Chapter One

GOD AND THE WORDTHE BEGINNING OF ALL THINGS

GOD created heaven, earth, and everything in them and man. The Bible says:

Genesis 1:1-2

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

The Bible also says:

John 1:1

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

In this book, I will explore a spiritual and philosophical perspective I have not encountered before.

This philosophical argument focuses on the concept of BEGINNINGS.

The dictionary defines beginning as "the origin or source of something, as well as the point at which something begins." Everything we see on Earth today, including war, wealth, trouble, political movements, family, and the Industrial Revolution, had a beginning. The essence of this philosophical argument is that A VOID MUST EXIST BEFORE ANYTHING CAN BEGIN. The beginning of anything reveals the existence of a void. A beginning is necessitated because something is missing. Beginnings are inspired not so much by what will be but by what is lacking, and if that is the case, we must look at the two powers present at the very beginning: GOD and THE WORD.

The beginning of everything as we know it is found in Genesis 1:1, when God created the heaven and the earth. No one can refute that, not scientifically nor spiritually.

Whenever we need to begin something new, we should run to God - the Beginner of things and His Word. Beginning anything requires a transcending and monumental capability to reveal what is missing.

God's creation revealed what had been missing. When He said, "Let there be light" (Genesis 1:3), it revealed the absence of light up until that point.

However, God is invisible; even though you were to use the latest and most sophisticated space shuttle to try to reach Him in heaven, you could never get there that way.

The furthest man has gone to is the moon. You can only locate God through His Word because "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God" (John 1:1). Because the Word was present in the beginning, He will tell us what transpired. He is the eyewitness who saw it all. Not only was the Word with God in the beginning, He (the Word) was or became God.

God turned the Word into Himself because that revealed His nature.

To find GOD and have a great beginning, you need the Word of God. Once you have the Word that has 'become' GOD, you can fill every void you encounter. John says, "All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made" (John 1:3). The Word begins or makes things on this earth. Whether it is a house, a family, cement, iron bars, etc., they are all words that take on a physical form and affect the world around them. The Word became flesh. Therefore, the Word can become anything.

John 1:14 (NKJV)

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

The Word is the force through which we begin anything. Without Him (the Word), we cannot begin anything.

"..without Him nothing was made that was made" (John 1:3). Without the Word, we cannot know God or begin anything because we do not know what to begin with.

Whoever desires to begin something revolutionary or military should turn to the Word because therein lies the power to begin things. That is what God did when creating the earth and all that is in it. He spoke the Word and things came into being.

Genesis 1:3 (NKJV)
Then GOD SAID, "Let there be light"; AND
THERE WAS LIGHT.

Genesis 1:9 (NKJV)

Then GOD SAID, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear"; AND IT WAS SO. Genesis 1:11 (NKJV)

Then GOD SAID, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; AND IT WAS SO.

Genesis 1:14-15 (NKJV)

14 Then GOD SAID, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; 15 and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth"; AND IT WAS SO.

Even things we look at and think they don't meet our standards, someone saw a void, went to the powers of creation (God and His Word), drew what they needed from them, and began something new.

Take children, for example. Their beginning was not with their earthly parents, as we think, but with Adam and, consequentially, with God.

Their destinies cannot be limited by their present circumstances but are enshrined in God, their genealogies, heritage, and current abilities.

If we minimize them based on what we see today, we may be surprised when they evolve into something magnificent tomorrow. We will look at them and ask ourselves where they got all those attributes, yet they were always in our children, the light, the truth, etc. They will turn darkness into light.

Philosophically, as Christians, we tend to isolate some things and call them worldly and want to dissociate from them, yet they all originated from God.

Hebrews 11:3 (KJV)

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Psalms 24:1 (NKJV)

The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, The world and those who dwell therein.

The world and its inhabitants are the Lord's. Presently, they may not be under His control because Adam gave up his authority over this world to Satan when he disobeyed God. Otherwise, there is no logical explanation for why God so loved the world and gave His only begotten Son to redeem it if the world was not originally His.

John 3:16 (NKJV)

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Chapter Two

ABUSE OF POWER AND REDEMPTION

We have to address the issue of abuse of power or office. Someone can use what's yours to build or do something you never intended. However, because your name is on it, you have to redeem it. When someone misuses government facilities and turns them into a military base to wage war against his own country, redemption becomes necessary, and someone must come to buy or get back those facilities. That is precisely what the devil is doing. Whatever he has, he stole. It was not his from the beginning. He stole it from Adam and is now using it to fight against God. The authority he has was given to man by God.

Genesis 1:28 (NKJV)

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Psalms 8:4-9 (NKJV)

4 What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?5 For You have made him a little lower than the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor.6 You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet,7 All sheep and oxen—Even the beasts of the field,8 The birds of the air, And the fish of the sea, That pass through the paths of the seas.9 O LORD, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the earth!

Satan is now misusing it to turn men into perdition. We must redeem whatever he stole to the rightful owner, Jehovah God.

Luke 4:5-7 (NKJV)

5 Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the devil said to Him, "All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. 7 Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours."

Even the creation story was mainly about redemption. The word "LET" implies resistance against a force that obscured God's original creation, as He had intended. Lucifer had something to do with the messy situation it was in. The creation story was a redemption story, returning things to their original state because the old occupants had messed them up.

Jeremiah 4:23-26 (NKJV)
23 I beheld the earth, and INDEED IT WAS
WITHOUT FORM, AND VOID; And THE
HEAVENS, THEY HAD NO LIGHT.

24 I beheld the mountains, and indeed they trembled, And all the hills moved back and forth. 25 I beheld, AND INDEED THERE WAS NO MAN, And all the birds of the heavens had fled. 26 I beheld, and indeed the fruitful land was a wilderness, And all its cities were broken down at the presence of the LORD, By His fierce anger.

The verses above confirm what Genesis 1:1-3 says: the earth was without form and void, and the heavens had no light, so God had to create light. They also confirm that man was not yet in existence. God gave Jeremiah a glimpse of what transpired at the creation of heaven and earth. See also 2 Peter 3:5-7, which talks about THE EARTH STANDING OUT OF THE WATER AND IN THE WATER, and that THE WORLD THAT EXISTED THEN PERISHED, BEING FLOODED WITH WATER. Scripture reveals that this was not the original state of the earth when God created it. It was a messed up state, so God had to speak to whatever obscured his creation to "LET THERE BE."

According to *Psalm 136:6*, the Bible says, "TO HIM WHO LAID OUT THE EARTH ABOVE THE WATERS, For His mercy endures forever." (Psalms 136:6). According to this verse, the earth's original state was that God laid it above the waters. How did it end up underwater when creation took place? A flood submerged it, and that's what Peter saw in 2 Peter 3: 5-7: the earth standing out of water and in water.

God had to redeem the earth from the mess caused by Lucifer and his angels by commanding all the forces obstructing to LET GO.

Genesis 1:9-10 (NKJV)

9 Then God said, "LET the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and LET the dry land appear"; and it was so. 10 And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas. And God saw that it was good.

THE DIVINE ABILITY TO BEGIN ALL THINGS

Chapter Three

THE WORD - OUR ACCESS TO DIVINE POWER

Whenever we see a void, we must return to the power that began everything: God and His Word. You cannot begin without HIM, whether a school, work, a family, or marriage.

Hebrews 12:2 (NKJV)
"Looking unto Jesus, the AUTHOR and FINISHER of our faith.."

The Word is the only thing that can reveal that power; God is power. He is so much more than what we have reduced Him to. Because of His relationship with us, He has reduced His glory to that of Father, just like the fathers we have in our families.

The problem is that we limit His capabilities in our minds because all earthly fathers are limited. The Almighty God is not limited. He is omniscient, omnipotent and omnipresent.

Genesis 17:1 (NKJV)

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.

Isaiah 66:1 (NKJV)

Thus says the LORD: "Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. Where is the house that you will build Me? And where is the place of My rest?

God is power; everything or everyone who comes to Him partakes of His divine nature and receives a total transformation. They become powerful, creative, wealthy, and much more. This means we must receive a revelation of the Word to access this power. Those who receive this revelation know that when they speak the Word, it will manifest.

Ecclesiastes 8:4 (NKJV)

Where the word of a king is, there is power; And who may say to him, "What are you doing?"

GOD brought creatures to Adam to name them; whatever he called them is what they are called to this day.

Genesis 2:19 (NKJV)

Out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to Adam to see what he would call them. And whatever Adam called each living creature, that was its name.

Adam was manifesting the power of the Word spoken from his mouth because he had partaken of the nature of his Father, God.

Still, in discussing the power of the Word, I received a revelation about the alphabet:

There are twenty-two (22) letters in the Hebrew Alphabet, twenty-six (26) in Chinese, twenty-four (24) in Greek, and twenty-nine (29) letters in the Egyptian alphabet.

The Spirit of God has revealed to me that the first civilization was Egyptian. They had to talk too much to make a difference, hence their 29-letter alphabet. Then, the Chinese and English each had 26 letters of the alphabet, and the wise Greeks had 24 letters. After that, the Hebrews had the fewest letters—22. This was because they had the power and presence of God, making them very wise.

Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV)

"The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

When you understand the power of the Word, your words may be few but very powerful. You do not have to speak many words to persuade anyone.

Job 22:28 (NASB)

"You will also decree a thing, and it will be established for you; And light will shine on your ways.

By associating with God in the beginning, the Word became God; He picked up His nature and character.

John 1:1 (NKJV)
In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Whatever you bring to God partakes His character and nature.

2 Peter 1:3-4 (KJV)

3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

The people of the Word [those who speak and do it] have extraordinary lives because the Word brings faith, and faith pleases GOD (*Hebrews 11:6*).

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)
So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

James 1:25 (NASB)

But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the law of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does.

The word becomes the element that produces faith, which pleases God. It produces God's kind of faith, as it did in the life of the Apostle Paul.

Galatians 2:20 (KJV)

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

I can't remain the same when the Word comes into my life. When I speak the Word, it will go and do what I have assigned it because God's Word will never return to Him void.

Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV)

So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

The Word works in me and transforms me, and I will live a good life. When the Word comes to me, I take in its character and become sharper than any double-edged sword.

I am translated by it, begin living an abundant life, filling wherever there is a void, fixing messes, etc. I cease operating with a natural mind but with the mind of Christ until it seems like God Himself is here.

1 Corinthians 2:16 (NKJV)

For "who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

The world brought into being by the Word has never aged or worn out. It is still vibrant and beaming with life, as it has been from the beginning. The beginning of all life is with the Word. Therefore, whatever the Word calls me, **I am NOW**.

THE WORD SAYS I AM BLESSED

Ephesians 1:3 (NKJV)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,

I AM A KING AND A PRIEST.

Revelation 5:10 (NKJV)

And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."

I AM HEALED.

1 Peter 2:24 (NKJV)

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

I SHALL NOT DIE

Psalms 118:17 (NKJV)
I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.

I AM PROTECTED

Isaiah 54:17 (NKJV)

No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment, you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness is from Me," Says the LORD.

I AM CHOSEN

1 Peter 2:9 (NKJV)

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

I AM RICH, POWERFUL, WISE, HONORABLE, STRONG, GLORIOUS AND BLESSED

Revelation 5:12 (NKJV)

Saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!"

I AM GUIDED

Isaiah 58:11 (NKJV)

The LORD will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

I AM NOT FORSAKEN

Psalms 37:25 (KJV)

I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

MY CHILDREN ARE SECURE

Isaiah 49:25 (NKJV)

But thus says the LORD: "Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible be delivered; for I will contend with him who contends with you, and I will save your children.

EVERYTHING THE WORD CALLS ME IS WHAT I AM.

When Jesus came, He said, "... Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these." (Matthew 6:28-29).

In other words, the Word was created before Solomon. He was just a recipient of a residue of the wisdom of God; from it, he made a kingdom for himself.

By returning to the Word, I will produce the things only God can. People should return to the Word to seek the answers to life, health, wealth, family, and finances. The Word is the only thing that can open their eyes to see the void around them. People are fearful because they lack the Word.

Chapter Four

THE WORD IS A SEED:

Luke 8:11 (NKJV)
11 "Now the parable is this: THE SEED IS THE WORD OF GOD.

Everything that comes to GOD carries His seed. For Sarah to give birth to Isaac, she had to receive God's seed, even when her natural body could no longer give birth to a child. That seed came in the form of a Word from God.

Genesis 18:10 (NKJV)

And He said, "I will certainly return to you according to the time of life, and behold, Sarah your wife shall have a son..."

Hebrews 11:11 (NKJV)

By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. For Mary to have Jesus, she had to carry GOD's seed in her womb.

Luke 1:31-33 (NKJV)

And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. 32 He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

The church must start carrying God's seed—His Word—because, for too long, it has carried the seed of the world. Consequently, we have been unable to produce HIS KIND, which is why there is so much misery, betrayal, conflict, and sickness. We don't even have solutions.

The global void in quality leadership is not because most of the leaders are witches but because they have been strongly influenced by religion; they carry the seeds of their denominations instead of the seed of God. This has produced the wrong ideology, tribalism, nepotism, a poverty mentality, chaos, and the list goes on. Failure has been the result.

The Bible says, "Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God" (Matthew 5:9), yet much of the world is in a state of chaos. Peace does not come from the UN, AU, or the EU; it comes from God. But because they [world leaders] lack that seed, they cannot manifest it.

Isaiah 9:6 (NKJV)

For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called, Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, PRINCE OF PEACE.

Faith is a seed, and so is joy, peace, prosperity, long life, etc. These all originate from the Word and are manifested in the lives of those who receive them.

Things either last long or break quickly because of their foundations. When the Word comes to us, it comes as a commandment, not an opinion; it's not something to be debated on. Blessed are they who hold onto it. His commandment makes the wise the simple (*Psalm 19:7*). Solomon, in all his greatness, received only one of the seven Spirits of God - Wisdom. God associates with spirits because He is a Spirit. He doesn't associate with bodies. That is why He had to send His Spirit to overshadow Mary so she could produce that which would overcome the world.

If you want to begin anything significant, get the Word. We must abandon religion and focus on the Word to build strong foundations. The word will align us with God's plan and will. Therefore, we need to receive, own, and stand on it so it becomes personalized.

That's why Elijah dared to say, "...As the LORD God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, except at my word." (1 Kings 17:1). That Word was originally God's word and yet God honored it, and the results were mind-boggling.

We must, therefore, align our thinking with the Word of God and avoid being double-minded. The Bible says, "...For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways." (James 1:7-8). We are the ones to shape situations, and not vice versa. We are not like chameleons; we don't adapt to the environment. The environment must depict our minds. Our thinking should influence the world around us and determine its direction. We are supposed to be the head and not the tail. We can see examples of this kind of influence from people such as Steve Jobs, the founder of the iPhone. It was an idea in his head that became a global phenomenon.

Job 38:6-7 (NKJV)

6 To what were its foundations fastened? Or who laid its cornerstone, 7 When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

When God created heaven and earth, the stars sang together. Heaven's divinity starts singing when it sees us do divine things. The angels sing and give God glory when we perform beyond heaven's expectations. By doing what causes heaven to sing, we bring God glory. As the children of God, we will surprise people.

We are surprised to see the fantastic developments in Dubai, a desert, and other cities like Singapore. Ordinary people have achieved these feats. How much more should we expect from ourselves as the children of God? Ever since GOD created the sun and moon, probably millions of years ago, they had never seen a person like Joshua who commanded the sun and moon to stand still until he destroyed God's enemies.

Joshua 10:12-13 (NKJV)

12 Then Joshua spoke to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel: "Sun, stand still over Gibeon; And Moon, in the Valley of Aijalon." 13 So the sun stood still, And the moon stopped, Till the people had revenge upon their enemies. Is this not written in the Book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and did not hasten to go down for about a whole day.

Before this, Every human had been subject to the sun and moon. Joshua was the first and to command them to be subject to him so he would obey God's command. Our societies, environment, and the earth are waiting for those kinds of people to command the gates to lock up and open up like we did in Karamoja, Uganda, a semi-desert and barren until we went there. Now, it produces food for thousands of people, stopping them from imminent death due to starvation.

In the parable of the Talents, Jesus teaches a valuable lesson about the three people who were given talents. Jesus reveals they could have achieved much better results if they had collaborated. No matter how talented a football player is, whether Ronaldo or Ronaldinho, they cannot win anything alone.

They must work together as a team to win. Developing talent is a team effort. The parable of the talents is not about who multiplied what he was given and who didn't. The one who didn't multiply his talent had a gift of saving; he decided it was better to save his master's money. Many people gamble money and end up in jail. The other two men could multiply what they had received.

The one who knew how to save would have helped the ones who knew how to multiply their talents, how to save so as to secure the future. By working with each other and joining forces, they could have created a winning team. There must be a collaboration of people of the like spirit. You are all talented; you are all farmers; you are all builders. Therefore you should work together to develop things because GOD does not give a talent for it to be wasted or buried.

Throughout the Bible, we see people who stood on the Word and their future was altered entirely for the better, like the woman who anointed Jesus for His burial (Matthew 26:12), Simon Peter, who followed the call of Jesus and became a might Apostle of the Lord from an ordinary fisherman (Mark 1:17), Joshua, who, because of his faith and obedience to God remained alive along with Caleb and inherited the Promised Land. At the same time, all their contemporaries died in the wilderness (Numbers 26:64-65), Abraham when God asked him to offer up Isaac as a burnt offering and obeyed (Genesis 22:15-18), Moses' whose body had been so consumed by GOD that even Satan and Michael the Archangel fought over it because Satan wanted to take and use it, and many other people.

Jude 1:9 (NKJV)

Yet Michael the archangel, in contending with the devil, when he disputed about the body of Moses, dared not bring against him a reviling accusation, but said, "The Lord rebuke you!"

We worship Jesus because we believe He died and rose again; praying to saints who didn't rise from the dead is very dangerous.

Obedience is better than sacrifice. If we want our lives transformed, we must obey God's Word without asking questions. Do whatever He says, even when it doesn't make sense, and do not mind people's opinions.
