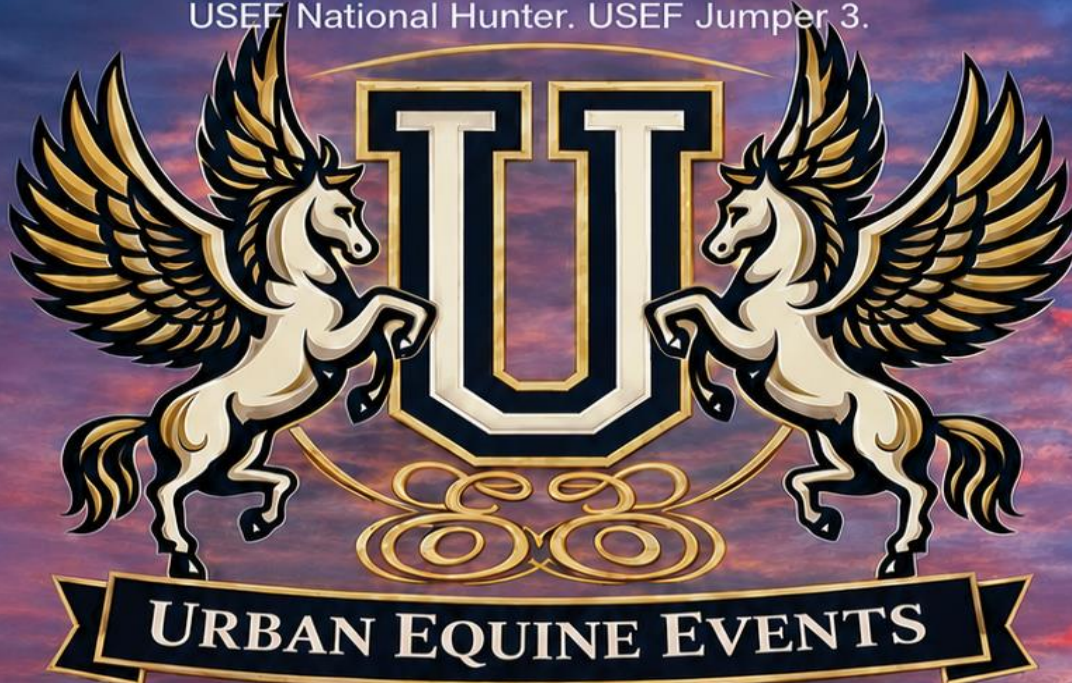

RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, the horse show management shall settle any dispute or question and the decision shall be Final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition of admission, shall consent to such methods of settlement. GR901.9 States that:

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Safe Sport - Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Neither the sponsor beneficiary, show grounds, show committee or show management or their respective officers will be liable for 1) injuries sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, sub contractors or employees; 2) any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed, stolen or injured in any manner – although every precaution will be undertaken to protect the property of the exhibitors; 3) Any loss or damage that may occur to any horse on the grounds. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management. By participating in the show in any way, to include spectator, exhibitor, rider, trainer, agent, or employee or agent of any of the above agree to hold Urban Equine Events, LLC, the Quail Run Horse Centre, Inc. and their officials, the beneficiary, the USEF and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the show, the beneficiary, or the USEF. It shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

RESPONSIBILITY

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and animals to stalls, buildings and any other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.



FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of END OF SUMMER (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR907.4.

If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber and competing only in classes that are exempt from membership requirements, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless and until USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my Fan account. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. I acknowledge that I may opt out at any time by going to My USEF Dashboard or calling (859) 810-8733.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles are provided for disposal of hypodermic needles in aisle of barns. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 Fine. Please do not mix with manure waste or trash cans.

PARKING

In designated areas only, and **NO PARKING IN FIRE LANES**. Show management reserves the right to ask anyone to move their cars, trucks, trailers, vans, or any other vehicles etc. at any time. **NO PARKING IN STABLING AREA**

CONCESSIONS

Limited Concessions available on site.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current **USEF/USHJA** membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will need to purchase a \$45/USEF & \$30/USHJA (or \$75 if both USEF and USHJA) non refundable, show pass fee (non member fee). USEF Show Pass Fees must be purchased online and directly from the USEF. All Junior and Pony Hunters must possess and present to the horse show office, a current USEF measurement card. All Amateur Owners and Adult Amateurs must present their Amateur cards at the time of number pick up. To speed processing, **please** enclose photocopies of these cards with entries.

HORSE REGISTRATION NUMBERS

See USEF Rules GR 1101,1102. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from the USHJA. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the Horse Registration application form. HORSES MUST STILL BE RECORDED WITH THE USEF (EITHER LIFETIME OR ANNUAL) TO RECEIVE NATIONAL OR ZONE POINTS.

MICRO CHIPPING

Beginning in the 2019 competition year, all horses competing in USEF-licensed and/or USHJA-sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper, and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed will be required to be microchipped. USEF has provided education materials to competitors to learn more about microchipping and the rules.

At competitions, exhibitors may ask to turn in a USEF Microchip Reporting Form. Please let them know they can report the microchip number directly to USEF three ways:

1. Online by signing into their My USEF My Way account and updating the horse's record.
2. Faxing to (859) 231-6662 or emailing to horseservices@usef.org the Microchip Reporting Form, which may be used to report chip numbers for multiple horses.
3. Completing the microchip field on a USEF Horse Recording/ ID Application.

The completion and submission of this form is the sole responsibility of the competitor. Competitions are not responsible for assisting with the forms. Our office will check the form to ensure accuracy and completeness once received.

SCHOOLING

SCHEDULE: Management will create and announce a schooling schedule for each day based upon weather and footing conditions. Whenever mounted, all riders **MUST** wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. **ALL HORSES & ALL NON-STAFF PEOPLE MUST LEAVE ANY AREA** upon entrance of **tractor** for ring preparation, and no additional schooling in rings **after tractor work** preparation for show, nor longeing anywhere other than designated areas, after tractor work.

Schooling Hours: On day prior to show: **11:00 AM – 6:00 PM**. On shows days rings **MAY possibly** be open for schooling over jumps for 1 hour at the conclusion of the day's classes and/or course build in that ring. Regardless of schooling status, All Arenas will close (*if open*) 45 minutes prior to show time in the mornings. No Schooling in arenas on final show day.

TRAINER STALL SPECIAL

BRING 6 HORSES AND THE 7TH STALL IS FREE!

LONGEING

Longeing is permitted in designated areas and **NOT** on grass. **PLEASE**, NO longeing in any areas **DURING** or **AFTER** tractor ring work, unless in **specified** and/or **designated** area.

STABLING

Stalls are temporary inside permanent barns. All stalls have fronts. First bedding is not included in the stabling fee. **No refunds** unless stalls are canceled by closing date of each horse show. Barns will be open two days preceding the show at 1:30 PM. Barns will close the day after the show at 10:00 AM. **No horse or pony may be stabled overnight in a trailer or van on the show grounds. Be sure to add stabling information to entry form.**

Stabling is located in an outdoor, covered barn. The stalls are 10' x 10' and have vinyl walls constructed with metal frame. The base is limestone. These are temporary stalls.

FEED & BEDDING

Feed and bedding is available through the horse show office. For deliveries prior to arrival,, please call (402) 689-0669. Exhibitors who bring their own shavings will be charged a \$25.00/horse disposal fee.

GOLF CARTS AND OTHER MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Golf carts may be available with reservation. **The supply is limited. Please reserve one early on the Stabling Reservation Form found on our website.** USEF Rule GR1301.7. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF Rule GR1301.8. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

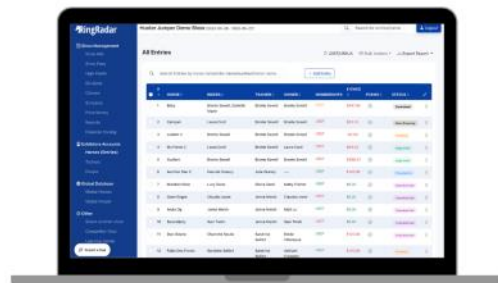

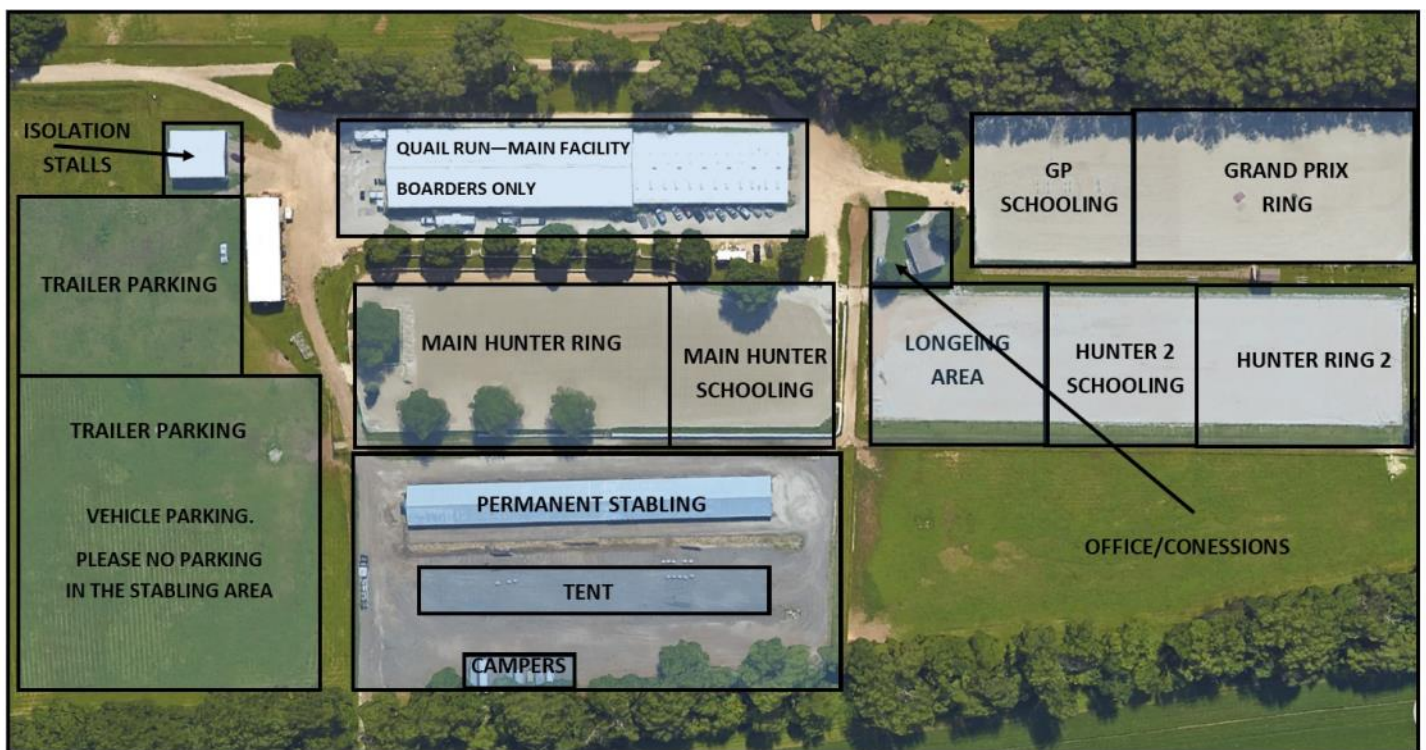

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW

- ◆ Enter all classes by **5:00 PM** the day before the classes are held. This applies to online (horseshowsonline.com) and in office submission.
- ◆ **Add Fees** of \$5 per add sheet will be charged if adds are made on the day of the class or after 5pm the day before.
- ◆ **Scratches** on the day of the class will not be charged if the scratch sheet is filled out and given to the Office and the gate. A \$5 fee will be added if scratch sheet is not filled out.
- ◆ Any entry riding in a class, in which they did not enter properly, will be charged \$15 rode without entering in addition to the class fee.



WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and END OF SUMMER AT QUAIL RUN ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INHERENT RISKS: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with equine activities, including but not limited to horseback riding and equestrian sport, are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

We at Mid States Horse Shows wish everyone and their horses a safe and fun show season! In that light, we strongly recommend the following bio-security policies to help promote the health and safety of our valued equine partners.

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection & Coggins

All horses arriving for the UEE competitions held at the Quail Run Horse Centre, Inc. in Elkhorn, NE must possess and present certificates of veterinary inspection (commonly known as health certificates) issued within 30 days prior to arrival, as well as a current and valid Negative Coggins to the show office where it will be kept on file. These must be received before any competition numbers will be issued.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Vaccination Records

All horses arriving for the Urban Equine Events, LLC competitions that are held at the Quail Run Horse Centre, Inc. in Elkhorn, NE possess and present proof of vaccination in the following capacity:

Within **6 months** of entry. (**USEF GR845**):

1. Equine Influenza Virus
2. Equine Herpes Virus (EHV 1 & 4, aka *Rhinopneumonitis*)

Proof of vaccination for all horses is **strongly recommended** in the following capacity:

Within **1 year** of entry:

1. Eastern and Western Equine Encephalomyelitis
2. Tetanus
3. West Nile
4. Rabies

Due to current industry concerns it is suggested and respectfully requested that the following are current within **3 months** of entry:

It is suggested and respectfully requested that Proof of Vaccination and/or the **Equine Event Vaccination Card** be presented to the office, where a copy will be kept on file.

An **Equine Event Health Declaration Form** is also provided for your convenience. This information is valuable to horse show management companies for risk management in the event of a bio-security situation. Please take advantage of this useful tool for all your competitions throughout the year.

ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/ jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM / SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. **See USEF GR 801.**

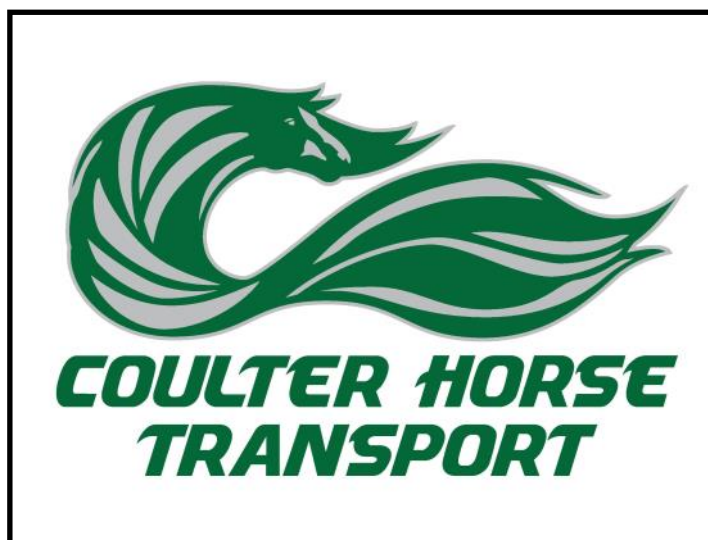

2026 USHJA ZONE 6 HANDY HUNTER CHALLENGE

The USHJA Zone 6 Committee has created this program to provide our membership with an opportunity to experience the excitement of Hunter Derbies and Hunter Classics. The USHJA Zone 6 Handy Hunter Challenge judging will place emphasis on a horse or pony that is maneuverable, obedient, and looks like they would be a pleasant ride in the show ring or hunt field. Most of all, while they may carry pace and show brilliance, they should look like they are a suitable mount for the non-professional rider. Additional judging specifications are provided in Section IV below.

Different elements that may be part of a handy course include, but are not limited to, fences ridden at a hand gallop, a roll back and a trot fence. Elements may also include objects found in a hunt field such as, opening and closing a gate, walking through a set pattern, halt and back or turn. No bridges or water elements to be included. This class may not be appropriate for a green horse or novice rider.

The USHJA Zone 6 Committee shall provide \$1,500 (\$500 each section) of prize money to the Handy Hunter Challenges which will be held at a limited number of competitions within the Zone. Each of the Challenges will consist of one at 2'6" (The Low Children's/Adult Amateur), one at 2'9" (The Children's/Adult Amateur), and one at 3'0" (The Children's/Adult Amateur). Participants in this class will accrue double points for the USHJA Zone Horse of the Year and USEF National Horse of the Year standings.

I. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS - LOW CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR

- A. All challenges will be held as a one round Handy Hunter class.
- B. A minimum of ten (10) fences shall be set at 2'6" in height with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- C. There will be three (3) high option fences set at 2'9" in height with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- D. Formal attire is requested, but not required.
- E. The class must be run in accordance with HU112.6 and include a bending line, and a trot fence. The use of natural obstacles is encouraged, but not mandatory. - C. Host shows may request permission from the Zone 6 Committee to allow eligible members from contiguous zones to participate in the Zone 6 Handy Hunter Challenge. If permission is granted, it must be stated in the prize list. Members of contiguous zones will be charged a \$50 minimum entry fee. This fee is to be remitted to the USHJA Zone 6 Committee.

IX. RESTRICTIONS

- A. Riders may only compete on one horse or pony per Handy Hunter Challenge.
- B. Riders entered in the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter into any other class held at the same competition where the height of fences exceeds 3'6", EXCEPT High Children's/Adult Jumper where the height of fences may not exceed 1.15m.
- C. Professionals are not eligible to compete in the Handy Hunter Challenge.
- D. Horses ridden in the Handy Hunter Challenge may compete with a different rider in other classes that exceed 3'0" in height at the same competition.
- E. Riders entered in any height of the Handy Hunter Challenge may not cross enter, at the same show, into a USHJA National Hunter Derby.
- F. Riders may not cross enter, at the same show, between the Low Children's/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge, the Children's/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge, and the 3' Children's/Adult Amateur Handy Hunter Challenge.
- G. If there are fewer than 3 entries in the Low Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge, it may be combined with the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge. If there are fewer than 3

entries in the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge it may be combined with the 3' Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge.

X. JUDGING (FOR EACH SECTION)

- A. The Handy Hunter Challenge may be officiated by one (1) or two (2) USEF "R" Hunter licensed judge(s). The judge must be in good standing with the USEF and USHJA.
- B. The Handy Hunter Challenges shall be judged and numerically scored on quality, movement, jumping style, handiness, manners and way of going. Pace and brilliance are to be rewarded, but judges should remember these horses should also exhibit suitability for the level of their rider. Each horse-and-rider combination will receive a numerical base score. In addition, they will receive one point for every high option jumped without a knock down; and a Handy Bonus Score consisting of zero (0) to ten (10) points for the handiness of the round. The three scores and the total score must be announced separately.
- C. The judging panel may not award the same base score to any two competitors in the class unless a competitor's score is below the cut-off score.
- D. All ties will be broken by the base score of the judging panel, before adding height and/or handy bonus points.
- E. See GR 1304 for Judging restrictions
- F. In all sport or education related matters, where there are either discrepancies or deficiencies in the specifications, procedures or any unforeseen circumstances related to a USHJA property, the President and Executive Director will consult with the Task Force/Committee Chair (if applicable), the Officers of the USHJA and USHJA legal counsel (if applicable) before making any final decisions.

XI. ENTRY FEES/ PRIZE MONEY/AWARDS (FOR EACH SECTION)

- A. There is no entry fee to compete in the Handy Hunter Challenge.
- B. Host shows may request permission from the Zone 6 Committee to allow eligible members from contiguous zones to participate in the Zone 6 Handy Hunter Challenge. If permission is granted, it must be stated in the prize list. Members of contiguous zones will be charged a \$50 minimum entry fee. This fee is to be remitted to the USHJA Zone 6 Committee.
- C. The Zone 6 Committee will provide each host competition approved by USHJA to conduct the classes, \$200 in addition to the \$1,500 prize money (\$500 each section) as recompense for holding the challenges.
The minimum prize money for each section shall be \$500. If the host competition wishes to add to the prize money, it may increase the prize money at their expense, not to exceed a total of \$1,500 in prize money for each section of the Handy Hunter Challenge. USHJA is not responsible for reimbursing a host competition for additional prize money.
- D. The Prize Money shall be distributed as follows: \$150, \$110, \$75, \$50, \$35, \$30, \$25, \$25 (30%, 22%, 15%, 10%, 7%, 6%, 5%, 5%).
- E. The USHJA Zone 6 Committee shall provide a first place prize and ribbons for places 1-10. The requirements of the final awards ceremony and victory gallop are at the discretion of host show management.
- F. Upon receipt of the complete results, including the prize money payouts, USHJA will reimburse the host competition for the amount of prize money actually paid in each section of the Zone 6 Handy Hunter Challenge, up to a maximum of \$500.00 and the \$200.00 host allocation.
- G. If there are fewer than 3 entries in the Low Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge, it may be combined with the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge. If there are fewer than 3 entries in the Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge it may be combined with the 3' Children's/Adult Amateur Challenge. The prize money for a single combined section will be \$800.00 plus the

\$200 host allocation.

Dear exhibitors,

Urban Equine Events, LLC is excited to be inviting you to join us for our 2026 season. Each year up to this point has been an exciting adventure in good competition, good friends, growing our businesses, and growing our sport. We hope that you join us in 2026 to continue the adventure!

I wanted to speak more in depth about the comment of “growing our sport” mentioned above. As part of the UEE mission statement, we have the goal of growing equestrian sport in the Midwest both for exhibitors and for spectators. Part of this goal is simply striving to produce high quality events for the existing exhibitors in our region. We believe that good competition in a fun and friendly environment promotes better horses, better riding, and better horsemanship. Another part of that goal is to produce events that are not just for the existing exhibitors, but events that everyone can enjoy. In an effort to highlight this part of our goal, MSHS will continue the use of the following concepts at our shows:

1. **The USHJA Outreach Program.**
2. **An Invitation for Schooling at our shows during schooling day.**

So, let me elaborate.

1. The **USHJA Outreach Program** is designed to help bridge the gap that exists between USEF rated shows, and non-rated events. Outreach shows offer several classes that range up to 3' in height in hunters, and equitation, and up to 1.20m in jumpers. Horses competing in Outreach classes DO NOT need to be recorded with the USHJA, and riders DO NOT need to be members of the USEF or USHJA, with the following exceptions. A rider MUST be a member of the USHJA at the Outreach level or above to compete in the Outreach Medal classes. A rider MUST be a member of the USHJA at the Outreach level or above to earn points, certificates of merit, and national recognition. **The USHJA Outreach membership is FREE!** Through the addition of Outreach shows at our competitions we hope to welcome those equine enthusiasts who typically do not attend rated events to come try us out and see the benefits of rated competitions (quality judging and course designing, quality show jumps, quality footing, equine drug and medication regulation, and the educational benefits offered through the USHJA and US Equestrian).
2. UEE invites equine enthusiasts to join us for **open schooling on “schooling day”** at our competitions. This invitation is geared towards young horses, but is open for all. We welcome riders of young horses, and all equestrians in general, to gain valuable mileage by exposing their horses and themselves to new environments. We recognize the value in establishing a pipeline in our sport, and we hope this is a good way to do it. Schooling during schooling day of our horse shows will always be free to those exhibitors entered in the horse show, however, we welcome those who don't want to compete to join us on our schooling days to gain that valuable mileage. The cost is \$45 per young horse, or \$85 for other horse/rider combinations.

We hope by offering these new opportunities at our events that we can help to accomplish our goal of promoting, growing, and strengthening equestrian sport in the Midwest. We would love to see you at our shows in 2026!

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

Entrants in Opportunity classes **only**, are not required to have USEF/USHJA membership, pay show pass fees or other Federation fees, and their mounts are not required to be registered/recorded with USHJA or USEF respectively, but are required to pay all other fees. If riders or horses enter **ANY** classes at the show, OTHER than Opportunity classes, they ARE required to have all necessary memberships and requirements, and pay all required Federation fees. Riders in Opportunity classes may not show in any USEF rated classes. Riders may cross enter into unrated classes for which eligible, if the height of fences does not exceed 2'6", but horses and riders must then have USEF/USHJA memberships or pay the show pass fees, and they must pay the drug, zone, and any other, required USHJA/USEF fees.

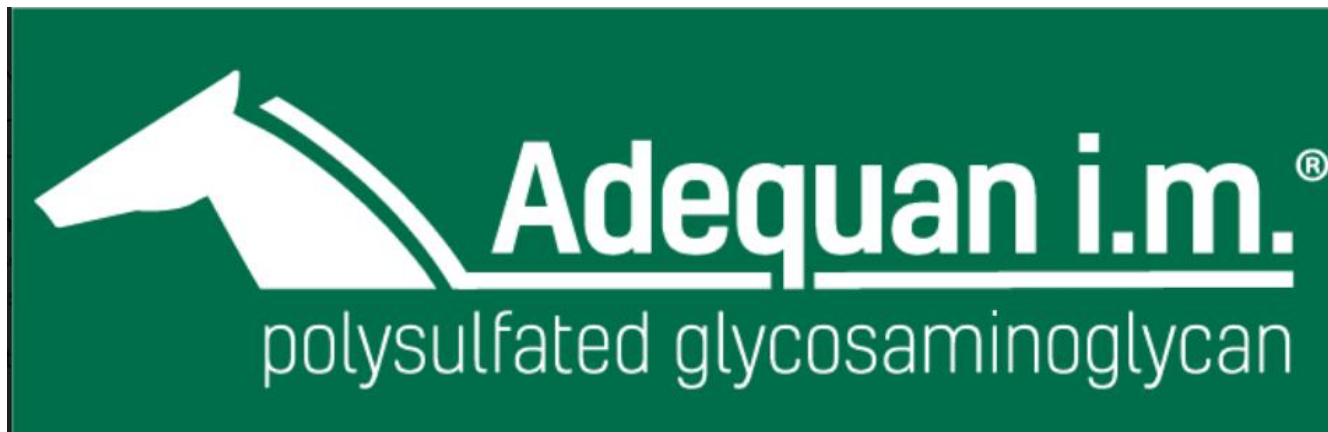
- ◆ If the rider has **EVER** shown in any USEF rated Hunter, Jumper or Hunt Seat Equitation class (Zone pointed or regular) they are ineligible to show in Opportunity classes. For questions, please check with the show secretary.
- ◆ Only the top ten INHJA approved shows for riders in each section, count toward INHJA year-end awards.
- ◆ Entries must show in at least three MHJA approved shows to be eligible for a MHJA year-end award.
- ◆ For the Opportunity classes, attire may consist of proper hunter/jumper show attire or the following: breeches with paddock boots and half chaps; jodhpurs with paddock boots; or breeches and boots. Jumpers may wear a polo shirt or other shirt with sleeves and a collar. Hunter/Equitation riders may wear a shirt with tie or a show shirt with a choker. Depending on the weather, they may wear a close fitting sweater, jacket or vest. All riders **must wear** SEI/ASTM approved head gear.
- ◆ Eligibility for year-end awards from the INHJA, requires an INHJA membership of "Outreach" level or above. Points will count from shows approved for such, by the INHJA.
- ◆ To be eligible for year-end award from the MHJA, you will need to join the MHJA as a competition member to be eligible for points judged on the rider (equitation classes). For points to count in the hunter and jumper classes, the OWNER of the horse must be a Competition member of the MHJA.

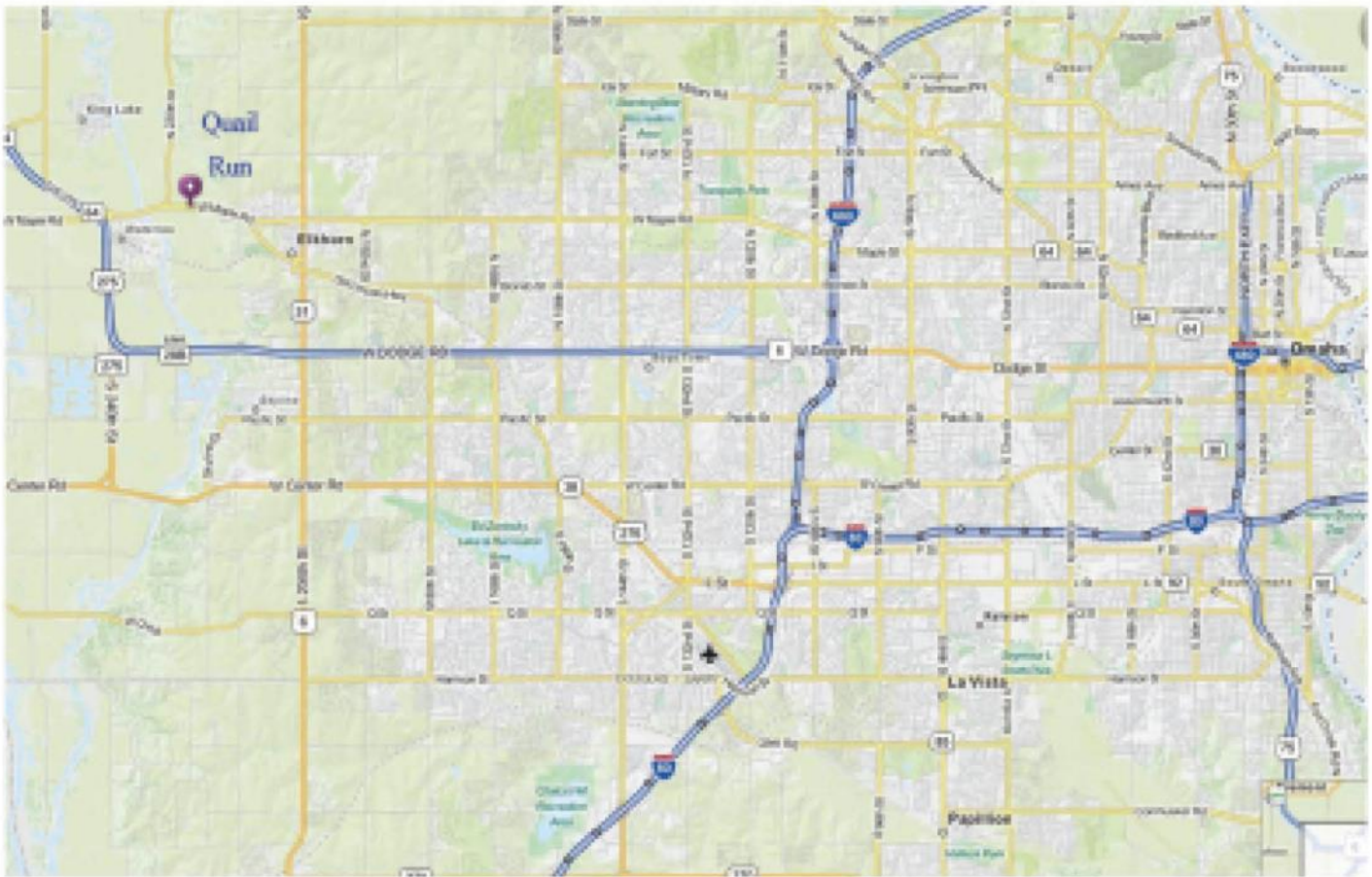

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS AND BEST PRACTICES

The following document outlines the protocols, guidelines, and best practices that will be in place during the Urban Equine Events show taking place in the 2024 calendar year at the Quail Run Horse Centre, Inc. in Elkhorn, NE. These protocols have been developed based on the guidelines set forth by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF), and the governments of Nebraska and Douglas County. All persons involved in the shows including, but not limited to, staff, officials, volunteers, vendors, exhibitors, trainers, grooms, parents/guardians, spectators, and other support staff must adhere to the protocols set forth in this document. In accordance with GR702.1 and GR914 the competition organizer and/or a USEF Steward/Technical Delegate has the authority to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect at the competition. Removal of a person from the competition grounds must, and will be, documented by the USEF Steward/Technical Delegate in their report to the USEF. **Trainers will be considered responsible for the conduct and adherence to the protocols for all individuals associated with their entries.**

We at UEE strongly recommend and respectfully request that anyone interested in attending these horse shows should self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms daily prior to entering the competition grounds. We encourage you not to attend if:

1. You exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms including, but not limited to, a fever of 100.4°F (38°C), cough, or shortness of breath.
2. Have tested positive or have been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time in the last 5 days.
3. Have tested positive outside of the past 5 days but are still symptomatic.

We at Urban Equine Events, LLC (UEE) strongly request that if you are not feeling well in any capacity that you stay home and not attend our events. It is everyone's responsibility to take the necessary steps to ensure the safety of yourself and others.

To maintain a quality showing experience we recommend that each exhibitor adhere to the following guidelines:

Prior to Attending the Urban Equine Events Shows

Planning:

In order to ensure a safe and quality product, UEE requests that anyone interested in attending provide as much information to management as possible. This includes:

- Stall Counts.
- Exhibitors in attendance. Names and emergency contacts are preferred.
- Horses in attendance. Names and recording numbers are preferred, but at the very least a count is requested.
- Classes and divisions that an exhibitor is interested in.
- Shavings, Hay, and Feed estimations.
- Golf Cart Rentals.
- Signed USEF Release and Waiver. Available for download on the UEE website. Digital submission to Patrice at purbs1@aol.com is preferred.
- Proof of Vaccinations, Negative Coggins, and other Health Documents are requested to be sent digitally to Patrice at purbs1@aol.com prior to arrival.
- Ensure that Safe Sport and Microchipping information is current.
- Arrival and Departure estimations.

The most efficient way to provide this information is via the Entry Blanks, Stabling Reservation Forms, Waivers, and other applicable documents that will be available on the UEE website: www.urbanequineevents.com, and then submitting said forms directly to Patrice Urban at purbs1@aol.com.

Entries:

- Electronic entries are the preferred method for entering these events. The entries may be submitted in the following formats:
 1. Online via the horse show program: www.horshowsonline.com. The show program will be set up so that trainers and individuals may enter the horse show digitally.
 2. Online via Equestrian Connect. Entries may be submitted electronically by visiting our online entry partner www.equestrianconnect.com.
 3. Digitally, by emailing the fillable PDF documents to Patrice Urban at purbs1@aol.com
 - a. Download the Entry Blanks from www.urbanequineevents.com
 - b. Fill out the fillable PDF form.
 - c. Save the completed PDF form.
 - d. Email the completed PDF form to Patrice Urban at purbs1@aol.com

4. Digitally, by filling out the entry hard copies and then submitting them electronically directly to Patrice Urban at purbs1@aol.com.
 - a. Download the Entry Blanks from www.urbanequineevents.com
 - b. Print the Entry Blanks
 - c. Fill the Entry Blanks out with all applicable information.
 - d. Scan the completed Entry Blanks, OR, take a clear and legible picture of all sides of the Entry Blanks.
 - e. Email the completed scanned or photographed entry blanks directly to Patrice at purbs1@aol.com
- Complete entries are requested and include all applicable information and class entries. If you cannot submit entries in the above-mentioned formats, please contact Patrice Urban directly at 402-689-0669 or purbs1@aol.com.

During the Competition and While on Grounds

General:

- UEE and USEF will require a signed USEF Waiver and Release of Liability document that includes providing emergency contact information to management.
- Although masks are not currently required, no exhibitor will be eliminated or otherwise penalized for wearing a mask or face covering while competing.
- UEE encourages all participants to take responsibility for providing your own personal protective equipment (PPE) and general supplies. This includes, but is not limited to water, food, cleaning products, and other supplies. General health recommendations discourage the communal use of grooming supplies, lead ropes, halters, and tack/equipment. The best practice is to use your own!

Horse Show Office:

- UEE and USEF strongly encourage all exhibitors to complete their entry forms, in their entirety, including having all required memberships in place, prior to entering the competition office.
- UEE encourages our exhibitors to perform office duties digitally whenever possible. See below for daily Adds/Scratches.
- Adds/Scratches: Adds and Scratches MUST be completed by 5:00pm the night before the next day's competition. It is preferred that adds/scratches are performed online via www.horsheshowsonline.com.

Emergency Plan

In the event that there is a medical emergency the following measures will followed:

Sport related injury: All normal protocols will be taken.

- On-site Medical personnel will attend to and assess the injured person.
- If the on-site medical personnel determines that medical transport is needed, then management will call for transport to the nearest medical facility.
- If the on-site medical personnel determines that medical transport is not needed, then management will follow the recommendations of the on-site medical personnel, and all other rules set forth from the USEF.

COVID-19/Illness related incident: If someone on grounds displays signs of illness or symptoms commonly associated with COVID-19 the following procedures will be taken.

- Consult with the on-site medical personnel.
- Determine whether or not immediate isolation is needed. In such a case the person will be moved to a separate indoor room on the grounds and will be tended to accordingly until further plan is determined.
- In consultation with the on-site medical personnel, if transportation to the nearest medical facility is required, then it will be arranged.
- Ultimately, the person in question will be encouraged to check in at the nearest medical facility for evaluation and potential testing.

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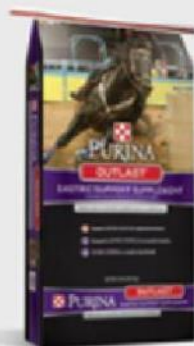
