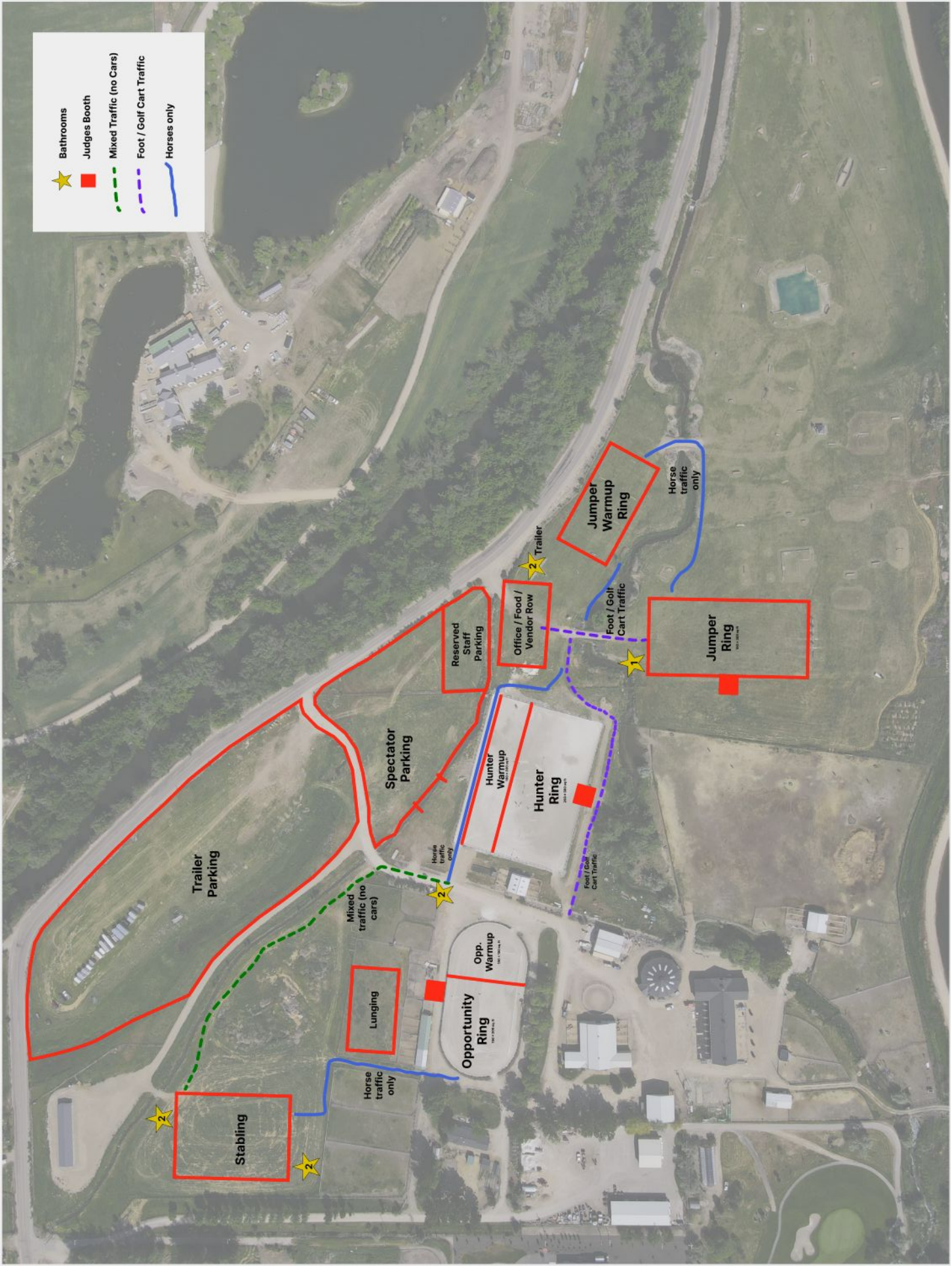
ESTHER SIMPLOT

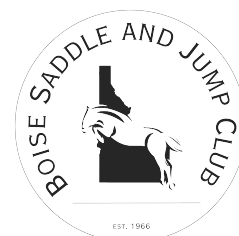

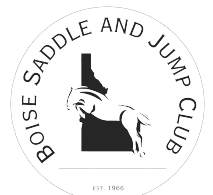

Table II Clear Round—Horses with clean rounds or equal faults remain equal. **Table II.1** Speed Class—Time First Round—Horses with clean rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Table II.2a Jump-Off at End—The jump-off for first place for rounds with equal faults if any begins after all competitors have completed their first round.

Table II.2b Jump-Off After Signal—After a clean first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course.

Table II.2a/b Jump-Off Option—Each competitor has the option of taking part in the jump-off at the end of their round as in 2(b), or after all competitors have completed the first round as in 2(a).

Table II.2c Power & Speed—After a clean first round, upon crossing the finish line, the competitor will commence the designated jump-off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course.

- Competition Days: office opens one hour before the first class, closes 30 minutes after the last class.
- Non-Competition Days: 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM.

ENTRIES

- Closing date for the Treasure Valley Classic Hunter Jumper Show: September 14th. Late entries: \$25 fee.
- Submit entries through RingRadar.com.
- Numbers will not be issued without a signed open check and/or credit card on file with the Horse Show Secretary.
- Entry form must include: \$125 BSJC Show Grounds Fee; horse name and rider(s) name; all mandatory signatures, including legal guardian for a minor exhibitor.

ADDED CLASS POLICY

- All add/drops must be made by the exhibitor or trainer on RingRadar.com prior to 6 PM on the eve of show day to avoid penalty.
- \$10 charge per class for Day-of-Adds; adding the day prior is free. Day-of-Adds depend on availability and management approval, and are not guaranteed.
- Featured Classes: horses entering the same day may be required to go first, paying the entry fee plus a \$10 post-entry fee.

CAVEAT DUE TO UNCERTAINTY

- All Hunter Classics/Derbies and Jumper Classes with prize money require 3 entries to fill and complete, or classes may be combined or cancelled.

EQUINE HEALTH & WELFARE

- Any horse with a fever of unknown or suspicious origin must be reported to Horse Show Management and the Show Veterinarian.
- Isolation stalls will be available on the grounds or at a local veterinary practice if needed.
- Please review equine hygiene practices and convey their importance to your equine caretakers.

CHECK OUT

- Bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show are assessed a \$25 fee.
- Mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours — check your bills carefully.
- A 4% convenience fee applies to all credit card bills.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS & PRIZE MONEY

- Ribbons are awarded through eighth place in all classes, unless otherwise noted.
- Prize money is awarded only to the recipient of record on the entry blank; deducted from entry fees at the event's conclusion, checks mailed within 30 days. Confirm entry form info is correct (USEF GR1210.6).
- Hunter & Jumper prize money split: 1st–30%, 2nd–25%, 3rd–20%, 4th–15%, 5th–10%.

CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION TITLES

- Awarded for the sections indicated, provided at least three horses are shown in every class in the division.
- When two or more divisions are combined, only one Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded. All over-fence classes count full points toward that Championship.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR — USEF GR801.2

- Compulsory for all mounted persons anywhere on the grounds of Federation-licensed hunter/jumper competitions: properly fastened headgear meeting or exceeding ASTM/SEI standards, carrying the SEI tag, harness secured.

FORMAL ATTIRE / EQUITATION ATTIRE

- Hunter: scarlet, black, or dark blue coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, buff, or canary breeches; hunt cap, derby, or hunting silk hat.
- Equitation: black, dark blue, dark green, or dark gray coat; white shirt with white stock, tie, or choker; white, beige, or canary breeches.
- Protective headgear required per USEF rules for both — no exceptions.

ACCIDENTS — USEF GR1316.2

- A competitor apparently unconscious or concussed after a fall/accident is precluded from competing until evaluated by qualified medical personnel (GR1211.5).
- A competitor who refuses evaluation is disqualified from the competition.

HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE & MANAGEMENT

- The Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions arising out of, or incident to, the show — without claims for damages or recourse.
- Questions not covered in these Rules will be decided by Management; its decision is final.
- Management may limit entries; refuse, conditionally accept, or cancel entries; disqualify riders/exhibitors; prohibit exhibition of entries; and cancel award prizes — without claim for damages.
- Management may change any course, add a jump-off, cancel or combine unfilled classes, reschedule classes after due notice, change rings or rotate judges, and change jumper specifications as warranted.
- Every horse is under the control of Management, which is not responsible for loss or damage. It is a condition of entry that each exhibitor holds the show, its officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsors, and facilities blameless for loss or accident to horse(s), employees, or equipment from sickness, fire, or other cause.

RELEASE, WAIVER & INDEMNIFICATION — USEF GR908

- I AGREE that the “Federation” and “Competition” include all officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and affiliated organizations.
- I AGREE I choose to participate voluntarily with my horse, as rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor.
- I acknowledge horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury — including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”).
- I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and Competition from all claims for Harm to me or my horse, and Harm caused by me or my horse to others — even from their negligence.
- I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or Competition.
- I AGREE to indemnify (pay losses, damages, or costs of) the Federation and Competition and hold them harmless for claims for Harm to me or my horse, and claims by others for Harm I or my horse cause.
- I have read the Rules on protective equipment (GR801, and EV114 if applicable); I am entitled to wear it without penalty, though no equipment guards against all injuries.
- As parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child’s participation and assume all obligations of this Release on the child’s behalf, and represent I have the requisite training and ability to safely compete.
- I AGREE medical personnel may share injury/treatment information with the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
- BY SIGNING, I AGREE to be bound by all Federation Rules and all terms of this entry blank and Prize List; an electronic signature has the same effect as a signature by hand.

SCHOOLING & TICKETED WARM-UP

- Flatting open 6:30–7:30 AM Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- Ticketed warm-up not offered in the Hunter or Opportunity Rings — those use the Warm-Up/Low Classes already offered at \$25. One ticketed round per horse per day permitted in the Jumper Ring.
- Purchase at the office; good for one round; non-refundable; requires show attire. Not permitted after your first division round or during monetary prized rounds. Fee: \$25.

DOGS — USEF GR1301.6

- Dogs must be leashed or restrained, not loose on the grounds; may not be led on a leash while mounted.
- Owners are solely responsible for damages, claims, losses, or actions from their dogs’ behavior. Non-compliance: Yellow warning card, possible penalty under Chapters 6–7.
- Loose dogs in the show ring area will be impounded; owner charged \$100, donated to the Humane Society.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES — USEF GR1301.7

- Minors without a valid driver’s license may not operate motorized vehicles (golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, farm utility vehicles) on the grounds; minors with a valid temporary license may if accompanied by a licensed adult.
- The parent/guardian who signs the entry blank is solely responsible for damages from a violation. Violations may bring sanctions and exclusion under Chapter 6.
- Wheelchairs and mobility devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt.

PARKING

- Available in all designated areas. No auto parking allowed in the barn area or aisles.

FEED & BEDDING / FARRIER

- No outside shavings/pellets — purchase through RingRadar. Exhibitors clean their own stalls and provide their own feed and buckets. Hay purchasable through RingRadar.com.
- Farrier on call — check www.boisesaddleandjumpclub.com for contact info.

STABLING

- 10' × 10' box stalls with full doors provided. Tying to trailers is prohibited; without a stall you may hold your horse or keep it in a trailer between classes (not overnight).
- Management encourages all horses to have a stall. Reservations through RingRadar.com.

ARENAS & FOOTING

- Grand Hunter Ring: 150' × 300', synthetic/sand. Grass Jumper Ring: 150' × 300', grass. Opportunity Ring: 150' × 250', synthetic/sand.

LUNGING

- Restricted to designated areas; not permitted in any ring areas at any time.
