

The 2016 NASL season features 12 teams across the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico. Miami FC and Rayo OKC begin play in the Spring Season, and Puerto Rico FC join in the Fall Season. The San Francisco Deltas will join the league in 2017.

The competition is split into Spring and Fall Seasons, with the champions of each season earning a spot in the NASL Championship, the league's four-team postseason tournament in November. The Spring/Fall winner with the better overall record will receive the #1 seed.

The two teams with the next highest overall points total will qualify as The Championship's 3rd and 4th seeds. Seeds 1 & 2 will host the semifinals, and the highest advancing seed will host The Championship Final, with the winner receiving the Soccer Bowl trophy.

STRIKERS ANNOUNCE NASL'S FIRST CREOLE-LANGUAGE BROADCASTS

The Fort Lauderdale Strikers and Ayiti TV earlier this month announced that all remaining 2016 Strikers home and away matches will be broadcast live in Haitian Creole.

The partnership makes Fort Lauderdale the first North American Soccer League (NASL) market to air all games in Haitian Creole.

"The Haitian community has been a part of the fabric of the South Florida community for decades," said Strikers Chief Sales and Marketing Officer Sam Ambrose. "We are proud to partner with Ayiti TV to bring Strikers Futbol Live to the Haitian population of South Florida."

Based in South Florida, Ayiti TV's broadcasts cater to South Florida's Haitian community with programming in French and Haitian Creole.

"Ayiti TV is excited to show Strikers soccer to South Florida's population of almost half-a-million Haitians," said Ayiti TV President & CEO Claude Mancuso. "With this partnership, the Fort Lauderdale Strikers recognize the importance of the Haitian community and Ayiti TV's viewers in the tri-county area and Florida's west coast. We look forward to working together with the Strikers to show our fans their favorite local sport team commentated in their native language, Haitian Creole."

In the tri-county area, Ayiti TV is available on channel 44.2 (Broward and Miami-Dade), and 33.5 (Palm Beach). Broadcasts can also be seen in Fort Myers and Naples on channels 51.3 and 18.3, respectively.

Ayiti TV coverage is in addition to the Strikers' English-language broadcast television agreement with SFL-TV. The Fort Lauderdale-based station will broadcast all 32 of the Strikers games in 2016.

NASL action can be seen on belN Sports and CBS Sports this season. The league also returns to national sports network ONE World Sports in 2016 as part of a multi-year broadcast television partnership, while telecasts also remain available on ESPN3 globally.

The Strikers' longest and most fierce rivals, the Tampa Bay Rowdies, will be looking to make their first trip back to the NASL postseason since they captured the Soccer Bowl in 2012. After a strong Spring Season in 2015 which saw them finish just one point behind the eventual champion Cosmos, the Rowdies ended in 5th place in the overall table, just behind Fort Lauderdale, and missed out on the NASL Championship.

The Rowdies are managed by Englishman Stuart Cambell. The former Leiscester City, Birmingham, Grimsby Town and Bristol Rovers midfielder finished his career in Florida with Tampa Bay in 2013 when he moved to the coaching ranks as an assistant. Campbell assumed the head coach position in August of 2015, replacing former Strikers midfielder and coach, and current broadcaster, Thomas Rongen.

Tampa Bay features plenty of familiar faces for Strikers fans, including defenders Darnell King, Frankie Sanfilippo and Stefan Antonijevic, and midfielders Justin Chavez and Walter Ramirez. Key additions Tom Heinemann and Freddy Adu, alongside veteran Rowdies such as Keith Savage and Georgi Hristov, look to help the Rowdies climb back to the NASL's top four and also recalim the Coastal Cup crown from the Red & Gold.

Caio Zanardi was appointed Head Coach of the Strikers on December 2, 2015. Zanardi will oversee all soccer operations as general manager, a position he was appointed to in July 2015. Zanardi comes to the Strikers after nearly three years working for Brazil's national soccer federation (Confederação Brasileira de Futebol). Prior to his role at the highest level of Brazil's soccer pyramid, Zanardi served six years as soccer director for Al-Nasr Sports Club, a top team in the United Arab Emirates. "While I was happy in Brazil, I couldn't turn down this opportunity," said Zanardi. "I believe in where the Strikers are going and I want to be a part of it." Zanardi's coaching credentials include an English FA International License, learning at the hands of renowned soccer coaches Fabio Capello, Sven-Göran Eriksson, Louis van Gaal and Carlo Ancelotti. Zanardi's résumé includes time with Palmeiras, Audax/Pão de Açucar - SP and Paulista de Jundiaí.

THE BATTLE FOR FLORIDA

Last minute comebacks. Red cards. Rainouts. Harrowing travel stories. So far in it's six year existence the Coastal Cup, the supporters rivalry cup between Florida-based NASL clubs, has produced plenty of excitement, heartache and memories for fans and players alike.

For the first five years, the Cup was contested soley between the sides based in Fort Lauderdale and Tampa Bay, re-igniting a matchup that dates back to 1977 and one of the fiercest rivalries in the original NASL. Tampa Bay would win the inaugural Coastal Cup in 2010, and would go on to capture the next 3 "Champions of Florida" titles as well, as the Strikers were unable to find much success against their rivals from the Gulf Coast.

While Tampa Bay held the early advantage in the modern incarnation of the rivalry, the tide has turned in recent years, with the Strikers taking the last two Coastal Cup titles and winning four of the last five matches vs the hated Green & Gold. The recent turn in form has also evened the all-time record between Fort Lauderdale/Tampa Bay teams(NASL/APSL/NASL 2) to 31 wins apiece and 4 draws since 1977.





The Coastal Cup began as a fairly straight forward two team contest, with three to four matches a year and the most points taking the trophy. But as Jacksonville Armada FC joined the fray in 2015, and Miami FC in 2016, the contest has nearly grown into a league of it's own, with 18 inter-Florida matches (five in April alone) scheduled for the 2016 season between the four sides.

Being the closest geographic grouping of clubs in the NASL and with bragging rights on the line, it's no surprise that fans make the trek to away matches within the state to cheer on their club. Supporters rack up the miles along Interstates 75 and 95 throughout the NASL season, adding atmosphere and significance to much of the NASL calendar.

The Strikers kicked off the 2016 season and Coastal Cup campaign with a draw vs newcomers Miami FC, and now face Tampa Bay in the second of back-to-back tests vs Floridian opposition after drawing Jacksonville 1-1 on April 23. Fort Lauderdale will once again host Miami on July 2, Jacksonville on July 30, and Tampa Bay on September 24, while they head out on a three game Florida road trip for matches in Tampa Bay August 6, Miami on August 13 and Jacksonville on August 17.
