## THE MANAGER AND HIS COACHES

**BILLY HITCHCOCK** was born in Inverness, Alabama on July 31, 1916, the youngest of eight children . . . Now resides in Opelika, a town of 18,000, 120 miles from both Atlanta and Birmingham.

Attended Staunton Military Academy (Va.) for one year after high school . . . Was all-state there in three sports and maintained 96.8 average.

In 1934, went to Auburn where he starred in football (once an all southeast conference halfback) and baseball . . . His brother Jimmy had been Auburn's first all-American in 1932.

Sustained torn knee cartilage late in college career . . . Injury almost ended athletic career . . . After graduating from Auburn in 1938 with a B plus average, he was operated on at Johns Hopkins. That fall went to Emory University (Ga.) Law School, but the knee responded to treatment and, after one term, signed for a bonus with the Yankees in 1939.

Joined the Kansas City Blues (Amer. Assoc.) that year and played third on infield which also included Phil Rizzuto at short, Gerry Priddy at second and Johnny Sturm on first . . . Club won pennants in 1939 and 1940. When Rizzuto moved up in 1941, Billy went over to shortstop.

In 1942, contract was sold to Detroit . . . He played 85 games for Tigers then joined Army Air Corps as second lieutenant . . . Was discharged for years later with rank of major.

Played total of nine years in American League with Detroit, Washington, St. Louis, Boston and Philadelphia and had lifetime average of .243 . . . Last year in majors as player was 1953 with Detroit.

Manager at Buffalo in 1954 and then coached third base for Tigers for next six seasons . . . Last year, returned to managing at Vancouver in Milwaukee system and finished second.

Was married to the former Rebecca Rice, then an Auburn co-ed, in 1941 . . . Has one son, Johnny (age nine) . . . Is co-owner of hardware store in Opelika where he works whenever possible during off-season.

**HARRY BRECHEEN** is the only member of the ball club who has been with the Birds since their 1954 opening in Baltimore . . . He has been with the franchise a total of nine years, including one season with the St. Louis Browns.

Harry was a standout lefthand pitcher for 11 seasons in the majors, all but one of these with the St. Louis Cardinals . . . He had a lifetime record of 133-92, a fabulous career e.r.a. of 2.92, and won four of five decisions spread over three world series. He is the only lefthander to have won three games in one series (1946 vs. Boston) in the history of that classic. Perhaps his best season in the majors was 1948. That year he won 20, lost only 7 and led the National League in percentage (.741), strikeouts (149), e.r.a. (2.24) and shutouts (7).

**CAL ERMER** is a 37-year old native of Baltimore who has been managing in the minors for the last 12 seasons and actually received his first managing job at the age of 22 (1947) . . . Has finished in the first division eight times and won four pennants . . . After winning Southern Association flag at Birmingham in 1958 was selected by the Sporting News as "Minor League Manager of the Year."

Last season managed Yankee farm at Richmond in International League . . . Started as an infelder in the minors in 1942 and reached the majors briefly with the Washington Senators in 1947.

Manager at Ponce in Puerto Rican League last two winters . . . Graduate of Patterson Park High School . . . Current residence is Chattanooga where he managed in Southern Association for six years (1952 through 1957).

**GEORGE STALLER** is anything but a stranger to Baltimore baseball. Now 44, George was an outfielder for the International League Orioles in 1942, 1943, 1946 and 1947, and has been managing in the Birds' minor league system since their return to the majors in 1954. At least ten players on Oriole roster have played for him in the minors.

Managed at Ardmore in the Texas League last season and in 1960 was manager at Vancouver (Pacific Coast League), immediately preceding Billy Hitchcock in that capacity.

Broke into baseball in the Dodgers' chain in 1937, and eventually earned a tryout with the parent club at spring training in 1941, but a broken arm interceded. He did, however, make the majors briefly with the Philadelphia Athletics in 1943 before joining the U. S. Marine Corps.

Began his managerial career in the Athletics' system in 1948, and remained with that organization until joining the Orioles as manager at York in the Piedmont League in 1954 and 1955. He later piloted clubs at Aberdeen, Knoxville and Amarillo as well as at Vancouver and Ardmore.

**FARM NOTES:** The Orioles have advanced 15 farm system products to the major leagues since 1954, more than any other club in the American League. . . This will be Earl Weaver's sixth season as a manager in the Bird's minor league organization and Billy Demars' fourth. . . A survey of all 37 players the Orioles sent to Winter Instruction Leagues in 1959 and 1960 reveals that 27 successfully jumped one classification the following season, and 16 of these hurdled two classifications. . . Boog Powell jumped two after the first winter and three following the 1960 winter league season. . . The working agreement with the Aberdeen franchise represents what is perhaps the longest unbroken association between a major and minor league club in organized baseball today. This will be the 17th straight season that the Orioles and their predecessors the St. Louis Browns have been connected with Aberdeen. The tie-up was originated in 1946.



**PITCHING NOTES:** The Orioles last year led the majors in shutouts (21) and e.r.a. (3.22) . . . No A. L. club had accumulated more shutouts since the White Sox won in 23 in 1954 . . . Steve Barber became the first major league pitcher to throw eight shutouts since Bob Porterfield worked nine in 1953 . . . Camilo Pascual, of the Twins, later tied Steve for the shutout title.

The Birds pitched 26 low-hit games (4-hits or less) in 1961 surpassing the old club mark of 20 established in 1960. Barber and Milt Pappas each pitched five low-hitters.

From July 3 to the end of the season, a period of 85 games, the Oriole staff was brilliant . . . In that span, Baltimore pitchers compiled a cumulative e.r.a. of 2.63 (762 i.p., 223 e.r.), pitched 38 complete games and 15 shutouts, won 54 and lost 31 . . . This as compared to a 3.85 e.r.a., only 16 routegoing performances, six shutouts, and a 41-36 record in the first 78 games.

Among other standout performances were Barber's 18 wins, Wilhelm's 16 saves (second only to Arroyo's 19 in the majors), and Hal Brown'sfeat of pitching 36 consecutive scoreless innings.

Brown has won more games lifetime as an Oriole (56) than any other pitcher . . . Pappas is second (53) . . . Pappas leads in lifetime Oriole shutouts (11), Barber and Brown are tied for second (9).

Oriole pitchers allowed only 109 home runs in 1961, fewest in the majors, and eight fewer than the staff allowed in 1960 although total home run output in the American League jumped from 1086 in 1960 to 1534 last year.

## ITEMS OF INTEREST

**THE 1961 SEASON**—The Orioles set a club record for wins (95) and also for won-lost percentage (.586) in 1961. . . . They ended the season 28 games over .500, the first time in club history they have ever been that far over the even mark. . . . The Birds were 29-25 against the other first division clubs, and 66-42 vs. the bottom five teams. . . . Baltimore was never out of the first division from June 25 on, and moved into third place permanently on July 25.

**HOME RUNS**—The Orioles hit 149 homers in 1961, easily breaking the old mark of 123 set the year before. . . . Through the first 71 games, the Birds were out-homered 60-64 by their opponents, but for the rest of the season the Orioles outblasted the opposition by an 89-35 margin. . . . The Birds hit 27 homers vs. Detroit, a new club record against one team, and also hit 24 vs. Los Angeles. . . . They walloped 17 and 22 respectively in Tiger Stadium and Wrigley Field. . . . The club hit five homers in one game in L.A. on August 30 (Richards' last game as manager) to tie an Oriole record. . . . On April 30 in Detroit, Gentile, Triandos and Hansen hit consecutive home runs off Paul Foytack.

**MEMORIAL STADIUM**—The Orioles' performance at home in 1961 followed a pattern set the year before. . . . In both seasons, the Birds got off to a slow start at home, but completely reversed the procedure later on. . . . In 1961, the Orioles lost 10 of their first 14 home starts, and were 15-21 as late as July 1. . . . Although they didn't get over the ".500" mark for good until July 26, the Birds were 33-12 (.733) at Memorial Stadium through July, August and September and finished with a 48-33 record. . . . In 1960 Baltimore was 20-25 at home on July 20, but went 24-8 from then on for a final 44-33 mark.

A total of 108 homers were hit in Memorial Stadium last year, a new high surpassing the old standard of 103 set in 1960.

Fence distances in left and right center have been slightly altered for the 1962 season. . . . However, the foul lines will remain at 309' and the distance to dead center at 410. . . . See diagram on page 7 for details on changes.

**MVP GENTILE**—Jim Gentile was selected the "Most Valuable Oriole" in 1961. . . . Winners in previous years: 1954—Chuck Diering; 1955—Dave Philley; 1956—Bob Nieman; 1957—Billy Gardner; 1958—Gus Triandos; 1959—Gene Woodling; 1960—Brooks Robinson.

During 1961, Jim: set 11 Oriole season records, tied a major league record with five grand slams, became first major leaguer to hit bases loaded home runs in successive turns at bat on May 9 in Minnesota, finished second in league in rbi (141) only one behind leader Roger Maris, tied Harmon Killebrew for third in home runs (46), set club standard for most rbi in one game (9) and tied record for most total bases game (11).

He also hit two homers in one game seven times, hit home run off light standard atop Tiger Stadium's right field roof (95' high), walloped nine homers off Detroit and Los Angeles, drove in 25 runs against Angels and 23 against Twins, achieved a reached base percentage of 42.8, hit eight homers off lefthand pitching, led club in key runs produced (48).

He also finished third in league MVP balloting with 157 votes behind Maris (202) and Mickey Mantle (198).

**PINCH-HITTING**—The Orioles led the American League in pinch-hitting for the third straight year in 1961:

Last season Dave Philley set a major league record for most pinch-hits in a season with 24, surpassing the old standard of 22 established by Sam Leslie, N. Y. Giants (1932). . . . As a pinch-swinger, Dave came to bat 72 times officially, had a .333 average, drove in 18 runs, hit seven doubles and drew five walks. . . . Other standout pinch-hitters were Dick Mansell (6-for-16, .375), Whitey Herzog (6-for-18, .333) and Marv Throneberry (7-for-23, .304).

**OPPONENTS' NOTES:** Detroit's Al Kaline (.410) and Rocky Colavito (.364) led all opponents in hitting against the Orioles in 1961 while teammate Norm Cash, the A. L. batting titlist, hit .305 and led the opposition in rbi with 15. . . . Ted Kluszewski hit 7 home runs to tie a club record. . . . Kaline led in hits (25) while Cash and Colavito scored most runs (16 each). . . . Other leading anti-Oriole hitters: Zoilo Versalles (.356), Albie Pearson (.339) and Floyd Robinson (.327).

Whitey Ford was the only opponent to win four games. He lost once, and brought his career record against Baltimore to 26-10. The biggest loser was Joe McClain, 0-4.

Despite the phenomenal successes of Roger Maris and Mickey Mantle in 1961, the Birds held them in relative check. Maris hit only 3 of his 61 homers and batted only .208 with 6 rbi against the Orioles, while Mantle blasted 4 homers and drove in 7 runs on a .277 average. However, Mantle raised his lifetime output of Memorial Stadium home runs to 18, a record for a visiting player.
