FUNCTION:


QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a proficient swimmer
- Must successfully complete a skill assessment consisting of a 200 yard swim (100 freestyle and 100 breaststroke), a timed swim with a 10 lb. weight, and a CPR scenario
- YMCA experience (preferred)

CERTIFICATIONS:

- Current American Red Cross Lifeguard/CPR/First Aid certification
- New Employee Orientation (must obtain within 90 days of employment)
- Department Specific Insurance Trainings (must obtain within 90 days of employment)
- American Red Cross O2 Administration Certification (preferred)

^{*}It is the responsibility of the employee to obtain and maintain all certifications required to perform this position, in accordance with Pav YMCA guidelines

- Refraining from distractions of any kind
- Keeping the pool deck clear of clutter
- Performing and recording swim tests
- Other duties assigned by the Interim Aquatics Director, Interim Aquatic Coordinator, Senior Programs Director and/or Executive Director
