Before we dug in, we wrapped our heads around the current situation. We needed to understand what was working and what were the challenges.

OUR OWN "STATE OF THE FIRE".



THERE WERE ELEMENTS THAT WERE SEEN MORE AS CHALLENGES:

Chicago was a sports-rich city with 5 well-established pro franchises to compete with: the Blackhawks, Bulls, Bears, White Sox, and the Cubs.

Chicago was also home to a vast number of entertainment options beyond sport that were competing for the attention of potential fans – concerts, festivals, museums, the lake, and shopping, just to name a few.

The overall marketing budget was to be 700K for the 2014 campaign not a small amount of money but pale in comparison to the budgets of the City's larger franchises.

Bridgeview, the location of Toyota Park, was often viewed as "too far" and/or "unknown" to the average city dweller.

The perception of play on the field to the average Chicago soccer fan, was often, albeit unjustifiably, "sub-par".

BUT THERE WERE ALSO ELEMENTS THAT SEEMED TO BE WORKING IN OUR FAVOR:

Ticket prices were affordable.

There existed a large number of untapped, knowledgeable soccer fans in the City of Chicago.

The true quality of play was high in comparison to most top leagues worldwide.

Attendance to two games generally created a long term visitor to Toyota Park.

The Fire had an established and still growing core of rabid fans known as "Section 8".

A newly-formed Chicago Fire Rec League had kicked off and was showing early signs of success.

A new Chicago Fire Soccer Center was to be built within the Chicago city limits.

THIS LEAD US TO BELIEVE THAT WE NEEDED TO CREATE A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE IN ORDER TO DRAW MORE FANS TO TOYOTA PARK.

But, it wouldn't be enough to just be a unique sport experience. With all there was to pick from in the Chicago entertainment landscape, the Fire needed to create an experience that captured the imagination of Chicago sport fans AND beyond.

This new, unique experience needed to be wonderfully memorable: memorable enough so that people would chat about it with their friends...and therefore attract more friends to games.

What would be unique about the Fire experience?

We needed to establish our brand personality. The Fire's personality, it's DNA, is what would make it unique.

WE'RE AGAINST BORING MAINSTREAM, CORPORATE SPORT. WE'RE AGAINST THE OLD FASHIONED, NARROW-MINDED, PROVINCIAL SIDE OF CHICAGO.

Despite all the passion we bring to the five values, we puncture them all occasionally by bringing a dash of humor.



These personality traits are meant to be timeless. They are what makes the Chicago fire the CHICAGO FIRE. Want something to put up in your conference room walls? Try these.

WE DETERMINED THAT WE WOULD USE THESE TRAITS IN THREE DIFFERENT WAYS:

GENERATING ★ ASSESSING/EVOLVING ★ BRIEFING



USE THE PERSONALITY TRAITS TO GENERATE IDEAS.

Let's say you're designing an element of the Chicago Fire experience. It could be a poster. It could be a scarf. It could be the landing page of the website. It could even be the ceremony that takes place when the players come onto the pitch.

Ask yourself, "How can I make this experience be expressed through a gritty/human/indie/Chicago pride/global curious/ irreverent lens?" Ideate around each trait individually. It's unlikely that you will create an idea that is influenced by all six traits. But you may find that maximizing one or two leads to a powerful idea.

Note: not every experience touchpoint needs to reflect the same balance of traits. Some can be super-gritty, some can be purely irreverent, others can skew towards Chicago... but overall the fans will get a sense of all six traits being expressed. Consider this another way: a person doesn't express every facet of their personality through everything they do. But over time, as we see them do multiple things, a clearer picture of his/her personality emerges.

USE THE PERSONALITY TRAITS TO

ASSESS & EVOLVE IDEAS.

If an experience concept has been generated by someone else, you can use the personality traits as a vocabulary for assessment and for guiding evolution of the ideas.

Instead of seeing something and just feeling intuitively that it is "off", you can guide someone by referencing the traits. eg. "The poster does a good job of conveying the information, but we're trying to be gritty. So maybe make the font something more raw, like a stencil or stamp. Also we're trying to be indie. So don't include loads of hard-sell text on the poster: we want the fans to feel like they're discovering something."

With assessment, the traits shouldn't drive a check-list mentality: it isn't a question of ensuring that there's a rigid connection to the traits. Rather they should provide opportunities to make ideas better, more memorable, and more reflective of the Chicago Fire core essence.

USE THE PERSONALITY TRAITS TO BRIEF PARTNERS.

Finally, the traits can be used to brief creative partners, by revealing the dimensions that the club is looking to display in its experience.

This process is best done by showing the traits along with examples of designs that bring those traits to life: "When we say irreverent, we mean stuff like this poster with the chant lyrics on it. We don't want to just have jokes etc"

Armed with the personality traits, we were ready to begin designing elements of the Chicago Fire experience.

The gameday experience represents the core of the Chicago Fire brand. Focusing on making this experience memorable will result in our fans talking and tweeting about it. Word will spread that Chicago Fire games are worth checking out.

We want conversations that don't revolve solely around the end result of the game - we want people speaking in descriptors when asked about their experience at Toyota Park – the wild tailgate scene, the cool Fanbulance, an awe-inspiring burst of flames, or funny halftime entertainment.

The gameday experience is a journey consisting of key moments - from the Fire shuttle that takes us to the game, to the parking lot experience, purchasing food and merchandise, our interactions with staff, player introductions, goal celebrations, to even our exit of the stadium. It's important to remember that when we design these moments we need to apply the brand personality traits – this assures that the end results are memorable AND have the unique Chicago Fire personality that we're looking for. The cumulative effect of these experiences will be to make the gameday experience less corporate, more in line with the passions of the fans, and a better driver of word-of-mouth.





The March is about getting our Fire fans to Toyota Park seamlessly and, more importantly, with a consistent drumbeat of passion. From the Red Hell Ride buses leaving from spots around the city to the collection area in the parking lot to the procession into the stadium –



Bands are picked from the City of Chicago AND from around the country/world to perform on flat bed trucks in the parking lot before (and after) matches. The music genres can range from Mexican salsa to Polish polka to



Food Truck Court

Give people food variety in the parking lot. Much like the Bands on Trucks, the styles of food you bring in game to game will change (possibly depending on who you are playing) – BBQ, Mexican, cupcakes, bratwurst, Peruvian – you name it – the food truck guys will always drive to serve a captive audience.





The Chicago Flame

The Chicago Flame torch is used throughout the season as a signifier of major club events – the beginning of the season, at a supporters meeting, the beginning of a match, the end of the season. Shown in two different materials (wood and metal), the torch is collection of raw Chicago-based materials bound together with braided rope or leather.

Remember:

Making the torch is only ONE PART of the experience. Think about the person chosen to walk it in, the song that is played during the march, the element that it is used to light, where it's kept between



Fire Upon Entry

Lit by the club's special guest fan, wooden fire pits ignite as the players run onto the pitch. This whole procedure the march in, the lighting of the pits, and the procession of the players are all shown up on the jumbotron.



Tour Stops Posters 2014/15/16

This is one of our favorites. Bands, big and small, commission illustrators and artists from all over to provide them with unique tour posters. We think the Fire needs to do the same. It could be a for a few matches or the whole home season but the artists design posters that are screen printed and sold to fans as they enter the stadium for that corresponding match. Following the match, mass printed posters go on sale in the pro shop or online. This is a wonderful collectible for frequently attending fans. The series, year after year, would make for a great display in places like the soccer center or



Seasoned Ticket

You're about to develop an ID card that will act as the Fire fan's new season ticket. This is a prime opportunity to produce something special for your most loyal fans. The designs you see incorporate a type of loyalty chevron in the form of the Chicago Flag Stars. The more years you stay a Season ticket holder, the more red stars you gain – a type of Seniority indicator.



Hands of Fire

Everyone has seen foam fingers at sporting events – we've been told it's even your top selling item in the pro shop. It's tired and old but people like the concept – so – create a Chicago Fire original – the Hands of Fire. Just imagine an entire section waving their "hot hands" in unison – pretty cool we think.

Goal Inferno

It's in your name – you're the Chicago FIRE. No more fireworks that go unnoticed. When you score a goal – fire erupts. When the players run onto the pitch – fire erupts. When you win the match – all hell breaks loose.



Create the Anthem

We all want an anthem that the Fire fans can own BUT the real challenge (and cool opportunity) is actually how we go about developing and ingraining the anthem in the hearts of our fans. Without this unique process, we believe, the anthem will go no further than person who wrote it. From the open public invitation to the fan online voting to the first public performance by the artist – the whole process is open, transparent, and completely Chicago.



Bubble Soccer Halftimes

Let's have a good laugh. Let's not be so serious. Bubble soccer – an actual real thing – would be a great addition to the Fire half time festivities. Fans picked to squeeze inside the bubble suits will find themselves bouncing and rolling all over the pitch – all to the fans in the stands great amusement.



The "human touch" of an experience goes a long way in establishing brand loyalty. Upon exiting Toyota Park, each fan is thanked by a Fire employee and handed a postagepaid feedback card with two simple, straight forward questions to fill out if they please – What could we do

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE WORKSHOP

IDEO and Chicago Fire core team members gathered for a half day workshop where they took a deeper look at existing concepts while also generating a number of new ideas. The end goal was to create gameplans for a number of high impact experience moments. These early gameplans began to define why fans and the organization would embrace the concept, steps that needed to be taken for implementation, and delegating responsibility to individuals within the organization.

Fireplace Focal Points

Again, we're the Chicago FIRE. We want fire wherever we can get it. From big open fireplaces throughout the restaurant to burners on the exterior, flames should always be present.

We think we've started to establish that the Firehouse isn't your typical bar/restaurant. That means you don't have typical entertainment options. you don't have video games. You have pinball machines. You don't have pool tables. You have FOOSBALL tables. The sound of the little white ball bouncing off spinning players should be heard throughout the space.

What followed was an implementation of the first part of "Phase 1" of the campaign - final artwork for three landmark billboards strategically located throughout the city.

This display reaches motorists traveling westbound on the Stevenson Expressway from Chicago's downtown business district enroute to western communities such as Hinsdale, Darien, and Burr Ridge. It is also close to the routes running away from Midway Airport to the near and far west suburbs.

THE SKINNY:

Of the three boards, it's the closest geographically to Toyota Park and, since it's in close proximity to the Harlem Ave exit, it will definitely be seen by Chicagoans heading to a game. It's on a fast moving highway and it's on the opposite side of westbound traffic.

LANGUAGE:

Since it's closer to the stadium, picking a chant that felt a little more "in the know" felt appropriate. It's also a very energetic, passionate phrase - exactly the feelings you want to instill in your fans as they approach the stadium. We've intentionally stripped the tagline and any mention of ticket prices - we believe they clutter the message especially in the case of a billboard that needs to be consumed at highway speeds.

IMAGERY:

Sean Johnson is a first teamer that we simply want to get more exposure - he is also the Fire player most likely to be selected for the World Cup roster. The logo colors have been simplified. The field of red is a consistent treatment across all boards.

GENERAL NOTES:

Home to Wrigley Field and the Chicago Cubs, Wrigleyville is a lively urban neighborhood inhabited by upper-middle to high-income residents. The congested Clark & Addison intersection is exposed to heavy vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Visible from the often congested elevated train line, this location is also a major feeder artery to Lake Shore Drive and the Kennedy Expressway.

THE SKINNY:

These are the people you want to target - they have jobs, they're young, they're knowledgeable. It's also an opportunity to express your unique message in close proximity to a veteran member of Chicago corporate sport - the Cubs.





LANGUAGE:

In sharp contrast to the world of blue (Chicago Cub land), we're making a statement with RED - even in the chant we chose. Note that the club logo and the URL are not being treated as a "lockup".

IMAGERY:

This photo of Mike Magee and Patrick Nyarko was chosen due to it's great job capturing the climax of a goal celebration notice the visible muscles in Magee's arms and both players mouths wide open. You can also see the MLS and the Fire logo you don't need to show a soccer ball.

GENERAL NOTES:

This expressway is the most highly traveled in Chicago. In fact, the Dan Ryan is one the most highly traveled in the United States. It presents a very high, long read, unobstructed view to inbound motorists just prior to entering downtown. Acting as the major North/South Chicago thoroughfare, it's the most direct route between Downtown and many suburban southern Cook County and Indiana communities.

THE SKINNY:

There are A LOT of eyes on this board BUT it's important to take into account that it is further away from the roadway than the others.





LANGUAGE:

Due to the farther distance from the roadway, we chose simple, straight forward language - your tagline. We also thought it was important to have language that included the word "soccer", allowing a driver/passenger traveling at high speeds to quickly decipher the purpose.

IMAGERY:

Again, we've chosen an emotional image of Mike Magee - muscles strained, number and logo visible, at the point of celebration.

THE THEME OF THE 2014 CAMPAIGN IS SIMPLE - THE CHICAGO FIRE EXPERIENCE IS UNIQUE AND COOL.

We recommend that you focus the majority of your efforts on making the "Chant" campaign work for you - at the stadium, OOH, and digitally. After reviewing the possibilities that this concept holds, we believe it's time to "dig in and focus". Rather than changing up messaging throughout the season, stick with this concept and drill it home with your fan base. This approach fits one of our most important personality traits - INDIE.

This season holds one key exception to this approach - the World Cup break. The Fire and the MLS will not be playing matches but soccer will be top of mind throughout the city. This is an oppportunity to provide an intriguing twist to our message. We recommend launching strategic "ethnic" and "experience" campaigns throughout neighborhoods and in the digital domain.
