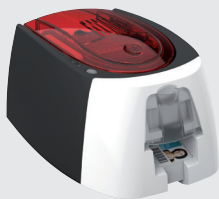

The 2016 NASL season features 12 teams across the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico. Miami FC and Rayo OKC began play in the Spring Season, and Puerto Rico FC joined in the Fall Season. The San Francisco Deltas will join the league in 2017.

The competition is split into Spring and Fall Seasons, with the champions of each season earning a spot in the NASL Championship, the league's four-team postseason tournament in November. The Spring/Fall winner with the better overall record will receive the #1 seed.

The two teams with the next highest overall points total will qualify as The Championship's 3rd and 4th seeds. Seeds 1 & 2 will host the semifinals, and the highest advancing seed will host The Championship Final, with the winner receiving the Soccer Bowl trophy.

AROUND THE NASL



There was no change to the Top 4 after Week 10 of the NASL Fall Season, while the rest of the pack continued to jostle for position the chase for the NASL Championship. In midweek action, **Fort Lauderdale** played **Minnesota United FC** to a 0-0 draw in their last ever meeting in NASL play, while the **New York Cosmos** posted an impressive 3-0 win over Spring Champions **Indy Eleven**.

In a rare Friday night matchup, **Ottawa Fury FC** hosted **FC Edmonton** at TD Place, and the two Canadian NASL sides battled to a 2-2 stalemate on the night. The **Strikers** were back in action again on Saturday, this time hosting the **Cosmos**, and moved their unbeaten streak to five games with a 0-0 draw, the second straight scoreless match in Fort Lauderdale. The **Carolina RailHawks** would defeat **Jacksonville Armada FC** in Cary, NC by a score of 1-0, while **Indy** and the **Tampa Bay Rowdies** drew 1-1 in the Circle City. **Miami FC** made their first trip to Caribbean in stylish fashion, defeating **Puerto Rico FC** 3-0, and **Minnesota United FC** and **Rayo OKC** wrapped up a relatively low-scoring NASL weekend with The Loons grabbing a 1-0 win at home.

Puerto Rico was again at home on Wednesday night to open up Week 11, as they played **Ottawa Fury FC** to a scoreless draw at Estadio Juan Ramón Loubriel.

Seven points now separate 4th place Minnesota from 5th in the hunt for the final spot in The Championship, as the Top 4 are beginning to separate themselves from the rest of the pack as we enter the final third of the season.

Indy Eleven completed the 2016 NASL Spring Season by stealing the Spring Championship on the final day of the season - with a 4-1 victory over the Carolina RailHawks - the exact result they needed to jump ahead of the New York Cosmos and capture the title.

With the Spring title in hand, Indy has their first ever postseason spot and a home match in the semifinal round locked up, but The Eleven have not let their foot off the gas, posting a 6-3-4 record in the Fall Season so far, just 6 points behind New York in both the Fall and Overall tables. Locking up home field advantage for the NASL Championship Final is still very much within reach for the "Boys in Blue".

Forward Eamon Zayed leads the club with 12 goals on the season, challenging Minnesota's Christian Ramirez in the race for the Golden Boot, who is just two goals ahead. The reason behind Indy's success in 2016 is two-fold, as the club has scored the second-most goals in the league while allowing the third-fewest.

Coach Tim Hankinson will be looking for his 3rd (and possibly 4th) NASL trophy this fall, to join the NASL Regular Season Championship he captured in 2012 with San Antonio, and this year's NASL Spring Title.

Caio Zanardi was appointed Head Coach of the Strikers on December 2, 2015. Zanardi will oversee all soccer operations as general manager, a position he was appointed to in July 2015. Zanardi comes to the Strikers after nearly three years working for Brazil's national soccer federation (Confederação Brasileira de Futebol). Prior to his role at the highest level of Brazil's soccer pyramid, Zanardi served six years as soccer director for Al-Nasr Sports Club, a top team in the United Arab Emirates. "While I was happy in Brazil, I couldn't turn down this opportunity," said Zanardi. "I believe in where the Strikers are going and I want to be a part of it." Zanardi's coaching credentials include an English FA International License, learning at the hands of renowned soccer coaches Fabio Capello, Sven-Göran Eriksson, Louis van Gaal and Carlo Ancelotti. Zanardi's résumé includes time with Palmeiras, Audax/Pão de Açúcar - SP and Paulista de Jundiaí.

RETURN OF THE STRIKERS

A LOOK BACK AT THE MEMORABLE RETURN TO THE FIELD FOR ONE OF NORTH AMERICA'S MOST LEGENDARY SOCCER CLUBS

On February 17, 2011, a crowd gathered on Fort Lauderdale Beach, at the iconic intersection of Las Olas Boulevard and AIA, for a big announcement.

Owners, dignitaries, mayors, players and alumni were on hand for some special news - the Fort Lauderdale Strikers would be returning to the field for the first time in 15 years. Joining the reborn North American Soccer League, the Strikers would be the only entrant in the league's debut season to carry on the name of a club from the classic era of the NASL in the 1970s and 80s.

Fast forward to Saturday, April 9th, 34 years to the day after the original Strikers first took the field with a 2-1 win vs the St. Louis Stars at Lockhart Stadium, where the Red & Gold were set to return to competitive play vs FC

Edmonton (who were playing in their first ever game).

6,402 fans were on hand to witness the rebirth of the Strikers, 200 more fans than attended that original game in 1977. After a scoreless first half, defender Martyn Lancaster would break the ice and head home the very first goal of the new era of Strikers

of the year. The then-NSC Minnesota Stars came to Fort Lauderdale. Minnesota grabbed the lead, and just as it looked like another visitor would come in and spoil the party, the Strikers were awarded a penalty kick in stoppage time, which Chacho Coudet would convert, locking up the first point in the modern era for the Strikers. Both Minnesota and

soccer, putting the Strikers up 1-0 in the 47th minute on an assist from Argentine midfielder Chacho Coudet.

The Eddies in their debut would play spoilers however, as within 20 minutes of that magical first goal, Shaun Saiko and Dan Antoniuk would find the net for Edmonton and seal a 2-1 win for the visitors.

The next two matches would feature late-game dramatics as the Strikers were searching for their first victory

Edmonton would feature heavily at the end of the Strikers first season back.

The first road trip of 2011 took the club to Atlanta, where they would take on the Silverbacks for the first time. More last night minute heroics were on tap, as Yoximar Granado would draw a penalty in stoppage time, and Chacho Coudet would again step up to the spot and convert a late PK to give the Strikers their first win in the modern era of the NASL.

RETURN OF THE STRIKERS

The Red & Gold would have to wait until June 4th for their second win, a 3-2 triumph over the Puerto Rico Islanders. Between the two wins, there was a five-game stretch that included four draws, which would turn out to be crucial points in the 2011 postseason race.

A second win in a row would come vs Minnesota, followed by a midsummer lull of seven matches with no wins, four draws and three losses, including a dramatic 1-1 draw vs FC Tampa Bay (now the Rowdies) in a makeup match

on June 29th in which Chacho Coudet struck once again late in a match, this time with a brilliant free kick goal.

A 3-0 victory at home on July 30 vs Edmonton would be a key turning point in the season, as it would be the first win of three in a row. A brace from leading scorer Brian Shriver and another goal from second leading scorer Abe Thompson kicked off the run that would send Fort Lauderdale on a path towards the 2011 NASL Playoffs.

The Strikers would follow up the win vs Edmonton with a 2-1 defeat of eventual regular season champions Carolina (who they would defeat again on September 7).

A set of three wins vs the Montréal Impact, Carolina and Edmonton would cap off the run to the playoffs, with a 90th minute goal from Brian Shriver sealing the win and postseason qualification in Edmonton.

The playoffs began on October 1, and Edmonton and the Strikers meeting for the 5th time of 2011, this time in the single elimination quarterfinals.

The Strikers would get their revenge on the Eddies for spoiling their return back in April - as the Red & Gold would dominate the match behind a hat trick

from Abe Thompson and two goals from Brian Shriver in a 5-0 win.

Up next was a two-game series vs the Puerto Rico Islanders, where the Strikers would get a big 3-1 victory in Bayamón, and come home to finish the series with a 2-1 win at home, advancing 5-2 on aggregate.

The Strikers would meet Minnesota in the NASL Championship Series, after the Stars defeated Carolina on penalty kicks in the semifinal round.

Unfortunately the magical return to play would not have a storybook ending for Fort Lauderdale, as the first leg of the finals ended in a 3-1 victory for Minnesota, with the only goal for the Strikers being an goal scored.

The Strikers would continue their home unbeaten streak in the return leg, however the 0-0 result on a rainy night in Fort Lauderdale was not enough and Minnesota would be the first to lift the Soccer Bowl trophy in the modern era of the NASL.

Though it was not the perfect ending, the Strikers inaugural campaign in the reborn NASL was surely one to remember, and rekindled the tradition of on-field success that the original Strikers created in the 1970s and 80s. Now today's Strikers continue that tradition, seeking to qualify for the NASL postseason for the fifth time in six seasons.

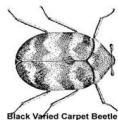

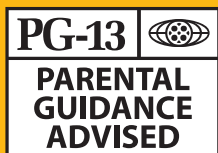
