GROUP E UPDATE

LouCity, which entered this month fourth of four on the USL Championship's Group E table, has seen a reversal in form. Now, the boys in purple (5-3-1, 16 points) enter Saturday just three points back of first-place Indy Eleven (6-3-1, 10 points) with a game in hand. Saint Louis FC (4-3-2, 14 points) is also right in the race for a playoff spot, with the top two advancing to the postseason. Sporting KC II (3-5-1, 10 points) holds the fourth spot.

KING'S CUP WINDS DOWN

With a separate organization launching a Major League Soccer franchise locally, Saint Louis FC is making this season its last. So will end a rivalry with LouCity known as the Kings' Cup — both clubs' cities are named after one — that began in on March 28, 2015, in their inaugural game. LouCity boasted a 5-1-4 record against Saint Louis FC entering this season. In their only meeting so far in 2020, Saint Louis FC earned a 1-0 victory July 18 at Lynn Family Stadium.

HITTING THE ROAD

The USL Board of Governors allowed unbalanced scheduling at the USL's restart, and by nature of LouCity's plan to host fans at Lynn Family Stadium, the club wound up opening the new facility with eight straight home games. Now the boys in purple are on the road for two straight, which coach John Hackworth cited as a chance to break up the monotony of a lifestyle under the cloud of the COVID-19 pandemic.

LUUUUUUUKE

For the first time this season, LouCity's leading scorer, Cameron Lancaster, gave up his starting spot Wednesday. In stepped forward Luke Spencer, a larger, bullying type of player who wore down Indy Eleven's back line for 56 minutes, often playing with his back to the goal and distributing. Upon his exit, Antoine Hoppenot moved to the top of the attack and within five minutes delivered a game-winning assist to Paolo DelPiccolo.

AN AWESOME AUGUST

Since the calendar turned from July, when LouCity began the USL restart 1-3, the club hasn't lost, drawing with Indy Eleven on Aug. 8 before launching the current three-game winning streak. This continues a trend of strong Augusts under coach John Hackworth. Upon his hiring in 2018, the boys in purple went 3-1-3 en route to a USL title. In 2019, they were 4-1-0 in August and reached the championship game again, evidencing late-season improvement under Hackworth's direction.

MATSOSO'S THE MAN

Coinciding with LouCity's unbeaten run, the University of Kentucky product Napo Matsoso shifted from central midfield to the right wing. He's tallied two goals and two assists in four games since. While Matsoso didn't pad his stats Wednesday against Indy Eleven, he did feed in a through ball to Hoppenot that led to the game-winning goal. In all, the shifty midfielder totaled 40 touches, winning a pair of tackles while completing 77.8 percent of his passes.

NEW ADDITION

Calling it a “unique opportunity,” Hackworth this week announced the addition of forward Arda Bulut to LouCity’s roster. A senior at Stanford University, Bulut is forgoing his final season of eligibility to sign as a professional given the Pac-12 Conference delayed its men’s soccer season to the spring. Bulut was part of an NCAA championship-winning team in 2017, and the Cardinal returned to the College Cup in 2019.

BETWEEN THE POSTS

LouCity has conceded just twice on its unbeaten run, a tribute both to the back line and to goalkeeper Ben Lundt. The loanee from Major League Soccer’s FC Cincinnati posted his second clean sheet in three games and third overall against Indy Eleven, continuing to come up big in limited opportunities to make plays, saving Indy’s lone shot on goal as Tyler Pasher — who entered with eight goals in nine games — went scoreless.

ON TARGET

LouCity has all season ranked highly in the USL in shots, now third with 140 attempts. More recently, the boys in purple have managed to convert. They’ve flown from 33rd in the league in goals scored to a tie for 15th, much in part thanks to a 4-1 outburst of a victory Aug. 19 over Sporting KC II. That night, six of nine LouCity shots were on target. Wednesday against Indy, five of nine landed on frame.

HEAD COACH JOHN HACKWORTH

On Thursday, August 2, 2018, Louisville City Football Club announced the appointment of John Hackworth as the club's second-ever head coach. After an international search led to Hackworth, the 48-year-old native of Dunedin, Florida, signed a contract spanning through the 2022 season.

Hackworth had been in charge of the U.S. U-17 Men's National Team since 2015 and has served as an assistant to the U.S. Men's National Team since the beginning of this year. An experienced coach at the national level, Hackworth began with U.S. Soccer in 2002 when he first served as an assistant to then-U.S. U-17 Men's National Team head coach John Ellinger. Hackworth would go on to succeed Ellinger and lead the U-17's to finishes in the quarterfinals of the 2005 FIFA U-17 World Cup and Round of 16 in the 2007 FIFA U-17 World Cup. Following his time in charge of the U-17's, Hackworth also served as the inaugural Technical Director of the U.S. Soccer Development Academy.

Outside of his time with U.S. Soccer, Hackworth's experience extends to both the collegiate and professional levels of the game. He began as an assistant coach for the Wake Forest University women's and men's teams in 1993 and 1994. Hackworth was then named the head coach at the University of South Florida in 1998, where he led the Bulls to two NCAA Tournament Appearances.

In Major League Soccer, Hackworth spent five years with the Philadelphia Union, serving as the club's Youth Development Coordinator from 2009-12, and head coach from 2012-14 before returning to take charge of the U.S. U-17 Men's National Team.



ASSISTANT COACH DANNY CRUZ

On Thursday, September 27, 2018, Louisville City FC announced the addition of Danny Cruz as coach John Hackworth's first Assistant Coach.

A former assistant at Real Monarchs SLC, Cruz came on board after ending his playing career ahead of the 2018 USL regular season. Prior to taking on his role with the Monarchs, Cruz's

extensive playing career saw him register 137 career Major League Soccer appearances in total.

A native of Petersburg, Virginia, Cruz's decade-long playing career began with the Des Moines Menace, where current LouCity players Richard Ballard and Tim Dobrowolski have spent time. After leaving the University of Nevada-Las Vegas, Cruz was drafted in the third round (41st overall) of the 2009 MLS SuperDraft by the Houston Dynamo. The former winger clocked time with the Dynamo, D.C. United, and Philadelphia Union in Major League Soccer before spending one year with Minnesota United and part of one year with the San Francisco Deltas in the NASL before leaving for Real Monarchs SLC in August 2017.
