Hillclimb Report: Rob reports no new updates. Ian reports that the radio test with KCC went well. Drew mentions that we need a formal contract for the equipment for any future rental.

CTTC: Howard reports that things are in good shape. We are waiting to see what happens with the Canadian border for some of the competitors and are working to get a uniformed officer for the spectator area. Lunches are sorted and we are close to what we need for workers.

Trailer Registration: Rob is talking to Drew about getting the trailer registration up to date. The trailer at least needs updated year stickers. Drew is recommending we register it in Maine in the future.
