Under the direction of the Aquatics Director, the swim instructor is responsible for teaching various levels of the YMCA Swim Lesson Program to all ages and abilities.

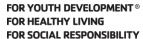

- American Red Cross Lifeguard certification
- American Red Cross O2 Administration certification (preferred)
- YMCA Swim Lesson Instructor Certification (preferred)
