

The two teams with the next highest overall points total will qualify as The Championship's 3rd and 4th seeds. Seeds 1 & 2 will host the semifinals, and the highest advancing seed will host The Championship Final, with the winner receiving the Soccer Bowl trophy.

Week 6 in the NASL Spring Season saw a change at the top of the table with the New York Cosmos blanking Miami FC 3-0 at FIU Stadium, which coupled with the Fort Lauderdale Strikers defeat of previous league leaders Carolina 3-1 in Cary, NC put New York in first place. Jacksonville Armada FC fell to FC Edmonton at home 1-0 on Wednesday, May 4th to kick off the week, and would have no better luck on the weekend as they dropped another 1-0 decision to Rayo OKC on Saturday. Ottawa Fury FC and Minnesota Unted FC played to a 2-2 draw, while the Eddies were able to escape Indiana with a valuable road point in their second match of the week with a 1-1 draw vs Indy Eleven.

While there was no mid-week NASL league play to begin Week 7, domestic Cup play for both the United States and Canada kicked off on Wednesday, May 11 with Edmonton falling 3-0 to Ottawa in the first leg of the first round of the 2016 Amway Canadian Championship. Round

The Strikers will be looking to send Indy Eleven home with their first loss of 2016 as Indy's "Boys In Blue" come in to the match with a 2-3-0 record, the only remaining unbeaten team in the NASI, this season.

This year's Indy squad, under new coach Tom Hankinson, look to be on a path to make their first real challenge at qualifying for the NASL Championship, having finished 9th place overall in both their inaugural 2014 campaign and the 2015 season. The Eleven look to have finally come into form, rewarding their fans who have posted the highest average attendance in the NASL for the past two seasons.

In addition to a new coach, the Eleven have bolstered their squad by adding former Ottawa Fury FC standout Sinisa Ubiparipovic, and feature Eamon Zayed and Nemanja Vukovic, both near the top of the early season goal scoring leaders table.

Indy Eleven are named for the 11th Indiana Volunteer Infantry Regiment, a unit that served with noteriety in the Union Army during the American Civil War.

Caio Zanardi was appointed Head Coach of the Strikers on December 2, 2015. Zanardi will oversee all soccer operations as general manager, a position he was appointed to in July 2015. Zanardi comes to the Strikers after nearly three years working for Brazil's national soccer federation (Confederação Brasileira de Futebol). Prior to his role at the highest level of Brazil's soccer pyramid, Zanardi served six years as soccer director for Al-Nasr Sports Club, a top team in the United Arab Emirates. "While I was happy in Brazil, I couldn't turn down this opportunity," said Zanardi. "I believe in where the Strikers are going and I want to be a part of it." Zanardi's coaching credentials include an English FA International License, learning at the hands of renowned soccer coaches Fabio Capello, Sven-Göran Eriksson, Louis van Gaal and Carlo Ancelotti. Zanardi's résumé includes time with Palmeiras, Audax/Pão de Açucar - SP and Paulista de Jundiaí.

Strikers U-23 brings a new level of player development to South Florida.

The newest soccer club in South Florida has a familiar name. 2016 marks the first season for Fort Lauderdale Strikers U-23, the club's new developmental team that will be competing in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL).

The club will feature amateur and college level players, both local and from from around the world, who will be playing in competitive league matches and developing their skills under the watch of the Strikers technical staff.

The Strikers announced the appointment of Olaf Henke as Heach Coach of the U-23 side on February 18, along with a partnership with local youth club Fort Lauderdale FC, who Henke has been a part of since it's inception in 2007. Strikers U-23 creates a bridge between Fort

Lauderdale FC's 600 youth players and the fully professional NASL first team.

"Both organizations are already sharing facilities in the city and are driven by the

same goals to provide the highest level of development for players," noted Henke upon his appointment. "The partnership adds a vital part to our club with the opportunities for our players to move into a professional team and organization."

Coach Henke also serves as a staff coach for


the US Youth Soccer Olympic Development Program for the Florida Youth Soccer Association. He has also served as an assistant coach for the Broward College women's team and as the head coach of the Pine Crest boys team.





In addition to providing a platform for local youth players to improve their game, Strikers U-23 will be crucial for the first team in identifying players who can make the jump to the pros. "Our NPSL side will provide a platform for talented, local players to develop with the same methodology of our first team," said Caio Zanardi, the Strikers' head coach and general manager. "We look forward to working with Olaf and providing support to the U-23 team. We are confident in our abilities to find and train high quality players with the potential to become professionals at the club."

The U-23 roster is being finalized as the team prepares for it's first ever official match on Sunday, May 22 vs Miami United FC at Ted Hendricks Stadium in Hialeah. The club has played three preseason matches leading up to it's official NPSL debut, posting an impressive 3-0-0 record with a +5 goal difference. The U-23s defeating Kendall Academy 3-1, Chivas Florida 2-1 and the APSL's Miami Storm FC by a score of 5-1.





When the U-23s officially kickoff their season, they will face some stiff local competition from the other four Sunshine Conference clubs in South Florida. Miami United FC features former Brazil great Adriano, while Miami Fusion FC are the reigning conference champions who through their 2015 NPSL results qualified for the 2016 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup. Weston FC and Storm FC round out the South Florida contingent, and are joined in the conference by Kraze United (Orlando) and two rivals familiar to Strikers NASL fans - Tampa Bay Rowdies 2 and Jacksonville Armada U-23.

The Strikers U-23 NPSL schedule for 2016 consists of 10 matches, and the club has recieved a fortunate draw, only travelling away from South Florida once, for their Sunday, June 5th match in Jacksonville vs the Armada. The other nine matches include five home games at Lockhart Stadium, and four away matches(May 22 at Miami United, June 19 at Weston FC, June 25 at Miami Fusion, and July 6 at Storm FC.

2016 marks the dawn of a new era in player development for the Strikers, and it will surely be exiciting to watch the next generation of Strikers talent rise to the occasion and challenge for the NSPL Sunshine Conference title.
