
CEO

Ian Ayre is the Chief Executive of the Nashville MLS team where he has been tasked with building the entire club from the ground up following the award of an MLS franchise to Nashville in 2017. He is also in charge of the day-to-day operation of Nashville's United Soccer League (USL) Championship club, Nashville SC. Ian has an extensive level of career experience gained predominantly in the areas of Sport, Media & Technology.

Following 10 years of active military service in the British Royal Navy and professional experience in consumer electronics, Ian was involved in the takeover of Huddersfield Town Football Club. He served as Chairman & Chief Executive of the club and transformed the club's commercial revenues and completed the final stages of construction of the club's new stadium and the revitalization of the playing squad.

In 2007, Ian returned to the UK to take up a role at Liverpool Football Club, the club he had supported since his childhood. Over his 10 years at the club he was responsible for rebuilding the club at all levels. After initially securing a record-breaking sponsorship deal for the club, he went on to restructure the entire commercial, operational and football elements of the business as well as overseeing the successful £120m stadium expansion. He was directly responsible for all player transfer negotiations including contract negotiations on over 100 player contracts (acquisitions, sales, loans, extensions) including Phillipe Coutinho, Steven Gerrard, Luis Suarez, Roberto Firminho, Raheem Sterling, Sadio Mane and worked with 5 leading coaches (Rafael Benitez, Roy Hodgson, Kenny Dalglish, Brendan Rogers & Jurgen Klopp), During his time at Liverpool, Ian also served on the UEFA Competitions Committee as an elected member and in 2017 was voted Premier League Chief Executive of the year. He stepped down as Chief Executive of the club in February 2017.

lan is 55 years old. He lives with his partner Karen and daughter Jasmine (12). He has four grown-up children and three grandchildren. Born in Liverpool, England, he has been a soccer fan since his early years and followed Liverpool all over the world both as a fan and as an employee. A keen golfer and motorcycle enthusiast, he has lived and worked in UK, Germany, Hong Kong, Malaysia and China. Ian would describe himself as a creative person and enjoys building great teams that do amazing things and loves the excitement of challenging projects that create outstanding outcomes.







GARY SMITH

Head Coach

Gary Smith, 49, was named as head coach for Nashville's first professional soccer club on April 12, 2017. While this is Smith's first time coaching in the USL, he has managed clubs the MLS, NASL and English League One and Two. In 2010, he led the Colorado Rapids to its second MLS Cup championship appearance winning its first MLS Cup. Smith begins his 21st season coaching after a 12-year playing career. It will be his eighth season as a head coach.

The Harlow, England, native began his youth career in the Arsenal youth system. Smith's father continues to be the head video scout for the club. In 1983, Smith joined Fulham's youth academy and made his first appearance in the 1985-1986 season. After four years with the club, Smith signed with Colchester United in 1987 and played 12 matches with the club. Smith played professionaly for several clubs including Wycombe Wanderers, Enfield FC, Welling United and Barnet United. Injuries forced Smith to prematurely retire at the age of 29 but created a smooth transition into his coaching career after spending some time as a player-coach.

Smith's' first coaching stint was at Wimbledon but he was quickly qppointed to coach the youth team at Wycombe Wanders in 2004. Ahead of the 2005-06 campaign, Smith joined Watford serving as reserve team manager and U18 manager. The next season, he worked as a scout for the English Premier League side Arsenal.

Smith secured his first managerial job in November of 2008 for the MLS side Colorado Rapids after successfuly serving as the inerim head coach. During his three seasons with the Rapids, Smith secured the first major trophy in the club's history after winning the 2010 MLS Cup. After winning the MLS Cup, Smith served as manager of the club for one final season before he was named manager of the League One side Stevenage. While at Stevenage, he led the clup to the League One playoffs. His final coaching stint before coming to Nashville was from 2014-2016 with the Atlanta Silverbacks of the NASL.

Smith was named Head Coach of Nashville SC ahead of its 2018 inaguaral season. Smith led the first-year team to a successful first season, earning a playoff berth. In March 2019, the club announced that Smith would remain the club's head coach as it moves into MLS in 2020.

MIKE JACOBS

Technical Director

Mike Jacobs joined Nashville Soccer Club in October 2017 after serving as Sporting KC's assistant technical director from 2015 to 2017. During his time in the role. Sporting KC won the 2015 and 2017 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and made the MLS Cup Playoffs in each of his three seasons with the club. Previously, Jacobs served in a variety of leadership roles in soccer across the U.S. In 2015, he was named the president of the National Soccer Coaches Association of America, the world's largest soccer coaches' organization. At the age of 43, he became the organization's voungest president.

In 2014, Jacobs was named the executive vice president and technical director for the United Soccer League (USL). Mike began his coaching career at Iona College, and at age 24, was the youngest head coach in the NCAA. He served as Iona's head coach from 1996-99 was named the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 1997. From Iona. Jacobs made the move to Evansville University as the top assistant to head coach Fred Schmalz. His work at UE led to a job at Duke University from 2002-06.

As assistant coach for the Duke University men's soccer team, he was awarded the inaugural National Assistant Coach of the Year award in 2004 and was named one of College Soccer News' "Top Assistant Coaches in the Country" four consecutive years. In 2006, Jacobs became a head coach again, this time back with Evansville. He led UE for nine seasons. helping return the program to national prominence.

In June of 2015, Jacobs was hired by Sporting KC of Major League Soccer as Assistant Technical Director to Peter Vermes. Jacobs was instrumental in developing SKC's USL team. Swope Park Rangers, who advanced to the USL Cup in each of their first two seasons, including a run to the title game in their inaugural season in 2016.

Mike was hired as Technical Director and Vice President of soccer operations with Nashville SC of the USL Championship in October of 2017 to manage player personnel and transactions, scouting and recruitment, development of the youth academy and training facilities, and other team-related business.

In October of 2018, it was announced that Jacobs was hired as the General Manager when the club transitions to MLS in 2020. As GM of Nashville SC, Jacobs orchestrated the first two signings in MLS history, forwards Daniel Ríos and Cameron Lancaster. Ríos and Lancaster were the top two scorers in the USL Championship in 2018 scoring 20 and 26 goals, respectively.

BRETT JACOBS ASSISTANT COACH

Brett Jacobs, 49, joins Nashville SC as the club's second assistant head coach. Jacobs, who was an assistant under Gary Smith with MLS' Colorado Rapids, will again join Smith on the sidelines for Nashville SC this season. Jacobs, no relation to Technical Director Mike Jacobs, assisted Smith in the 2010 season when the pair won the MLS Cup. With 25+ years of U.S. and international coaching experience both at the professional and academy levels, Jacobs has been trusted as a national staff instructor for the US Soccer Federation, a position he has held since 2007.

After a professional playing career that spanned 11 years in the U.S. and England, Jacobs entered the coaching world as an assistant for the University of West Florida (NCAA Div. II) from 1995-1997 followed by stints as a state development coach with the Massachusetts Youth Soccer Association from 1998-2001, academy coach for Wimbledon FC (currently MK Dons) from 2002-2004, and the director of coaching for the Michigan State Soccer Association in 2005. In addition to his director of coaching position, Jacobs was named as first team coach and assistant head coach of the Michigan Bucks in USL League Two (previously PDL), helping lead the Bucks to a national championship in 2006 and a national finalist in 2007.

Initially named the director of coaching for the Rapids Academy in 2008, Jacobs was brought on as a full-time member of the club and promoted to Assistant Coach, winning the MLS Cup in 2010. After his stint in MLS with Colorado, Jacobs received his first head coaching opportunity at Clark College just outside of Portland, Ore. In 2016, Jacobs became the head coach of Portland Timbers U-23 of USL League Two. His most recent stop was as the head coach of Europa Point FC in Bigraltar, where he also worked as a technical consultant helping the club grow out of its infancy and helping talented young professionals prepare for much larger European leagues.

Jacobs, a native of Ohio, currently resides in Nashville with his wife, Jennifer, and his two sons, Finn and Jett.

Davis was a key contributor, making 101 clearances throughout the season and was accurate on 80% of his passes. Prior to joining Nashville SC, Davis played for Minnesota United FC in the NASL and eventually in MLS. In 2017, he played in six matches and started in five for Minnesota United in its inaugural season in MLS. He holds the club record across the NASL and MLS squads for matches played with 171. Davis was selected 32nd overall by Real Salt Lake in the 2010 MLS SuperDraft after finishing his collegiate career at the University of New Mexico.

Mensah started his career with Inter Allies in Ghana, where he scored two goals in 2016.




About Malcolm Stewart



The USL Championship is a professional men's soccer league in the United States and Canada that began play in 2011. The league is sanctioned as a Division II Professional League by the United States Soccer Federation.

USL Championship is the world's largest Division II professional soccer league, with teams in 23 states and a Canadian province for the 2019 season. In total, the USL reaches a population of more than 75 million people, fueling the growth of professional soccer across North America. The league has more than doubled in size since 2014, after five teams joined the league last season and seven more clubs joining for the 2019 season. Headquartered in Tampa, Fla., USL Championship provedes unparalleled club support with a growing team of more than 50 professionals across 17 departments, ranging from operations to marketing, communications and sponsorship.

USL Championship is divided into an Eastern Conference and Western Conference with 18 teams in each. With a 34-match regular season, each team will play each other twice in a home-and-away format. The 33-week season will kick off the weekend of March 8-10, 2019.

The top eight teams from each conference will advance to the 2019 USL Cup Playoffs with four weeks of postseason action determining a league champion. The fixed-seed format concludes with the USL Cup, which is held at the venue of the conference champion with the best regular-season record.








First Tennessee Park



First Tennessee Park is a 10,000-seat stadium in the Germantown neighborhood of Nashville that opened April 17, 2015. The stadium was originally built as the home of the Triple-A Nashville Sounds, replacing the Sounds' former home, Herschel Greer Stadium. The park was built on the site of the former minor league ballpark, Sulphur Dell, that was used from 1870 to 1963. Nashville SC began play at First Tennesee Park in its inaquaral 2018 season.

The stadium's design incorporates elements of Nashville's musical heritage. Its most distinctive feature is its guitar-shaped scoreboard, a successor to the original guitar scoreboard at Greer Stadium. The stadium's wide concourse wraps entirely around the stadium, providing views of the field from every location. The Nashville skyline can be seen from the stadium to the south.







Nashville Soccer Club will move to Major League Soccer (MLS) starting in the 2020 season.

Nashville became the league's 24th MLS franchice in December 2017 when Commissioner Don Garber announced that the group led by local businessman John Ingram had won a bid. In September 2018, the Nashville Metro Council gave final approval for a 27,500-seat soccer-specific stadium at the Nashville Fairgrounds that will become the home for Nashville SC in 2021.

Nashville SC will play its inaugural MLS season in 2020 at Nissan Stadium before moving to the new Fairgrounds stadium in 2021. On February 20, 2019, Nashville SC unveiled its MLS branding and identity featuring a brand-new "Acoustic Gold" and "Electric Blue" crest.

"We wanted a name and an identity that was authentic in the sport. It says exactly who we represent and who we are, Nashville Soccer Club," siad Nashville MLS CEO Ian Ayre. "Our announcement is another step forward, and we have many others to take, but it is important to start that with a clear identity of who we are. Gold is our primary clyb color, and we need to own that color in the sport. As we grow as a team we want to be recognizable by our color, our name and our values as a club. Throughout 2019, we will be doing our best to bring everyone along on our journey as we #BandTogether Nashville and soccer on our march to MLS."
