Since 1970, the Pav YMCA has played a part in strengthening the Berwyn, Cicero, Forest View, Lyons, North Riverside, Riverside and Stickney communities. The Y is the leading nonprofit committed to strengthening community by connecting all people to their potential, purpose and each other. Working locally, we focus on empowering young people, improving health and well-being and inspiring action in and across communities.

# ANNUAL SUPPORT

## Sponsorship Opportunities

### MEMBERSHIP

At the Y, no child or family is turned away. We give children, adults, and families the opportunity to learn and grow while making communities healthier and stronger. We recognize that for communities to succeed, everyone must be given the opportunity to be healthy, confident, connected, and secure. The Pav YMCA uses financial gifts to help families in need participate in programs and utilize services that benefit their wellbeing, such as membership. The financial assistance we provide is funded 100% through donations given to our Annual Support Campaign. It is with the generous gifts of others we are able to keep the Y accessible to all. Last year, we subsidized over \$62,000 in membership fees alone.

### MILITARY VISITS

The Pav YMCA is visited by active duty military personnel every month. Use of the Pav YMCA is made available, free of charge, to anyone on active duty in the U.S. Armed Services. This is our way of supporting the health and well-being of our troops here at home. Thank you for your service! Annually, the Pav YMCA subsidizes over \$15,000 in military visits.

### BABYSITTING

We offer babysitting to all Members and Guests for their children ages 6 months to 7 years old. Members can utilize this benefit at no additional cost for up to 90 minutes per day. Annually, the Pav YMCA subsidizes nearly \$30,000 in babysitting services for our Members.

- > ONE WEEK OF BABYSITTING (5 DAYS) **\$25 for one child OR \$40 for two children**
- > ONE MONTH OF BABYSITTING (30 DAYS) **\$150 for one child OR \$240 for two children**

In fact, he was the composer of the National Kiwanis song. Throughout his career, he was also connected to the Chicago YMCA.



# (GIVE) BACK TO SCHOOL

## Donation Opportunities

(Annual school supply fundraiser in July)

The Pav YMCA raises funds to help alleviate the cost of back-to-school supplies for families in our community and ensure students have the tools for a successful school year. An average of 900 school supply kits are created for kids in grades K-8th that cost approximately \$15 each.

# END OF YEAR GIVING


