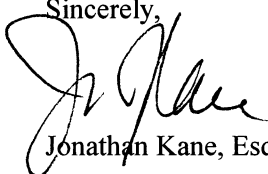
Thank you for your prompt and thorough reply to our letter of August 22. It appears, however, that you have misunderstood our claim. Our client does not claim that Broken Sea Audio is selling copyrighted works. CPI appreciates your company's desire to foster interest in the works of Robert E. Howard.

Our client's concern is that the logo you have been using to advertise these products infringes CPI's trademark rights in that it is substantially similar to the style of registered CONAN trademarks owned by CPI, and therefore created a likelihood of confusion in the marketplace as to the source of the products.

Our letter did not request that you cease sale of your audio books, merely that you cease the use of your logo that was confusingly similar to CPI's registered CONAN trademarks. Based upon a visit to your site today, it appears that you have in fact ceased using the CONAN logo in connection with your products.

CPI continues to assert that use of the CONAN trademark to identify your audio books constitutes unfair competition and falsely suggests that CPI has sponsored, authorized and/or is otherwise connected with you or your goods. We expect that you will continue to respect CPI's legal rights in its valuable CONAN franchise.
