





## TONIGHT'S OPPONENT CHICAGO FIRE

The Chicago Fire are not en fuego.

But they do enter Saturday's game against the LA Galaxy streaking.

The Fire (2-4-12, 18 points) are unbeaten in eight games, last losing a match on May 21 when they fell 2-1 to the Philadelphia Union, 2-1. But since May 28, Carlos de los Cobos' last match as head coach of the Fire, when his team managed a 2-2 draw against San Jose, the Fire have been streaking.

Following that game, the Fire made a coaching switch: Out went de los Cobos, in came Frank Klopas. Klopas, also the club's technical director, was named the Fire's interim head coach on May 30. He's led his team to a 1-0-6 record, the longest streak for an MLS coach starting a new job in the MLS post-shootout era (since 2000). Klopas first' win as a coach, a 1-0 win over the Crew in Columbus, was the Fire's first win since late March, snapping a run of 11 straight games without a win.

The loss to Philadelphia was also Fire goalkeeper Sean Johnson's last game on the bench behind veteran Jon Conway. Johnson, who had been benched ahead of LA's visit to Chicago in April and battled an injury, has been a key to his team's current unbeaten streak, notching three shutouts and turning in a terrific performance on June 9 in which he recorded nine saves to help the Fire get a 0-0 result on the road against Sporting Kansas City.

While defensively the Fire have been solid in the back with Johnson in goal, Jalil Anibaba, Yamith Cuesta, Cory Gibbs and Gonzalo Segares on the backline, offensively they've struggled. Chicago has only managed six goals during the streak, scoring one goal or less in each of their last seven matches.

Their midfield features talented playmakers like Patrick Nyarko and Marco Pappa, who is tied for the team lead in goals with speedy forward Dominic Oduro, who tallied his fifth goal of the season during their 1-1 draw against Chivas USA last Saturday. Oduro has four of the Fire's last seven goals and has already matched his career-high for goals in a season.

The Fire have an all-time losing record against the Galaxy of 15-16-5, including 6-8-3 when playing the Galaxy in Los Angeles. But the Fire hold a slight 4-3-2 advantage against the Galaxy at The Home Depot Center since the venue opened in 2003.

This is the second meeting between the two clubs this season. On April 17, the Galaxy, playing without an injured Landon Donovan and a suspended David Beckham, beat the Fire, 2-1, at Toyota Park with goals from former Fire forward Chad Barrett and defender Omar Gonzalez.

Oduro, playing in his first game of the season with the Fire, scored a goal in the 89th minute and added some drama to the final minutes of the game.

#### Key Man: Sean Johnson

Since Sean Johnson returned to the lineup on May 28 against the San Jose Earthquakes, the Fire have gone 1-0-7. During that stretch, the second-year goalkeeper has conceded only five goals and notched three clean sheets. Johnson, 22, began the season as the starter but was demoted to the bench by then Head Coach Carlos de los Cohos after make

then Head Coach Carlos de los Cobos after making only five saves and giving up 10 goals in the first four games of the season. But since being inserted back in the lineup, Johnson is averaging almost four saves a game and has been an integral figure in the Fire's defensive resurgance. •

ooking sharp in their brand new Punjaband-Gold third jersey, the LA Galaxy extended their unbeaten streak to 11 games with a 0-0 draw against the Seattle Sounders FC at a sold out The Home Depot Center on



Monday night. The draw was the second consecutive shutout for the Galaxy who also defeated the San Jose Earthquakes, 0-0, on June 25.

Second-year goalkeeper Brian Perk made his Major League Soccer debut in the game, replacing the injured Donovan Ricketts and the suspended Josh Saunders. The Rancho Santa Margarita-native was awarded no grace period in his first match and was tested early on. In the 18th minute, Omar Gonzalez handled a Fredy Montero shot and referee Ricardo Salazar awarded Seattle a penalty kick. Perk, who had not faced a shot in the game at this point, got a good read on Fredy Montero's intention and coolly parried away the shot, keeping the game scoreless.

Perk, who is just 21-year-old, making him the youngest goalkeeper to play a game in Galaxy history, finished the game with two saves. He also walked away with an MLS Save of the Week nomination

for his penalty kick save on Montero.

The Galaxy's best chance came in the 68th minute when forward Juan Pablo Angel latched onto a Landon Donovan pass and cut inside onto his right foot, firing a curling shot from the edge of the box on goal. Sounders goalkeeper Kasey Keller dove to his left and tipped the ball of the far post and out for a corner kick to keep the score 0-0.

CARSON, Calif.— Before the LA Galaxy's game at San Jose two weekends ago, Mike Magee was just another player. A mere mortal if you will.

But, in a span of four days he became a legend.

An attacking player throughout his entire career, Magee kept a clean sheet for 47 minutes in an emergency situation against the Earthquakes — a performance good enough to earn him MLS Player of the Week and MLS Save of the Week honors. As if that weren't good enough, he then followed it up with a game-winning goal in a 2-1 U.S. Open Cup victory over the Los Angeles Blues.

Can Magee top perhaps the most exhibit and productive three-day stretch of his career?

"Oh, man, you guys are expecting too much now," he said after the game against the Blues. "I don't know. Hopefully, [we just] keep winning."

The only thing with more steam than Magee's rise to LA prominence is the club's 11match league unbeaten run. The Galaxy last lost a game on May 1 and have been a force

Magee has played a role in the streak, playing in all 11 games and starting eight of them. Perhaps his most significant moments, though, came in that game in San

> Donovan Ricketts was making his return to the starting lineup, following his participation with Jamaica in the COCNACA Gold Cup tournament, but a collision and subsequent broken bone in his arm sent him to the sidelines. Josh Saunders stepped in to replace Ricketts

but a red card knocked him out of the match two minutes before halftime.

Enter Magee.

Never having played in goal before — not even in a non-competitive match — Magee volunteered to fill-in at goal, and a legend was

Magee made four saves and preserved a scoreless draw. Not only did Galaxy fans take notice. but so, too, did the league as Magee was named MLS Player of the Week for his performance.



Thus, he became the first goalkeeper to win the award this year. Also, Magee's save on Steven Lenhart in the closing minutes of the match was voted Save of the Week by the fans.



Not all legends, however, are seamless.

"It's been pretty nerve-wracking," he said. "I'm still a little nervous from playing goalie. The butterflies haven't left yet."

Alas, his new-found Midas touch was not limited to goalkeeping duties. The Galaxy fell behind to the third-division Blues with less than a half-hour remaining in their Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup match last week. After Omar Gonzalez tied the game up with a quarterhour remaining, Magee came to the rescue yet again.

On a free kick, Gonzalez got his head to the ball and knocked it to the far post. Magee rifled the ball into the back of the net, punctuating his meteoric rise to fame.

How much fame has Magee gained? After his performance against San Jose, Magee was a trending topic worldwide on Twitter, and the banter has not died down since.

"Luckily, I don't have a Twitter account, because I've heard it's been pretty intense on Twitter," he said. "I've gotten a lot of texts and phone calls from family and friends. They're having a good time with it."

Magee began the season as a forward, starting the Galaxy's season opener at Seattle up top alongside Chad Barrett. A spot opened up in the midfield when LA lost Landon Donovan to injury before a trip to D.C. United and Magee slid into the midfield. Overall, Magee has started 15 matches and has come on as a substitute in three others, and aside from his cameo in goal, he's played solely in the midfield.

"Over the last six years, I've kind of realized that I've played pretty much everywhere," Magee said. "I don't think there have been many weeks beside this year where I've trained at one position which is something that has kind of done me favors throughout my career where I've gotten to play a lot but it's also hurt me at times where I haven't been able to practice in any one position."

Now that he had a taste at goalkeeper, will Magee consider putting the gloves on once more?

"I don't even want to think about goalie ever again," he said with a grin. "Seriously." •


# Fourth of July

his weekend, the LA Galaxy U-16's have traveled to Milwaukee, Wis. where they are competing in the U.S. Soccer Development Academy Finals. The group comes in to Finals Week in good shape following an impressive showing last weekend in Frisco, Texas—three victories in three games and a plus-4 goal differential—but the path to the championship won't be easy.

Finals Week runs from July 9-16 at three venues in Milwaukee. Eight teams will be split into two groups of four. The teams will play each team in their group in a round-robin format, with the U-15/16

group winners squaring off for the championship on Saturday, July 16.

The Galaxy will open the tournament on Sunday against local rivals Real So Cal before facing the Dallas Texans on Tuesday and wrapping up group play against Seattle Sounders FC on Thursday.

Earlier this week, we caught up with midfielder Grady Howe, who has trained with the first team and has made his MLS Reserve League debut on Tuesday, to see how the team was handling the emotions, nerves and training sessions ahead of Finals Week.

## What has this week been like for you and you're teammates?

"We're taking nothing for granted. We've been getting pretty easy wins, two, three, four goals a game, but now we're just gearing up for Finals where it's going to be 1-0, 2-0, 2-1 games. So, practices are more quality, we're emphasizing the mental toughness aspect so that we're always doing the right thing. We're trying to play the right way, but at the same time we're trying to win too."

What was the most challenging part of the games in Dallas?

The most challenging? The weather, actually, the heat. We responded well to the heat, but it was a real big factor. Winds

were also difficult. We pulled through with a couple of goals going against the wind, which was huge. But the elements were not on our side in that tournament."

The Development Academy league is set up to better develop players, not so much to win trophies. But, when you get to this level of any tournament, it's all about winning, right?

"Yes, absolutely. The focus for the whole year really has not been winning, though we did win games, it's been getting guys in, getting guys developed and we've done a great job of that. Throughout the season we've seen different guys come in and make a big difference for us. So, obviously, during the season we really like to focus on the soccer. But as we head into the finals, it's win, win, win. So, we're trying to get the job done while playing good soccer. Playing good soccer and winning is our focus there."

What has it been like to be playing with the Galaxy Academy, given the amount of talent on your roster, and to have the opportunities you have had, like playing in the Reserve League and training with first team?

"This is definitely the best team I've ever been on. We have a good group of guys and the coaches have done a good job of picking the right players and they've created the right chemistry for us. The players really love each other, we work for each other and the quality, you can tell, is a step ahead of any team we've ever been on. Training with the first team, I just mentally prepare myself to play that much quicker because you don't have time to take that extra touch. You have to know what you are doing before you get the ball. And when you go out here it just makes you that much better going back to the Academy."

Brian Perk's first save in Major League Soccer came in the 18th minute when he stopped Fredy Montero's penalty kick attempt. It's a rare occurrence to have your first save from the penalty spot. How rare? Perk is only the second goalkeeper in MLS to achieve that feat. The

first was Miami Fusion goalkeeper

Matt Napolean in 1998.

Perk is the fourth different player to play in goal for the Galaxy this season, joining Mike Magee, Donovan Ricketts and Josh Saunders. Prior to this season, the Galaxy had never used more than three goalkeepers in a season.


Dating back to the game in Colorado on June 18, the Galaxy come have not surrendered a goal in the last 216 minutes.

Following Monday's 0-0 draw, the Galaxy now have four 0-0 draws this season, including their last two games. Prior to their last two games,

the Galaxy had never had back-to-back scoreless draws. The four scoreless draws are a new single season record for

the Galaxy.

With the draw, the Galaxy their unbeaten streak to 11 games. The streak is the fifth longest in Galaxy history. They are the only club in MLS history with six unbeaten streaks of 10 games or more. During the streak, the Galaxy have gone 5-0-6 in those contests and gotten 21 of a possible 33 points.



Speaking of streaks, the LA Galaxy extended their streak of hosting game on the Fourth of July to 16 this past Monday. The streak is not only the longest in MLS history, but in the history of all major U.S. pro sports leagues, according to the Elias Sports Bureau. It's never been equaled even in the 136 years of Major League Baseball. MLB's longest streak was 12 straight seasons, set in the 19th century by the team we now call the Cubs (1887-1898). Chicago played those Fourth of July games at three different stadiums, including double-headers in each of those seasons except 1897. For the record, the Galaxy played their first seven July 4th games at the Rose Bowl, averaging 55,000-plus per game, before moving to The Home Depot Center, where they have continued to fill the building (averaging more than 25,000 per game).
