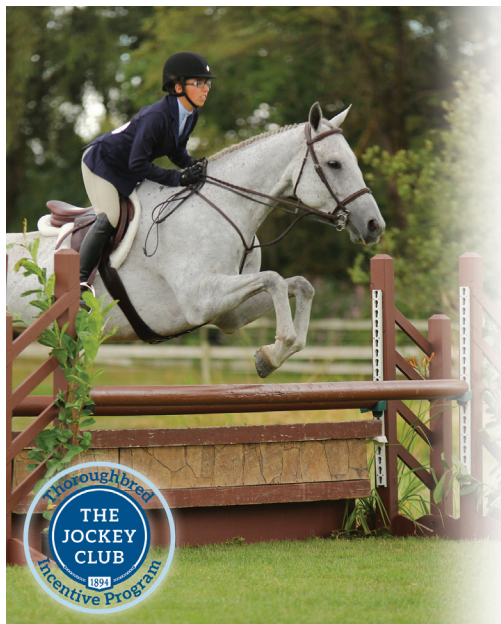
HUNTER DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

TIP Beginning Thoroughbred Hunter Division – Fences not to exceed 2'3" in height. Shall consist of three classes—two (2) over fences and one (1) under saddle. Jump courses should consist of at least seven (7) jumps, to be judged on manners, pace and way of going unless otherwise noted. Under saddle class to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions, and to be judged on manners, movement and way of going. Ribbons for 1st through 6th place for each class and Champion/Reserve ribbons will be provided. T.I.P. Championships division.

TIP Open Thoroughbred Hunter – The Jockey Club T.I.P. Open Hunter Division allows a show to run a Thoroughbred division open card at several heights, as defined in the show's prize list. Horses will be placed in two (2) over fences and one (1) under saddle classes. Jump courses should consist of at least seven (7) jumps, to be judged on manners, pace and way of going unless otherwise noted. Under saddle class to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions, and to be judged on manners, movement and way of going. 3 sets of ribbons for 1st through 6th place and one set of Champion/Reserve ribbons will be provided.

JUMPER DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

TIP Thoroughbred Jumper Division Open Height – The Jockey Club T.I.P. Thoroughbred Open Height Jumper. Ribbons for 1st through 6th place for 2 classes and a Champion/Reserve will be provided. T.I.P. Championships division

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ENTRY FEES

\$25 per class | \$40 Grounds/EMT Fee will be charged per entry.

Entries close at 9:00 pm on Thursday before show date.

Post entries of additional horses, if time permits, will be charged \$20.00 per horse.

No same-day walk-in entries can be accepted. Changes to an existing entry are of course permitted.

Divisions will be split or combined as entries warrant.

All divisions will pin a Champion and Reserve Champion.

SCHOOLING

The show ring will be open on the morning of the show and at appropriate breaks between divisions.

Schooling sessions will be supervised by show staff.

USHJA OUTREACH & PHSA

All sections qualify for the Outreach Program except Leadline. Please see the show office for FREE membership into this fun program created by USHJA. This show is not rated by the USEF, and is part of the Regional High Score Program for the PHSA.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Horse Show Committee, the Horse Show organizers, Trails End Farm or property owners will not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/2025.
3. ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted. No exceptions.
4. The decision of a judge is final.
5. Make checks payable to: Alexis Liskey
6. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes to expedite the schedule.
Management reserves the right to change the ring assignments as appropriate to the weather and efficiency of the show. Management also reserves the right to close entries as necessary.
Please pre-enter to avoid any confusion.
7. The show rings will be open on the morning of the show and at appropriate breaks between divisions.
