The Jacksonville Armada FC return home to Community First Park on Wednesday at 7 p.m. ET to face NASL Spring Season Champions Indy Eleven in the two club's third and final meeting of the season. The match marks the beginning of another busy week for the Armada with three home matches in seven days.

Originally scheduled to be played on Saturday night, the match was rescheduled for Wednesday following weather concerns related to Hurricane Matthew.

With the hurricane behind them, the Armada return to the First Coast following a successful trip to Minnesota on Oct. 1 that saw the club earn its fourth win of the season and second road victory in club history. The victory could be considered one of the teams most significant and extended the team's unbeaten streak to four games.

Despite United controlling the majority of ball possession, a solid defensive performance from the Armada kept Minnesota from producing a quality shot on goal all game. In the 88th minute, the Armada stunned United in front of their home crowd at NSC

Stadium when Matt Bahner scored his third goal of the season off a pass from Derek Gebhard. The win was the Armada's first ever victory over United in all contest and the final meeting of the two clubs in NASL competition.

The Indy Eleven arrive in Northeast Florida following a late 2-1 loss in Western Canada to FC Edmonton. Despite the Eleven's Irish-born striker Éamon Zayed scoring his 14th goal of the year in the 56th minute, Edmonton were able to equalize in the 80th minute and then cap off the match in stoppage time.

The defeat ended a two match winning streak for the Eleven.

In the last meeting between the two teams, Indy Eleven handed the Armada its worst defeat in club history with a 5-2 dousing on Aug, 3. Indy's Zayed led the assault with a hat-trick, netting goals in the 16th, 58th and 65th minutes. Alhassane Keita attempted to bring his side back into the match earning his first goal of 2016 in the 33rd minute, but three more goals allowed the Eleven to cruise on through to a crushing defeat of the Armada in Indianapolis.

POTENT NOTABLES

- Neither team has ever lost in their respective cities and have held the visitors to two goals all time at home (in Jax: 1-0 on 5/9/15, 1-1 on 10/3/15, and 1-1 on 5/23/16; in Indy: 3-0 on 9/5/15 and 5-2 on 8/3/16).
- Charles Eloundou is the first player under the age of 30 to score more than four goals for the Armada and currently leads the team with five goals this season.

LAST TIME OUT RECAP (AUG. 3, 2016)

INDIANAPOLIS - Alhassane Keita found the back of the net for the first time in league play this season and almost had another on Wednesday night, but it was not enough for the Jacksonville Armada to overtake the NASL Spring Season champion Indy Eleven in a 5-2 loss at Michael A. Carroll Stadium.

Keita, who was the Armada's leading scorer in 2015, struck gold in the 33rd minute when he was able to snatch the ball from Indy's Don Smart and smash it into the back of the net from just outside the box with his left foot.

It was his first goal since his game-winner in Jacksonville's thrilling 2-1 extra time victory over the Charleston Battery in the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup third round on June 1.

It looked like the Guinean striker would have another tally to his total in the 80th minute when defender Matt Bahner curled in a picture-perfect cross just in front of the goal for a streaking Keita, but the Eleven's Colin Falvey got a foot on it first to put it past Indy goalkeeper Jon Busch for an own goal.

"I thought we did some good things with the ball," said Tony Meola, Armada FC head coach. "Give our guys credit, we battled until the end and had opportunities."

Indy's leading goal scorer Éamon Zayed led his squad with a hat-trick effort, netting goals in the 16th, 58th and 65th minutes. Forward John Braun assisted on Zayed's second goal and scored one of his own in the 13th. Nemanja Vukovic had the Eleven's other goal in the 36th minute.
