The Jacksonville Armada will try to get back on track at 7:30 p.m. ET this Wednesday when it takes on NASL Spring Season champion Indy Eleven in Indianapolis.

An 88th minute goal by Fort Lauderdale's Maicon Santos spoiled a valiant effort by the Armada and goalkeeper Sean Lewis, who finished with nine saves, handing Jacksonville a 1-0 loss at Lockhart Stadium. Until that one moment when it lost sight of Santos off a corner kick, the Armada held firm, winning the majority of duels (56-44 percent) and possession (53-47 percent).

Jacksonville was not without its chances, recording nine shots, including an attempt from Danny Barrow in the 73rd and a screamer from distance by Charles Eloundou in the 77th, but both were stopped by Strikers goalkeeper Bruno.

Indy is coming off a 2-1 road loss to Miami FC on Saturday. The Eleven's leading goal scorer, Eamon Zayed, found the back of the net in the 90th minute, but it proved to be too little, too late, as Miami's Dario Cvitanich struck just four minutes and Ariel Martinez added insurance with a goal

in the 85th. It was just the second loss for Indy in 2016 but second in three games. The Eleven are, however, undefeated at home this season, going 3-1-0 at Michael A. Carroll Stadium.

The Armada and Eleven last met on May 28 at Community First Park in Jacksonville and played to a 1-1 draw. Armada defender Matt Bahner struck in the 30th minute on a left-footed blast just outside the box, and the arrow seemed to be pointing up for Jacksonville.

But in the 73rd minute, Indy's Jair Reinoso sprinted down the right wing and sent in a cross for Justin Braun, who headed it into the back of the net. Jacksonville's Alhassane Keita nearly put the Armada back on top in the 87th when slipped a shot past Indy goalkeeper Jon Busch with the outside of his right foot, but right back Marco Franco came racing in and stopped the ball just a few yards off the goal line.

POTENT NOTABLES

- With this week's Wednesday/Saturday slate, it will be the fourth time in 2016 (including the U.S. Open Cup third round affair with the Charleston Battery) the Armada has had to endure two games in a week. It will begin a stretch of five games in 18 days.

- Jacksonville has gone with 14 different lineups this season and has had the same back-to-back starting 11 just twice (June 4 at Carolina, June 11 vs. Tampa Bay; July 11 vs. Puerto Rico FC, July 14 at New York Cosmos).

- Jacksonville has yet to record a regular season road win in its existence. Its winless streak away from Jacksonville stands at 24 games (the Armada did come close to getting that monkey off its back this season against Fort

Lauderdale on April 23 and Tampa Bay on July 2. Jacksonville scored first in both contests before settling for draws).

- Though he has played in just six contests, goalkeeper Sean Lewis already has 30 saves, which ranks eighth in the NASL. He set a club record with 10 saves at the Tampa Bay Rowdies on July 2 and notched nine saves at the Fort Lauderdale Strikers on July 30. His 5.0 saves per match is the best saves per match average in the NASL.

- The Jacksonville Armada FC announced on Monday it has mutually parted ways with goalkeeper Sebastian Evers.

Evers got the starting nod in goal on May 28 in a 1-1 draw with Indy Eleven in Jacksonville. He had a standout performance before going down with a groin injury in the 57th minute. Evers also saw action in this year's preseason.

A four-year starter at the University of Central Florida, Evers, 25, signed his first professional contract with the Armada FC in February 2015.

On Tuesday, it was announced he signed with fellow NASL side Miami FC.

LAST TIME OUT RECAP (MAY 28, 2016)

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. — Momentum is all about perception, and the Jacksonville Armada's 1-1 draw against Indy Eleven was open to interpretation.

On one hand, the Boys in Blue blew a shot at three points after giving up a 73rd-minute equalizer.

On the other, they snapped lengthy scoreless and losing streaks, and put in a gutsy performance against unbeaten Indy despite major absences and a difficult matchup.

Afterward, the Armada opinion was clear. The pint glass was half-full. Indeed, that point was a welcome sight after four straight shutout losses.

Left back Matt Bahner put an end to 464 minutes of attacking frustration with a first-half screamer, and Justin Braun found the net to tie it for the visitors.

That attacking turnaround was clear to see in the first half, as the Armada repeatedly pounded on the door of an Indy side that came in allowing fewer than one goal per game.

A nice headed pass from Barrow led to an Alhassane Keita shot that went just wide in the 26th, and Junior Sandoval's free kick ricocheted off the wall and then the post in the 28th. Two minutes later, Bahner found pay dirt.

Standing outside the box, waiting for a chance at a rebound, he got his wish. The ball popped out to him - one of "the ones everyone salivates about" - and he fired a left-footed missile that beat Indy keeper John Busch at his near post.

At the other end of the field, the Armada dealt with the Eleven's surges up field, largely thanks to 25-year-old goalkeeper Sebastian Evers. Evers was the big surprise in the lineup by replacing stalwart Miguel Gallardo, who had started every game this season but committed a costly error in last week's 1-0 loss at Ottawa.

And Evers did his part, with a fingertip save of Eamon Zayed's 17-minute header, followed by a denial of Braun from close range and a punch-out of a dangerous cross in traffic at the end of the half. But while the Armada handed Indy their first halftime deficit of the year, it wasn't to last.

Evers' fairytale debut hit a snag in the 56th, when he pulled his groin on a goal kick and had to come off for Gallardo in the club's first-ever keeper substitution. Already short-handed, that wasn't a sub they could spare.With four attack-minded players in the starting lineup, Nicolas Perea and Kevan George had to hold the midfield with minimal backup, thanks to multiple absences.

Jair Reinoso sprinted down the right wing and sent in a cross for Braun, and he beat center back Beto Navarro to a cross and blasted a header into the net. Following the equalizer, he posed in front of the Armada's supporters club, Section 904, who answered with a few choice projectiles.





HEAD COACH/TECHNICAL DIRECTOR TONY MEOLA



Legendary former U.S. Men's National Team and MLS goalkeeper Tony Meola was named the Jacksonville Armada FC head coach and technical director on Nov. 24, 2015.

TONY MEOLA

HEAD COACH/TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

Meola, who was inducted in the U.S. Soccer Hall of Fame in 2012, takes over an Armada FC club that finished 8-7-15 (W-D-L) overall in its inaugural season in the North American Soccer League, good for an 11th-place combined finish.

Meola has been a prominent figure in U.S. Soccer since he stormed onto the scene in 1987 when he helped lead the U-20 National Team at the 1987 FIFA World Youth Championship in goal. Following a two-year college career at the University of Virginia, where he was a two-time All-American under the guidance of U.S. Soccer icon Bruce Arena, Meola embarked on an illustrious international career in 1988 with the U.S. Men's National Team.

The Kearny, N.J., native earned 100 caps for the USMNT, which is tied for 14th all-time overall and third among goalkeepers, and was on the squad for the 1990, 1994 and 2002 FIFA World Cups. His 37 wins and 32 clean sheets rank third all-time in U.S. Soccer history.

Meola also had a successful 18-year club career, most of which was spent in MLS with the New York/ New Jersey MetroStars, Kansas City Wizards and New York Red Bulls. In 2000, he was named league MVP, MLS Goalkeeper of the Year and led the Wizards to an MLS Cup victory, where he was also named MLS Cup MVP. He still holds the MLS record for most shutouts in one season with 16, which he set in 2000 with Kansas City. In 2005, he was named to the MLS All-Time Best XI.

Prior to playing in MLS, Meola had brief stints in England with Brighton & Hove Albion and Watford in 1990. In 1991, he returned to the United States and played for the Fort Lauderdale Strikers, then competing in the APSL. Meola also played for indoor team Buffalo Blizzard in 1994 and for the USISL's (now USL) Long Island Rough Riders in 1995.

After becoming involved with the U.S. National Team the past several years in training sessions with the U-17 and U-20 teams, Meola also showed his ability as a player development expert. He made waves with former USMNT teammate Tab Ramos and the U-20 National Team, taking a hands-on approach with goalkeeper training and helping scout players. Meola has also developed a robust knowledge of the NASL after a successful broadcasting career with Sirius XM, Fox Sports, ONE World Sports and several other outlets.

Somewhat of a renaissance man, Meola was a multi-sport star in high school, serving as captain of his Kearny High School basketball team and was an all-state baseball player, which led him to be drafted by the New York Yankees in 1987. He also played baseball at the University of Virginia, and in 1994, Meola tried his hand at American football in 1994 when was a placekicker for the New York Jets in training camp.

And beyond sports, Meola has shown off his theatrical talents, appearing in the off-Broadway play Tony and Tina's Wedding in 1995. He also formed the New Jersey cover band Mushmouth with hometown friends in 1998.

Meola's love of the "beautiful game" was passed on to him from his father Vincent, who played professionally in Italy in the 1960s.

Meola, who is married to Colleen Meola, has since paid that passion forward to his three children, Jonathan (18), Kylie (15) and Aidan (13) and recently coached Aidan's U-12 soccer club in New Jersey. He has also been active nationally in the promotion of soccer among youth clubs.
