STRIKERS STORYLINES

RUBBER MATCH WITH THE LOONS

The visiting team has won each time Fort Lauderdale and Minnesota United FC have played this year. The Strikers will be trying to keep that 2015 form intact Saturday at Minnesota with the season series on the line. On September 26, the Loons pounded the Red & Gold 5-2 in South Florida. On June 13, the Strikers topped United 3-2 at NSC Stadium, handing Minnesota its only home loss of 2015.

STEFANO TAKES COMMANDING LEAD

Stefano's hat trick Saturday at San Antonio, his second this year, gives him the pole position for the NASL Golden Boot award. His 15 goals is four more than Minnesota forward Christian Ramirez. Below is a closer look at Stefano Pinho's 2015 season by the numbers.

15: Number of goals for the 2015 NASL scoring leader

12: Total number of NASL honors Stefano has picked up this year. They include: One Player of the Month (August); three Player of the Week (Fall, Weeks 8, 9, 14); six Team of the Week (Spring, Week 9, 11; Fall, Week 7, 8, 9, 14); two NASL Play of the Week (Fall, Week 7, 9).

10: Stefano's 10 goals scored on the road are the most in the league this season

7: Number of individual players providing assists for Stefano's goals. Shawn Chin, James Marcelin and PC have each provided two assists, while Dáni Sanchez, Gabriel, Bruno and Marlon Freitas have also set up the prolific Brazilian scorer (10 total assists on his 15 goals)

6: Number of wins in games in which Stefano has scored. The Strikers have played to a 6-2-1 (W-T-L) record in matches when Stefano has found the back of the net.

5: Numbers of goals Stefano needs to tie Etienne Barbara (2011), Pablo Campos (2012), Christian Ramirez (2014) and their NASL Modern Era single-season record of 20 goals scored in a year

24 IN 25

Fort Lauderdale has used 24 different lineup combinations in 25 NASL contests. For the only time in 2015, the Strikers fielded the same starting XI in consecutive matches when the side that defeated Jacksonville Armada FC on September 16 suited up against the Ottawa Fury three days later. Fort Lauderdale has used 24 different lineup combinations in 25 NASL contests.

FORD RECALL

The Fort Lauderdale Strikers announced late last week that goalkeeper Josh Ford was recalled from his loan by Major League Soccer (MLS) club Orlando City SC. David Meves, back to full fitness after recovering from a fractured jaw suffered in May, joined fellow netminder Lionel Brown in the 18-man squad for the team's last match against San Antonio Scorpions. Ford, 27, started 16 matches for the Strikers during his loan spell, keeping three shutouts and posting a 6-5-5 (W-T-L) record. The Orlando City SC netminder was originally loaned to Fort Lauderdale on May 29, 2015 after long-term injuries to Meves and Joe Nasco. Nasco fractured his leg in two places on April 25 in Ottawa while Meves, who started the year as the Strikers' first-choice goalkeeper, sustained his injury in the Strikers' U.S. Open Cup match at the Charleston Battery on May 27.

MR. BROWN

Lionel Brown, who grew up in Margate, was pressed into action after Ford's recall. Brown, who has been with Fort Lauderdale for four seasons, earned his first win while starting in net last Saturday in San Antonio. The Jamaican native allowed a pair of goals. On April 25, Brown came on early in the first half to help the team win at Ottawa. In two 2015 starts prior to last Saturday, Brown allowed two goals in a tie and defeat (1-0 home loss to Carolina on May 23; 1-1 tie at San Antonio on May 30). Last week's game was the fourth NASL game in which Brown has appeared for the Red & Gold against San Antonio in five career league starts.

FOREIGN AID

In addition to his league-leading 15 goals, Stefano is also the Strikers leading assist man. He and compatriots Marlon Freitas and PC each have four assists in NASL action this year. In total, Brazilian born players have 15 of the Strikers 24 assists in NASL action this year. This includes assists by Bruno Nunes and Léo Moura.

BRAZILIANS = VICTORY

In each of Fort Lauderdale's nine NASL wins this year, a player from Brazil has scored. The following Brazilians have entered the scoring column this season (in order of their first goal with the Strikers): Léo Moura; PC; Marlon Freitas; Stefano; Bruno. Additionally, Gabriel found the net in a draw.

FIFTY AND AN ASSIST

Shawn Chin made his 50th appearance for the Strikers in last week's match with San Antonio when he entered in the 70th minute. Chin's impact was significant; he provided the assist for Stefano's third goal in the 86th minute to ensure the victory and help stem the tide following two second-half Scorpions goals. The Miami native is currently 10th in appearances for the modern era Strikers. Chin has played the second most games among active players, trailing only Iván Guerrero (72).

BACK TO BACK COASTAL CUP CHAMPS

Jacksonville Armada FC's 2-0 win over the Tampa Bay Rowdies on September 26 ensured that the Coast Cup trophy would remain in South Florida for a second straight year. Created by supporters groups in 2011, the Cup is awarded to the Florida-based side with the most points in head-to-head competition. The Strikers retain the cup with a game to spare (Nov. 1 at Jacksonville) after a 4-0-1 record in matches against Sunshine State opponents.

Recap: The Strikers returned to the win column in fine fashion Saturday night with a 4-2 win in North American Soccer League (NASL) action Saturday night at Toyota Field in San Antonio. NASL leading scorer Stefano exploded for three goals, two in the first half, to give him 15 on the year and extend his league lead to five more goals than the next highest scorer, Scorpions forward Omar Cummings. The road decision halts a two-match losing skid and erases a four-match stretch in which Stefano had failed to score a goal. The victory puts the Strikers in the fourth and final position to make The Championship (postseason) with 34 points in the NASL Combined Standings. It also evens Fort Lauderdale's record in 2015 to nine wins and nine losses -- 9-7-9 (W-T-L). Stefano opened the scoring 10 minutes into the contest when he maneuvered around two San Antonio defenders and sent a sizzling shot past goalkeeper Daniel Fernandes. Fewer than five minutes later, Marlon Freitas got into the act when he slammed home a tap pass from PC for his sixth goal this year. It was Stefano again in the 40th minute: He took a PC pass from 25-yards out on the counterattack, and sent a hard shot in with his left foot, freezing Fernandes. It remained 3-0 through halftime, thanks largely to a stellar Fort Lauderdale defense and holding midfielders James Marcelin and Hendry Thomas that snuffed out several Scorpions' attacks. The home team got on the board in the 56th minute when Kris Tyrpak scored a debut goal. San Antonio appeared to get back in the game in the 79th minute when Stephen DeRoux reduced the deficit to one goal. Stefano picked up the hat trick and put the game away fewer than 10 minutes later (86th minute) when substitute Shawn Chin slipped him a pass inside the six-yard box and he slotted home. The hat trick is Stefano's second this year, the first coming August 29 in a 7-1 win over Indy Eleven. The three-goal night gives Stefano four games this season in which he's scored at least two goals. It also sends him past Mark Anderson for the modern era Strikers single season goals-scored record. Stefano now has 15 goals in NASL games, two more than Anderson tallied in all competitive matches in 2012. Lionel Brown, who grew up in Margate, was pressed into action after Josh Ford was recalled by Major League Soccer's Orlando City SC. Ford, on loan since May 29 and the starter in the last 16 straight games, was recalled Friday morning by Orlando City following an injury to another of its goalkeepers. Brown, who has been with Fort Lauderdale for four seasons, earned his first win while starting in net. On April 25, Brown came on early in the first half to help the team win at Ottawa. In two 2015 starts prior to tonight, Brown allowed two goals in a tie and defeat (1-0 home loss to Carolina on May 23; 1-1 tie at San Antonio on May 30). Tonight's game was the fourth NASL game in which Brown has appeared for the Red & Gold against San Antonio in five career league starts. The Strikers' defense was strong for the most part while doing without Jordan Graye, who is still recovering from a broken nose suffered last month. Gabriel was also out after a lower body injury during training Thursday. The team did regain the services of defenders PC and Iván Guerrero. PC sat out last week serving a red card suspension while Guerrero returned from a hamstring injury.
