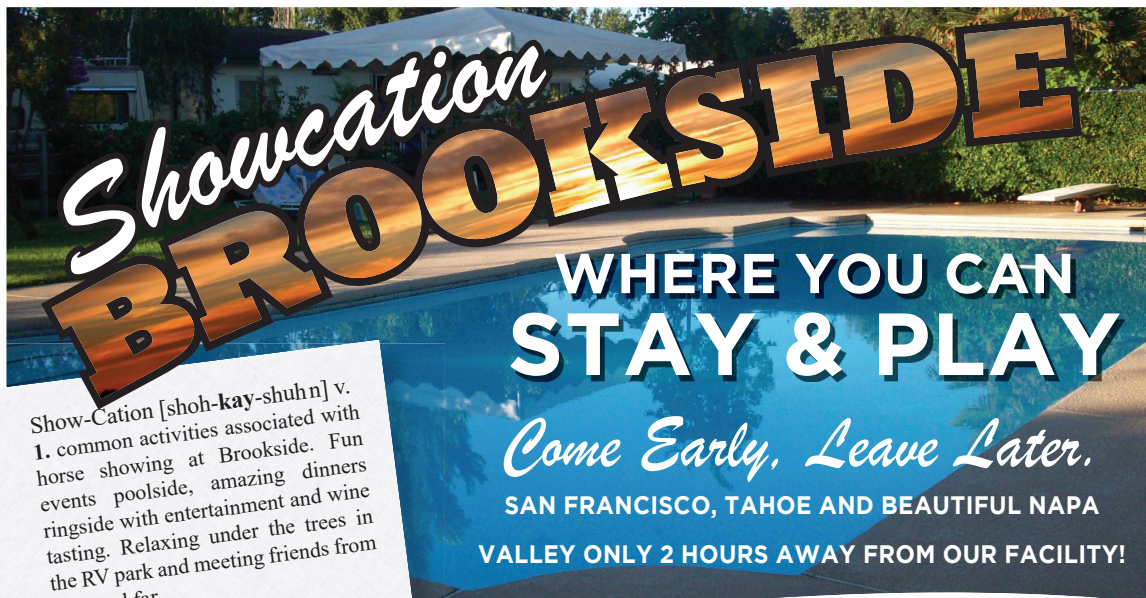

MADDEN CROSS RAIL MEDAL

Established in 2023 for the Jr/Am riders, in the name of William Bill” Madden, the owner of Brookside Equestrian Park for over 30 years. The Madden Cross Rail Medal is established to recognize and reward the performance of a junior / amateur rider who is starting, or returning to competition, and not competing over 18” from October finals to October finals. 3 riders must enter for the class to count as a qualifier.

Qualifying classes for the Medal Finals are offered throughout the show year at many shows, and any rider earning a ribbon (1st to 10th or 1st to 8th) at any show is qualified. Previous winners of the finals may not compete in the finals again. There is no membership in any association required.

Riders that have qualified and then show in 2ft height for any reason will be disqualified from competing for the Cross Rail Finals.

The finals class will be held at the Brookside Fall Finale in October. The finals will allow trotting and cantering on course and will be judged on a riders equitation over a

course of cross rail fences of not less than 8 fences, at a height of 18”, with at least (2) two additional equitation tests included in the course. An additional test will be required of the top 10 scoring riders after the first 2 rounds. The finals will be tallied and scored and the presentation of Champion, Reserve Champion and 3rd through 10th will be held. Riders are required to ride for the awards ceremony. Champion receives a Golf Cart. A rider who wins the Madden Medal Finals is no longer eligible to participate in any future finals. A perpetual plaque will be on display at Brookside Equestrian Park.

BROOKSIDE WORKING HUNTER DERBY CHALLENGE

**Brookside shows will be offering a new Hunter Derby
format competition at each one of our four shows:
Opening Day, Splash, Back To School, and Fall Finale**

All courses will offer authentic cross country, agility, and obedience. The test in each level of the competition will be suitable for that level. The Derbies offered will be 2’0 Jr/Am, open 2’6 & open 2’9/3’0 sections. A champion class will be held for each height at the Fall Finale. In this final class, the same format will be used as the previous classes with one exception – all entries will be judged together for this finals class.

The championship class will be a jackpot class. \$75 entry fee
with a \$25 ad back to the pot of 500.

Same horse and rider combinations may not cross enter 2’0 & 2’6 derbies.

Payout structure: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 10%, 5th - 7%, 6th - 6%, 7th - 5%, 8th - 5%

MEDAL SPECIFICATIONS & SPECIAL CLASSES

HORSE & HOUND Jr/Am: Open to riders not showing 3'6 or higher at this show. Course of fences 3'0 with 2 tests included. Three riders must complete for class to count.

HORSE & HOUND PONY: Sm/M 2'0 Lg 2'6 2 tests included. Points and rules same as Horse & Hound Jr/Am.

ALMADEN FARMS JR/AM: minimum 8 fences at 2'9, with test built into the course. 2 Must compete and all ribbon winners qualify for the finals. Held at Beach Party.

CLOVERLEAF JUMPER CHALLENGE: open only to Jr/Am riders not showing in any jumper classes during this show year over 3'3" (1.00M). To be judged over a jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 2'7 (80m) in height. To be judged under the rules of any/all USEF jumper tables. Any jumper type bit or equipment is allowed except for draw reins. At least 2 riders must enter for the class to be a qualifier for the finals. All ribbon winners qualify for the finals. The Cloverleaf Challenge Finals will be held at Brookside during the Fall Finale. The finals will consist of 2 rounds, held over 2 separate days. With a final jump-off of the top 10 from the first 2 rounds combined scores and/

or all riders with combined clean round scores. Champion of the finals will earn a golf cart, second through 10th will all receive awards. Previous winners of the Cloverleaf Equitation Finale or the Jumper Champion are not eligible for the Cloverleaf Jumper Challenge Finals.

EQUITATION RIDE-OFF: All riders earning a ribbon in an equitation class at this show, either over fences or on the flat, all ages, invited to the ride-off. The ride-off will be on the flat. No entry fee.

THE MADDEN CROSS RAIL MEDAL: Riders in this medal may not be showing over 18" (XRail) during this show year. Open only to Jr/Am riders. Trotting and/or cantering on course allowed. To be judged on a rider's equitation over a course of cross rail fences of not less than 8 fences with at least two additional equitation tests included in the course. Any additional testing is at the judge's discretion. All riders earning a ribbon in the qualifying classes are qualified for the finals. At least 3 riders must enter the class for it to count as a qualifier. Finals will be held at the Brookside Fall Finale. The champion will earn a golf cart. Once a rider has won a Madden Medal Finals they are no longer eligible for the Finals.



CLASS #500, 501, 502 DERBY CHALLENGE Brookside shows will be offering a new Hunter Derby format competition at each one of our four shows. Opening Day Splash, Back To School, and Fall Finale.

Each Derby will have two judges (preferably) in the class one judge will judge the thoroughbred horses, and the other judge will judge all of the rest.

All courses will offer authentic cross, country, agility, and obedience efforts. The test in each level of the competition will be suitable for that level. The Derbies offered will be 2'0 Jr/Am, open 2'6 & open 2'9/3'0 classes.

Three separate derbies at each show with a growing level of difficulty for each height. Courses will include a minimum of eight efforts in the first round. All tests will be offered in the first round of the competition scores to be announced. After the first round

the top eight highest scoring entries will return for a second round, which will be a straightforward Hunter course of seven fences.

A champion class will be held for each height at the fall finale in this final class. The same format will be used as the previous classes with one exception - all entries will be judged together TB and Non TB for this finals class.

Champion of each class will be determined from the scores for thoroughbreds/non-thoroughbreds. A special prize will be awarded by TIP to the high scoring thoroughbred across all derby classes held at Brookside Shows.

The championship class will be a jackpot class. It will have a \$100 entry fee with a \$25 ad back to the pot of \$500.

Show management reserves the right to modify the class specifications prior to the start of the class.

Same horse and rider combinations may not cross enter 2'0 & 2'6 derbies. Payout structure: 1st - 30%, 2nd - 22%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 10%, 5th - 7%, 6th - 6%, 7th - 5%, 8th - 5%

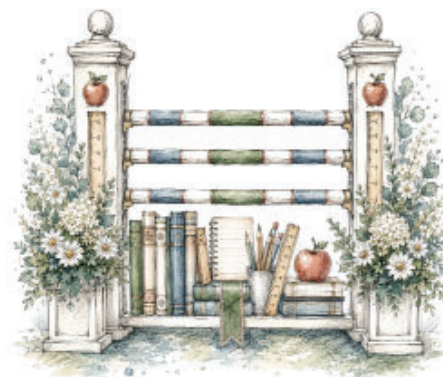

RULES OF SAHJA will be followed. Decisions of judges and management are final.

ENTRY FEES: All regular classes are \$35, see special classes for those entries. Stalls are available for \$200 for the show and \$50 per day for day stalls. A \$50 schooling fee, \$5 SAHJA fee, \$14 CA Drug fee will be charged to each horse. Checks should be made out to Brookside.

POST ENTRIES: will be accepted with no additional charge.

STALLS: exhibitors requiring stalls should notify the show of their stall requirements by July 31.

AWARDS: prizes to all 1st place winners, ribbons through 8th place in all classes.

DRIVERS: no one without a valid drivers license may drive any golf cart or car/truck on the show grounds.

SCHOOLING: rings will be available for schooling from 8am-10pm the day before the show and any morning or evening during the show when the rings are not closed.

ATTIRE: boots, collared shirts, USEF approved helmets, breeches required.

DOGS: all dogs must be on leashes, non-compliance will incur a \$50 fine.

Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined or canceled at management's discretion.

FEED/BEDDING & RV PARKING: For information related to feed and bedding as well as for golf cart, RV and/or space rentals, RV parking, contact the Brookside office at 916-682-1403.

REFUNDS: all refund requests should be submitted in writing. Any monies paid prior to July 31 closing date may be refunded.

PARKING AREAS: parking areas are designated and violators can be towed.

BARN AISLES: no vehicles or trailers of any kind allowed in barn aisles.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: all non-showing horses must complete a "non-showing" form, sign a release, pay a \$50 facility fee if not using a stall and pay a \$50 schooling fee.

ADD/SCRATCHES: allowed at the gate, but must be completed in the office by 4pm daily to avoid being charged. **On Sunday, no add/scratches allowed at the gate.**
