MATCH PREVIEW

Sounders FC 2 (2-7-2, 8 points) on Sunday attempts to snap a five-game winless streak against OKC Energy FC at Cheney Stadium in Tacoma (1:30 p.m. PT / ESPN+). The match will be the first of two between the clubs this season. S2 travels to Oklahoma City on Saturday, August 25 for a 5:30 p.m. PT kickoff.

S2 (2-7-2, 8 points) is in 15th place in the Western Conference, while OKC Energy FC (2-9-1, 7 points) sits in 16th. The away match is just the fifth of the season for Energy FC, and the club has posted a 0-3-1 mark in its first four road games. S2 is 2-4-0 at home in Tacoma this season.

Sounders FC 2 dropped its last match, 4-0, at Fresno FC on June 2. Midfielder Antonee Burke-Gilroy made his S2 debut after coming on for captain Ray Saari to start the second half. Jesse Daley made his first start for Seattle and played the full 90 minutes. Burke-Gilroy and Daley were signed to S2's squad from Australia on May 1, 2018.

LAST MATCH RECAP

Sounders FC 2 (2-7-2, 8 points) on Saturday dropped a 4-0 decision at Fresno FC (3-4-6, 15 points). The home team got on the board first in the 27th minute with a penalty kick goal from captain Juan Pablo Caffa and never looked back. The loss extended S2's winless stretch to five games.

Antonee Burke-Gilroy made his S2 debut after coming on for captain Ray Saari to start the second half. Jesse Daley made his first start for Seattle and played the full 90 minutes. Burke-Gilroy and Daley were signed to S2's squad from Australia on May 1, 2018.

Jemal Johnson scored twice in the second half for Fresno FC to put the game out of reach. After opening the scoring for the home team, Caffa assisted on Johnson's first goal in the 54th minute to put Fresno ahead, 3-0. Johnson put home a rebound off S2's goalkeeper Bryan Meredith in the 84th minute for the final goal of the match.

FIVE S2 PLAYERS APPEAR FOR MLS CLUB

Five S2 players (Rodrigue Ele, Nick Hinds, Shandon Hopeau, Ray Saari, and David Olsen) played for the First Team on Wednesday in the Fourth Round of the 2018 U.S. Open Cup in Sacramento. Ele, Hinds, Hopeau, and Saari each started for Sounders FC in a 2-1 extra time defeat to Sacramento Republic FC.

Cameron Iwasa put the home side up in the 60th minute, completing a nice set of build-up plays that began with Villyan Bijev and ended with Iwasa tapping in a short cross by Elliott Hord past Seattle goalkeeper Bryan Meredith.

Meredith kept the score at 1-0 in the 66th minute, coming off his line to thwart a Wilson Kneeshaw chance before making a point-blank save on a blast from Adam Moffat. The veteran goalkeeper wore the captain's armband for Seattle following Lamar Neagle's exit in the first half due to a groin injury.

The Rave Green found the equalizer in second-half stoppage time courtesy of Harry Shipp, who hit a low first-time shot from distance that deflected off a SRFC defender and into the net. It marked the first goal of 2018 across all competitions for Shipp.

Sacramento notched the winner in the 115th minute, with Jure Matjasic converting a rebound attempt from close range after Meredith denied a hard shot from Iwasa.

S2 MOVES TO TACOMA

Seattle Sounders FC and the Tacoma Rainiers announced on November 1, 2017 that beginning in 2018, Sounders FC 2's previously-announced transition to Tacoma is accelerating, allowing S2 to play its home matches at Cheney Stadium, while progress continues toward a new soccer-specific facility. Earlier in 2017, the two clubs reached a historic agreement to build a 5,000-seat facility in Central Tacoma on the footprint of Cheney Stadium. While that process moves forward, South Sound soccer fans are now able to see their USL side play in Tacoma several seasons ahead of schedule.

"Our organization was already thrilled to be moving ahead with the Rainiers and the City of Tacoma on the new stadium project, but when we learned of the opportunity to begin playing USL games as soon as 2018 in a facility like Cheney Stadium, we embraced the chance," said Sounders FC Owner Adrian Hanauer. "From Rainiers leadership to the many civic officials in Tacoma that are working hard to deliver professional soccer to their city, we're humbled to have such willing partners in this effort. As soon as next season, fans can enjoy a first-class experience at Cheney, allowing the club to make a tangible connection to the City of Tacoma earlier than expected."

"We are so proud to bring another professional sports franchise to Tacoma," Rainiers President Aaron Artman said. "To partner with the top soccer organization in the country, the Sounders, adds a layer of passion and prestige to the project, fueled by a vibrant South Sound base of supporters. We are excited to deliver a fantastic USL experience with S2 at Cheney in 2018 and 2019, while keeping our focus on delivering a world class soccer specific stadium by 2020."

Originally announced in May of 2017, the partnership brings together two of the Northwest's premier professional sports organizations to reach a first-of-its-kind relationship in USL within the same regional market. The Tacoma Rainiers are an award-winning franchise that has been a staple of the South Sound community for over 50 years, operating as the top affiliate of Major League Baseball's Seattle Mariners. They will operate the business side of the new era of the USL club, taking advantage of the decades of experience operating a professional organization in the Tacoma market, while Sounders FC is set to maintain leadership over soccer operations and sporting infrastructure. With key details coming together - including a name for the organization that is representative of its new home - it was announced today that much like the naming of the Sounders FC First Team, Tacoma fans will have influence over the identity of their new club. Details for that process are forthcoming, with the team to play under the S2 brand in the near-term during this transition.

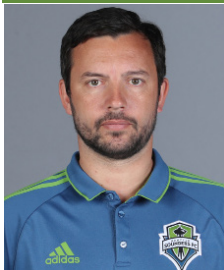

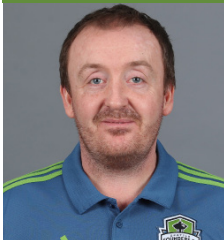
