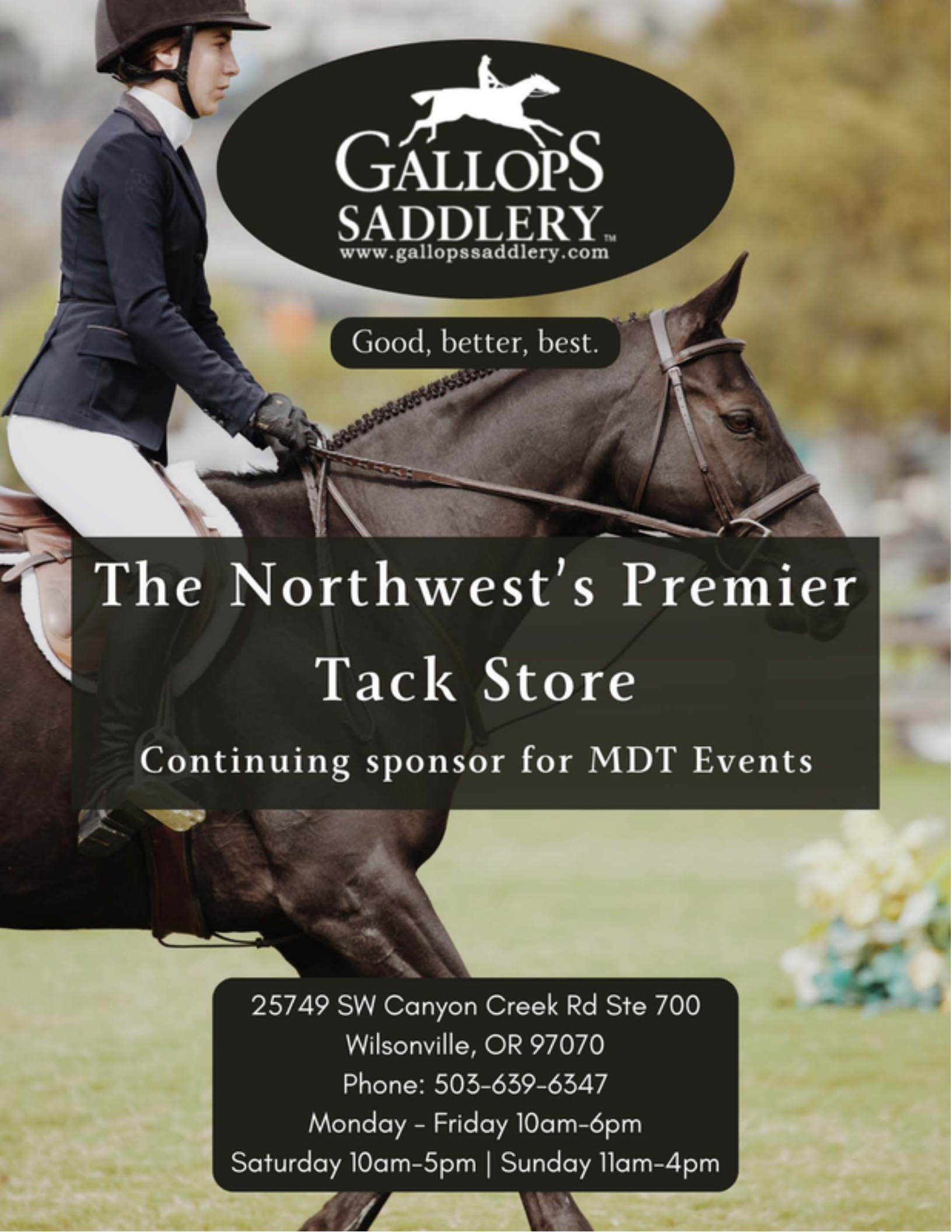

**Entries open four weeks prior to each show and close the Tuesday before each show.
Stalls are available to reserve, preference given to exhibitors showing all weekend.
Each entry requires a \$150 deposit.**

sign & submit your documents

In order to expedite check in, all release forms should be submitted via RingRadar

In order to mount on property, you must have been issued a number from the show office. Those who submit documents ahead of time will be able to pick up their numbers without waiting in line

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

\$50 USHJA Hunter Derby (\$50) - Open to Juniors, Amateurs, and Professionals. The course will consist of hunter classic and hunter handy style lines, turns and jumps with options set at 3" of greater height; one point will be added for each high option fence. The judge will use the open numerical scoring system. Winner take all.

\$80 MDT Jackpot Jumper Classics (\$50) - Open to Juniors, Amateurs, and Professionals. All classes run as Table II, Section 2b. Winner takes all. Must have 4 riders to pay out. Horse/rider pairs are limited to 2 Classics per show and must participate in at least 1 standard class.





CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

OHJA Foundation Medal (\$50) - Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Fences not to exceed 2'3". At Outreach shows, not less than two (2) fences must be 2'3" in height. No cross entry at same show with fences 2'6" or higher. Courses may include x-rails. No oxers, in-and-outs or combinations permitted on course. Ride off required for at least the top 2 riders

OHJA Mini Medal (\$50) - Open to Juniors and Amateurs. Fences not to exceed 2'6". At Outreach shows not less than two (2) fences must be 2'6" in height. No cross entry with 3' medals. No one or two stride in-and-outs permitted on course. Ride off required for at least the top 2 riders

OHJA Low Jumper Medal (\$50)

1. OHJA Low Jumper Medal fence height is .70m and .80m. No oxers in the Low Jumper 23 Medal. Class to be held with .70m riders competing at their height and .80m riders competing at their height. Following the flat phase, which is held at the judge's discretion, the class shall be pinned as a combined class.
2. Cross Entry Restrictions: Riders may not enter a class at 1m or higher at that show.
3. Low Jumper Medal Final will be held at .75m and written test and flat phase is required for Medal Final.

High Jumper Medal (\$50)

1. OHJA High Jumper Medal fence height is .90m and 1.0m. Oxers may have a maximum spread of their respective height. Class to be held with .90m riders competing at their height and 1.0m riders competing at their height. Following the flat phase, which is held at the judge's discretion, the class shall be pinned as a combined class.
2. Cross Entry Restrictions: Riders may not enter a class at 1.10m or higher at that show.
3. High Jumper Medal Final will be held at .95m and written test and flat phase is required for Medal Final.

The OHJA Jumper Medal must be conducted over jumper fences. OHJA Jumper Medal shall be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgment and execution of an efficient, time saving pace and track. One (1) point will be subtracted from the rider's score for each commenced second over the time allowed and four (4) points will be deducted for each knockdown on course. Two refusals will incur elimination. Jumper tack must be in accordance with the USEF Rule JP 111, with the exception that no draw reins or German martingales are allowed. At the judge's discretion, there may be a flat phase following the over fences round.



FUN CLASSES!!

Each show will host one fun class as the show schedule allows. Show management will choose a class with a fun challenge.

These classes will be on the flat or non-mounted. Some examples: Ride A Buck, Rose All Day, Simon Says, Relay Race

The class fee is \$20 - half of all entry proceeds will be awarded to the winner(s), the other half will be banked and awarded to the recipient of the You're Golden Grant

YOU'RE GOLDEN GRANT

The You're Golden Grant was inspired by Meg Dunne and her horse of a lifetime, You're Golden ("Daisy"). Meg grew up with a deep love for horses but without the financial resources to regularly compete on the rated circuits. Together, Meg and Daisy worked their way up through the levels aided by local shows, guided by determination, hard work, grit, and a passion for the sport.

This grant is awarded each year to a rider who reflects that same spirit—someone who shows locally, works hard to pursue their goals, and dreams of doing bigger things in the sport despite financial limitations.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Must have attended 1 MDTE show in the year applying**
- 2. Special consideration for those who have volunteered in the local horse community**
- 3. A letter of recommendation is encouraged, but not required**
- 4. Send an email to: megdunnetrainingevents@gmail.com with a paragraph or two about your story and what you would plan to do with the funds.**
- 5. Open to juniors, seniors, and professionals**
- 6. Award to be announced at the final MDTE show of the year or no later than November 1st**

MDT Events LLC Release of Liability

ENTRY AGREEMENT: By entering a competition ("Competition") eligible for Oregon Hunter Jumper Association ("OHJA") and United States Hunter Jumper Association ("USHJA") points and signing this entry agreement, and on behalf of myself and my participants, representatives, employees and agents, I AGREE that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the OHJA and USHJA. I AGREE to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the OHJA and USHJA. I AGREE to release and hold harmless the OHJA, USHJA, Competition, and Competition Management described herein and their respective officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

OHJA AND USHJA RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER, AND INDEMNIFICATION. *This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.* I AGREE in consideration of my participation in the Competition, managed by Meg Dunne Training Events, LLC and located at premises operated by Meg Dunne Training, LLC and/or Heirloom Equestrian Center, LLC (collectively, "Competition Management"), to the following:

I AGREE the construction and application of OHJA and USHJA rules and the terms and conditions of this release agreement ("Release") are governed by Oregon law.

I AGREE that the OHJA and USHJA and Competition as used herein includes Competition Management, as well as their respective officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel and volunteers (collectively, the "Released Parties").

I AGREE that I am voluntarily participating in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including but not limited to broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Released Parties from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Released Parties.

I AGREE that I am expressly assuming all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Released Parties.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Released Parties and hold them harmless will respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition.

I AGREE that I am knowingly, voluntarily, and expressly waiving my right, and that of my representative, to bring or maintain any action against the Released Parties for any Harm to me or my horse, including for claims for negligence but excluding claims for gross negligence or intentional misconduct.

I AGREE that any legal action against the Released Parties must be brought in the State of Oregon.

I ACKNOWLEDGE that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and

I AGREE to all of the above provisions and I AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this Competition.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable OHJA and USHJA Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry agreement.

GENERAL INFO & RULES

Entries, Fees & Payment

- Entries are accepted online at Ringradar.com, entries close midnight Tuesday before each show.
- A show deposit of \$150 is due at the time of entry. If you need to scratch before the entry deadline, it will be refunded to you. Deposits for scratches after the entry deadline will not be refunded.
- All deposits will be applied to your show entry
- Accepted forms of payment in the show office are: Check, Venmo, and Cash. A \$75 fee for NSF checks will apply. Exact cash payments only.
- Transaction fees by payment method: Checks & Cash have no transactions fees. MDTE pays fees on Venmo transactions. Exhibitor pays fees on RingRadar transactions
- Back numbers will not be issued without release forms signed and submitted. You may not mount on property without a back number.
- A grounds fee of \$50 will automatically be charged to each horse/rider pair
- A USHJA fee of \$5 will automatically be charged to each horse
- Class Scratch Policy: No refunds for classes scratched after the division begins. You MUST scratch in the Show Office to receive a refund.
- \$25 fee for anyone who does not check out with the show office before the close of the show. The card on file will be charged on RingRadar and the fee applied to your show bill.

GENERAL INFO & RULES (cont'd)

Stabling

- Portable 10'x10' stalls with dirt floors are available for use at your own risk
- Tack stalls by request only at show management's discretion based on demand.
- Overnight stalls are \$85, weekend stalls (Friday - Sunday) are \$150
- Shavings are available for purchase for \$15 upon entry. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their stalls daily. Stalls will be stripped after your departure.
- Exhibitors to provide their own feed & water buckets, wheelbarrows, shovels, etc. The use of nails, screws, screw in hooks, staples, or similar is not permitted in the stalls. A \$50 per stall fee will be applied to anyone in violation
- Stalls not required. Haul-In fee \$25/day

- USEF rules will govern at judge's or management's discretion. Management may cancel, split, or combine classes.
- No oxers until 2'6" / .70m; no combinations until .90m
- All jumping classes are ran by sign ups at the back gate, we will run "open cards" to save time.
- All riders must wear an approved helmet and boots with a heel
- Standing and running martingales and boots permitted in all classes
- Management and Judge reserve the right to excuse exhibitors for inappropriate attire, tack, or horsemanship
- MDT Events LLC is not responsible for lost or stolen items
- Please leave your pets at home

Schooling

- Schooling areas will be available for use before and during the show. In the event of poor weather, the show ring will open between jump height changes for schooling. A select number of jumps will be available for schooling, the entire course will NOT be open

 - Friday 8am to 11:30am
 - Saturday 6am - 7:30am
 - Sunday 6am - 7:30am
- Longeing is permitted in the round pen. HELMETS MUST BE WORN WHILE LONGEING. In the event of poor weather show management will communicate longeing times

CODE OF CONDUCT

MDTE is committed to fostering a positive, supportive environment for horses and people alike. Participants are expected to treat themselves, their horses, fellow competitors, staff, and spectators with kindness and respect.

Negative, abusive, or slanderous behavior will not be tolerated and may result in dismissal from the current MDT event and possible exclusion from future MDT events.
