JACKSONVILLE, Fla. (June 9, 2017) – The Jacksonville Armada FC (4W-4D-2L, 16 pts, 2nd place NASL Spring) is looking to get back on track as it travels to Indiana for the second meeting with Indy Eleven (0W-7D-3L, 7 pts, 8th place NASL Spring) this season.

Jacksonville is coming off a tough loss to league-leading Miami FC Saturday at Hodges Stadium. The game was decided in the 35th minute when Dylan Mares' header beat Armada FC keeper Caleb Patterson-Sewell. Jacksonville rallied in the second half with a flurry of chances, but the score remained in favor of Miami. Although Miami took all three points, Jacksonville remains in second place with several weeks left before the Spring Season champion is decided.

Indy has yet to find the win column this season as it sits near the bottom of the league table. Last week against the San Francisco Deltas, Indy held a 2-0 lead late into the game until the Deltas struck in the 85th minute and again in stoppage time to force a draw.

Despite Indy's struggles this season, the club has proven to be a challenge for the Armada FC. Jacksonville has not won against the Indianapolis club since early May 2015, in its only win against Indy. The most recent meeting between the clubs ended in a 1-1 draw at Hodges Stadium in Jacksonville, Fla., with Jonathan Glenn notching his first goal of the season.

- Jacksonville's first and only win over Indy came in May 2015. The last time the Armada FC visited Indy resulted in a 5-2 loss on Aug. 3, 2016.
- Indy has not won a game yet this season, but has only lost one game at home.
- This match features two of the top goal scorers in the league. Armada's Zach Steinberger leads the league with six goals and Indy's Justin Braun is tied for second with four goals.
- Steinberger is facing his former club, Indy. He closed out May with two consecutive NASL Player of the Week awards and an NASL Player of the Month honor, both firsts for Jacksonville.
- Kevan George will be missing from the lineup this weekend as he was called up by Trinidad and Tobago for two CONCACAF Fifth Round matches to qualify for the 2018 World Cup. He will return on June 14.
- Jacksonville features three players in the top ten amount of passes in the league: Mechack Jérôme with 673, Aaron Pitchkolan with 627, and Kevan George with 558.

LAST MEETING RECAP

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. (April 29, 2017) - The Armada FC (2W-2D-0L, 8 pts., 1st NASL Spring Season) and Indy Eleven (0W-5D-0L, 4 pts., 6th NASL Spring Season) tied Saturday night at Hodges Stadium one all, in front of 3,122 fans.

Although the game ended with no clear winner, it is essential when looking at the bigger picture because both teams remain unbeaten.

"It's a great confidence booster. It wasn't a win, but at least we're picking up points along the way, and that'll count at the end of the season," said Kevan George.

With these two undefeated squads battling, this match was sure an action-packed fight till the end.

After slipping by Caleb Patterson-Sewell, Justin Braun of the Indy Eleven was able to kick the ball into the net. This goal gave Indy Eleven their first advantage of the night in the 25th minute.

Not to be outdone on their home field, Jonathan Glenn nailed a header from Jack Blake to knot things at one during the 30th minute. Section 904 and Hodges Stadium alike erupted with cheers and beating of the drums.

The draw came without the presence Head Coach Mark Lowry, who was suspended for one week after being ejected from the last match against the New York Cosmos. Nathan Walter, Armada FC technical director, helped to fill in on the sidelines.

"That just shows the character of these young men. They work incredibly hard, under the adversity of the game we came up with a big [goal]. We showed the quality we possess, we just didn't show it enough consistently during the game," said Nathan Walter, Armada technical director.

Glenn kept the momentum up but barely missed what would have been his second goal of the night. The teams went into halftime tied at one.

After a slew of hard hits and substitutions during the second half, neither team was able to net a second goal to give them the victory. Both sides took one point at the end of the night.

"Going down a goal and coming back shows good adversity," said Drew Beckie "It's a bit frustrating with a 1-1 result, we want to see a win...but I'll build on this and keep going."
