Since 1970, the Pav YMCA has played a part in strengthening the Berwyn, Cicero, Forest View, Lyons, North Riverside, Riverside and Stickney communities. The Y is the leading nonprofit committed to strengthening community by connecting all people to their potential, purpose and each other. Working locally, we focus on empowering young people, improving health and well-being and inspiring action in and across communities.

- Over **3,283** members/participants were under 18
- Over **1,562** registrants in youth swim lessons
- More than **\$29,851** in financial assistance was awarded for school aged child care and camp programming
- Over **703** children involved in school age child care and camp programming
- Partnered with Cicero School District 99 to provide programming to students through an ISBE After School Programs Grant awarded to the school district totaling **\$71,753**
- Subsidized **\$29,306** in babysitting services

WHAT WE DO


The Y provides support that empowers people and communities. We nurture the potential of every youth and teen, help others improve health and well-being, and create opportunities to give back to the community.
