### About Phoenix Rising Soccer Complex

The Phoenix Rising Soccer Complex sits on Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community land near the intersection of the 202 and McCormick Dr in Scottsdale, Arizona. Built in just 53 days, the stadium has been the only home for the re-branded Phoenix Rising Football Club.

The first-of-its-kind soccer-specific stadium in Phoenix made its debut on March 25 in the club's 2017 season opener against Toronto FC II (a 1-0 loss). The stadium has an official total capacity of 6,200 but with the addition of the stadium's field seats, luxury suites and standing-room only areas, crowds can be as large as 7,000.

This season the club has made several additions to the stadium including bar areas at two corners of the stadium, a bigger merchandise tent and bigger snack shacks and a large tented area for fans to enjoy their concessions away from the sun.

### PRFC and Rio Grande Valley FC

### OTHER GAME NOTES

#### League Leaders

Phoenix Rising FC has been one of the most dangerous teams in attack in the USL this season. Its 53 goals scored are tied for the second-most in the league and the club has attempted the second-most shots in the USL, 396. The team's plus-25 goal difference is also best in the Western Conference, and second-best in the USL.

#### Going Streaking

PRFC is on a three-game winning streak, tied for the longest winning streak of the season (5.4.18-5.12.18). With a win, PRFC can extend their winning streak to four games, a feat they haven't reached since September 2017 (9.9.17-9.27.17), when the club won five straight.

#### Keeping it Clean

Zach Lubin and Carl Woszczyński have combined for three straight clean sheets during the club's current winning streak, bringing the season total to 11. PRFC was riding a three-game clean sheet streak going into the previous meeting this season against RGV, which they played to a 0-0 draw.

PRFC's leading goal scorer is in good form. Forward Chris Cortez has scored in each of the team's last two games, bringing his season total to 13. His next goal will be the 20th of his PRFC career, which started in 2016. His 13 goals this season are sixth-best in the USL, three goals behind the leaders.

#### Awako's Big Game

Midfielder Gladson Awako is coming off of his best game of the season. Against Colorado Springs on August 25, Awako scored the team's first goal of the night and assisted on two others to help lead the team to a 4-0 win. It was his first goal this season.

#### Familiar Faces

For a few Phoenix Rising FC players, they had the chance to compete against some familiar faces in Phoenix's last two games. Devin Vega and Billy Forbes both played, and scored, against their former team, San Antonio FC on August 22. A few nights later, Kevaghn Frater scored against the Colorado Springs Switchbacks, who he played for in 2017.

#### Big August for Asante

One of the main reasons Phoenix Rising FC went 4-1-0 during the month of August was their star forward Solomon Asante. He scored in all four games he appeared in, finding the back of the net six times during the month. His

big month was highlighted by a second-half hat-trick against Orange County SC on August 11.

#### Rewrite the Record Books

Phoenix Rising set a club record last week, and can set another soon. By defeating Colorado Springs 4-0, PRFC set a new single-season record with 53 goals, eclipsing the previous mark of 50 goals in a season, set last year. The club is also on pace to have their best regular season in points. With eight games remaining in the regular season, PRFC sits with 50 points, just 8 points shy of their highest, set in 2017.

#### International Duty

A pair of PRFC players have been called up to play for their country. Midfielder Kevon Lambert was called up to play two games for Jamaica, and goalkeeper Dallas Jaye will be available for three games for Guam this week. The FIFA International window closes on Tuesday, September 11.

#### Jockeying for Position

Phoenix Rising enters this week's match in second place in the Western Conference, but could leapfrog Real Monarchs SLC into first with a victory. PRFC's highest-ever regular season finish in the West is fourth place, in 2017.
